

Top 8 cryptocurrency exchanges with the lowest transaction fees

Are you a trader and you don't like losing too much money on trading fees? Please refer to the top 8 virtual currency exchanges with the lowest transaction fees below.

1. Poloniex

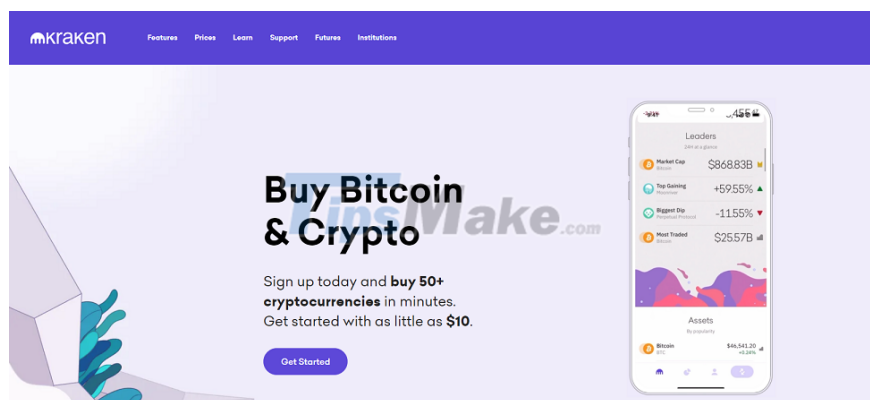
Founded in 2014 by Tristan D'Agosta, Poloniex is an exchange with extremely fast and solid growth. The exchange's daily trading volume is estimated at more than \$160 million.



Poloniex supports many coins, many staking options and an interesting reward center, most importantly: low fees. Currently, Poloniex only loses 0.124% in maker or taker fees, and does not charge deposit fees. This means you can buy and sell photo coins on the platform without worrying about unnecessary fees.

2. Kraken

Ranked fourth in terms of trading volume worldwide, Kraken started out as an American Bitcoin and Litecoin exchange. Today, the system already supports a huge number of cryptocurrencies ranging from Ethereum to Aave. There are many trading pairs, stakes, and funding options available on Kraken. The exchange's maker and taker fees are a factor that makes it get a lot of attention.



Currently, Kraken only charges 0.15% maker fee and 0.26% taker fee. This is a very reasonable phi level compared to many other trading platforms.

3. Binance

Binance is currently the most popular exchange in the world, a favorite trading place for thousands of people buying and selling virtual currencies. Binance is available in more than 180 countries, they also have a very friendly charging mode.



The taker and maker fee is only 0.1%, Binance facilitates the trading of coins to become very active. Best of all, Binance does not charge staking, deposit and withdrawal fees. Overall, this is a stable exchange for all your coin trades.

4. Pionex

Pionex is a relatively young cryptocurrency exchange, founded in 2019. But it quickly gained attention. One of the most unique features of Pionex is its automated trading bot, which allows users to conveniently trade and invest assets.

Another great thing that we need to pay attention to is the extremely low maker and taker fees – 0.05%. This number is significantly lower than many coin exchanges in the market. Pionex does not charge a deposit fee, but there is one for withdrawals as well.

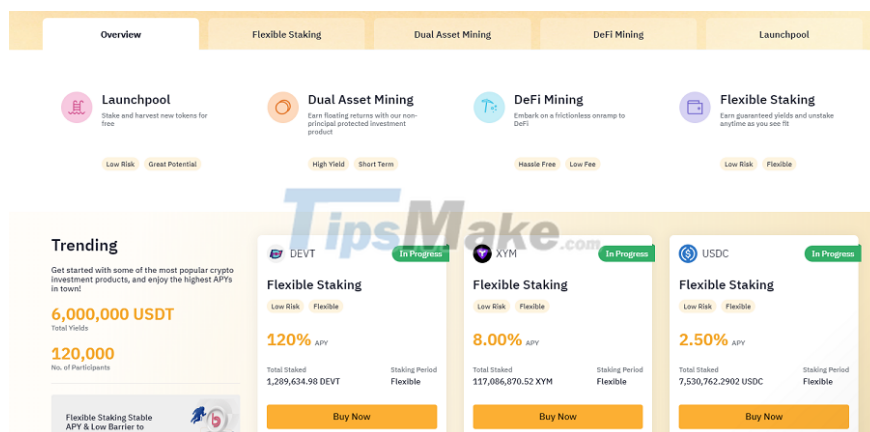
5. eToro

Founded in 2007, eToro is an Israeli brokerage, but they also offer a diverse and reliable coin exchange. eToro allows users to buy and sell a variety of cryptocurrencies, including Bitcoin, Ethereum, and Stellar. The exchange also has some great staking options for those looking to earn passive income from crypto.

Regarding maker and taker fees, eToro charges no fees. However, this does not mean that trading on eToro is completely free. The platform charges a spread of 0.75%. In addition, eToro does not charge any deposit or withdrawal fees, which makes transferring your funds easy and enjoyable.

6. Bybit

Founded in March 2018 by Ben Zhou, Bybit is the fastest globally accessible Singaporean exchange. In just 4 years, Bybit has become an extremely popular platform, with a huge volume of transactions every day.



No maker fee, only 0.075% taker fee, Bybit ensures you avoid all kinds of nasty fees. Furthermore, both deposits and withdrawals are free of charge. What could be more wonderful?

7. CEX.io

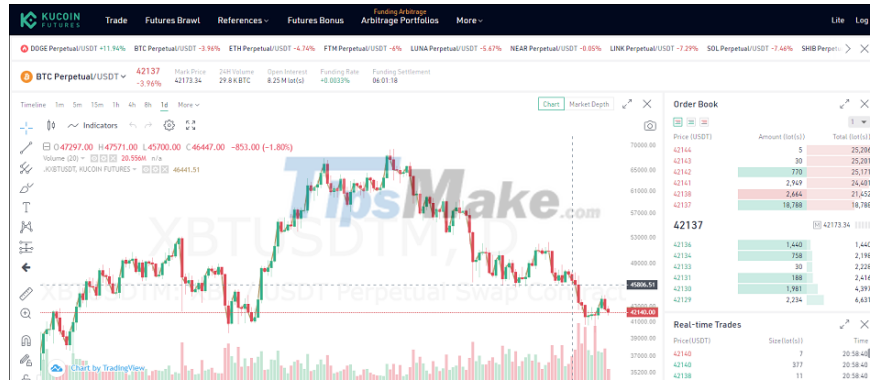
CEX.io is a widely used cryptocurrency exchange platform with a bunch of great features, including margin trading, staking and official debit card issuance. This exchange can be accessed by users in almost every country in the world, currently the number of users has reached 4 million.



CEX.io charges a maker fee of 0.16% and a taker fee of 0.25%. In addition, the platform also charges a fee of 2.99% for deposits from VISA or Mastercard, and charges withdrawal fees depending on where you receive the funds.

8. KuCoin

KuCoin currently ranks as the 5th most popular exchange in the world, having a list of over 500 supported coins. In addition, KuCoin provides various features for you to build your own portfolio.



Currently, KuCoin maker and taker fees are the same – 0.1%. Besides, KuCoin does not charge a deposit fee of any kind but does charge a withdrawal fee. The withdrawal fee you will have to pay depends on the cryptocurrency you are transferring. Ex: Withdrawing Bitcoin will cost you 0.0005 BTC, while withdrawing Polkadot will take away 0.1 DOT. You should check KuCoin fees first to see what fees you will incur.
