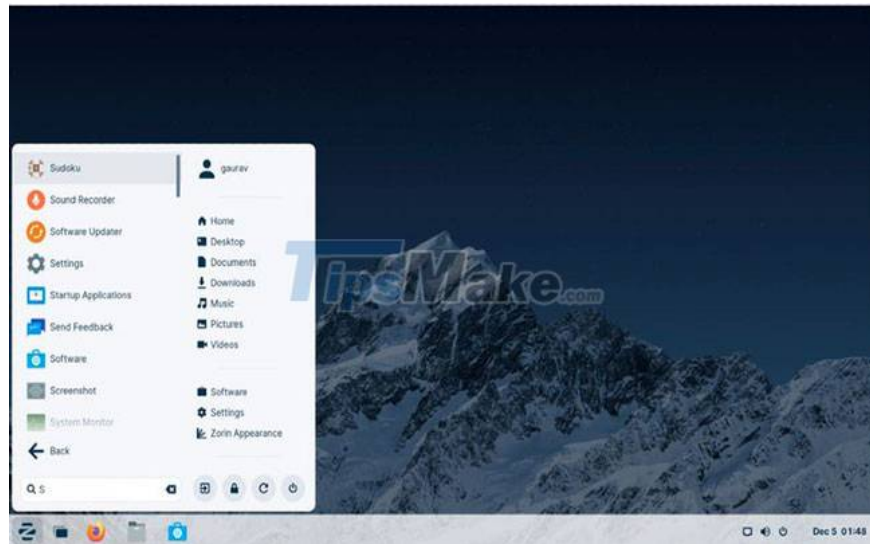

6. Solus



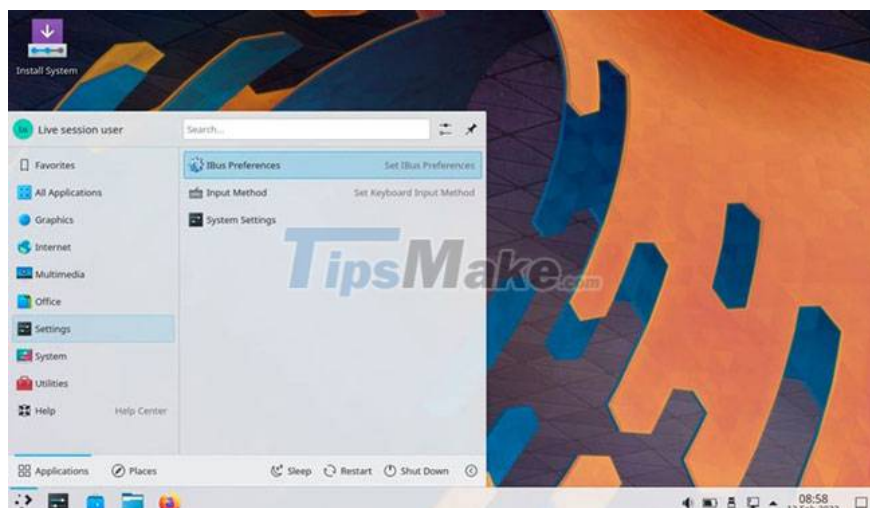
Solus will delight you with its eye-catching desktop and the ability to customize the operation. This feature-rich distribution comes bundled with the Budgie desktop environment.

7. KDE Neon



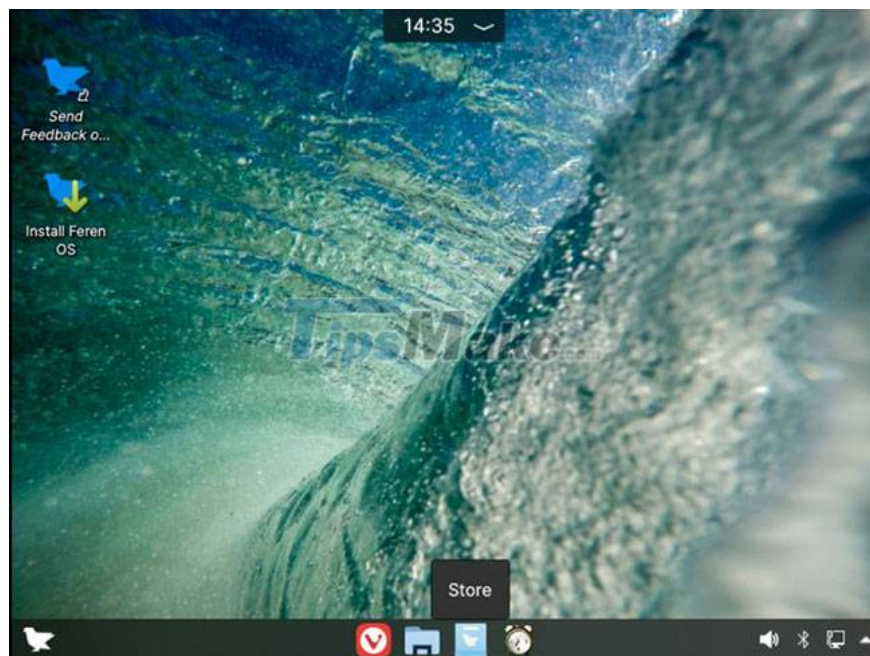
