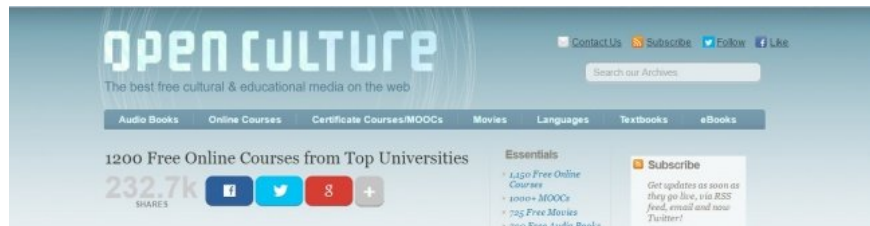

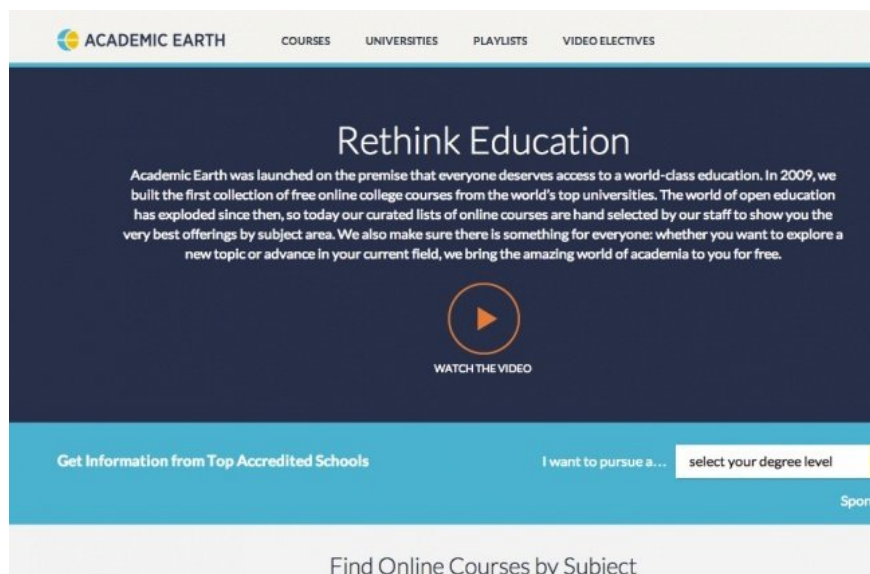
Open Culture Online Courses

University Of the People

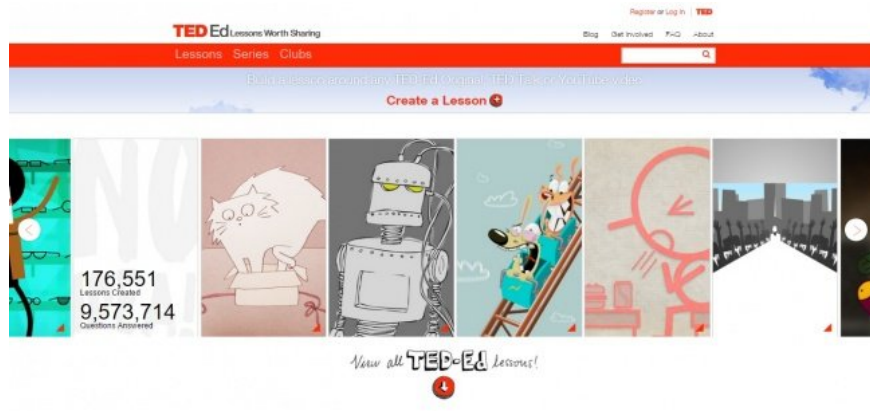

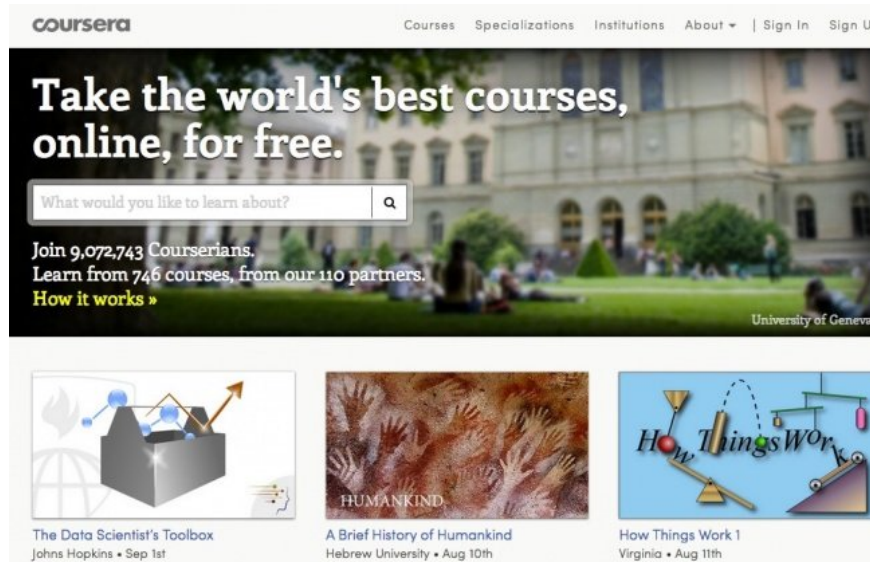

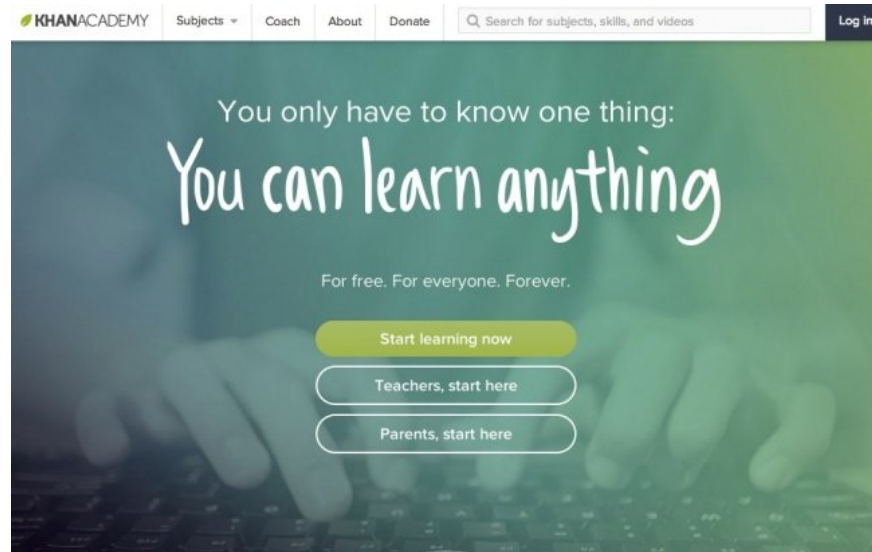
