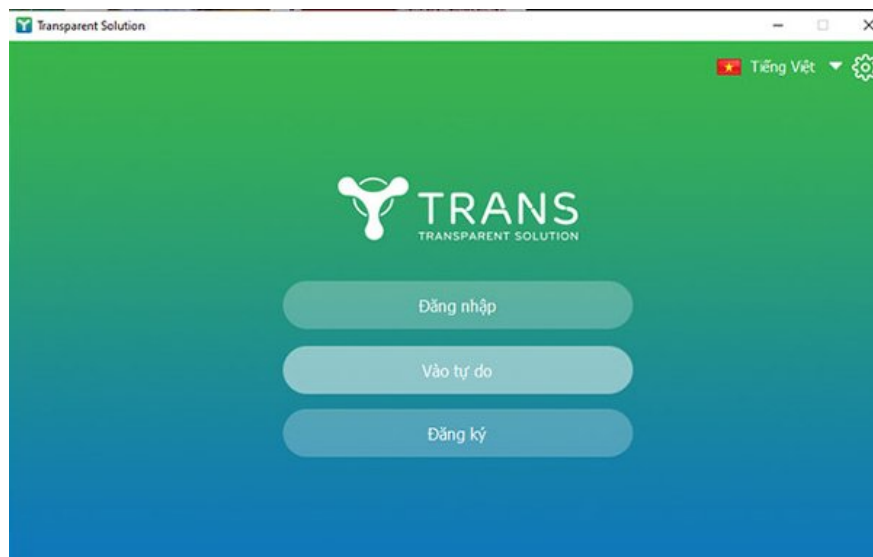

TranS is a free online teaching software with Vietnamese interface that helps teachers easily organize lectures and communicate with students in the classroom.



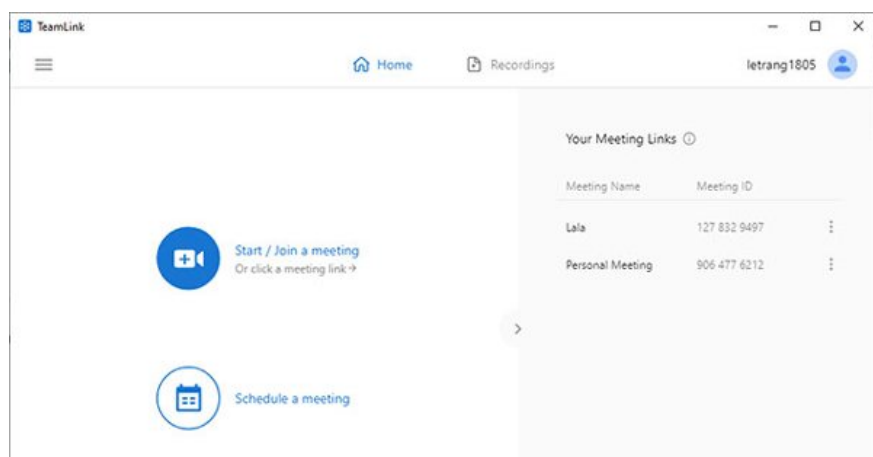
The TranS app supports streaming video with HD resolution and clear sound up to 300 points simultaneously in a room. The teacher can simultaneously watch 49 videos on the screen at the same time.

5. Facebook Workplace

With **Workplace by Facebook** (also known as **Facebook Workplace**), teachers can connect and communicate their lessons to students on the platform built and developed by Facebook.



Some salient features of Workplace include:

1. Integrated live stream, video chat with high quality, developed and supported by Facebook.
2. Ability to link and share archives from Google Drive.
3. Use NewsFeed feature similar to Facebook to share articles, post homework. This enhances the interaction between students and teachers.

6. Skype

Teachers can fully use **Skype** to organize online lessons with groups of less than 10 students. Teachers can take advantage of this software to organize classes quickly such as: Popular applications, many users; Easy to use, only requires an Internet connection; Integrated on many platforms, suitable for all computer configurations; .



However, the downside of Skype is the limitation in the free version. Users have to pay if you want to make a call for a group of 10 or more people, some features are not available in the free version, .

7. Zoom

Zoom is a completely free online teaching application that supports teachers and schools to organize classes with the maximum number of participants up to 100 people, each lesson period can last up to 40 minutes and unlimited. number of meeting.



In addition, this application also allows teachers to share work files, share computer screens, record lessons and many other useful features.

However, there are many concerns about the confidentiality and information security of Zoom in online teaching activities. Teachers should consider when choosing this application to organize online classes.
