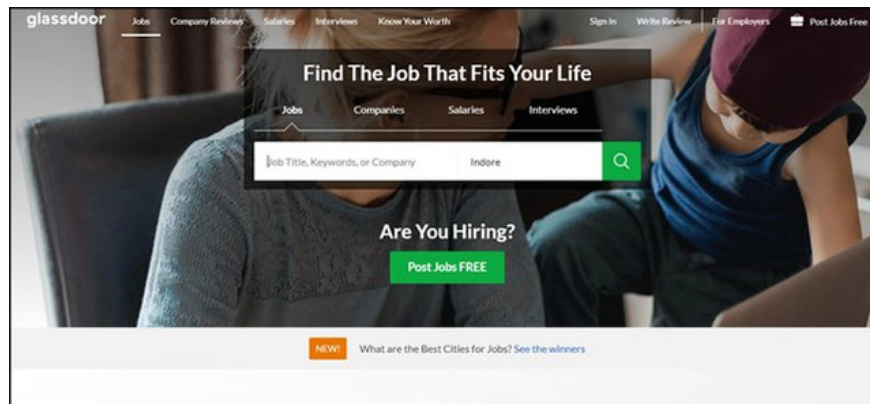

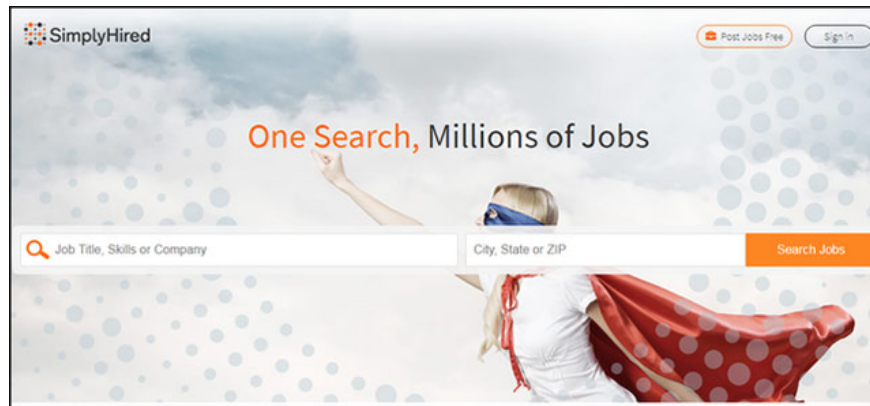
## **Glassdoor.com**

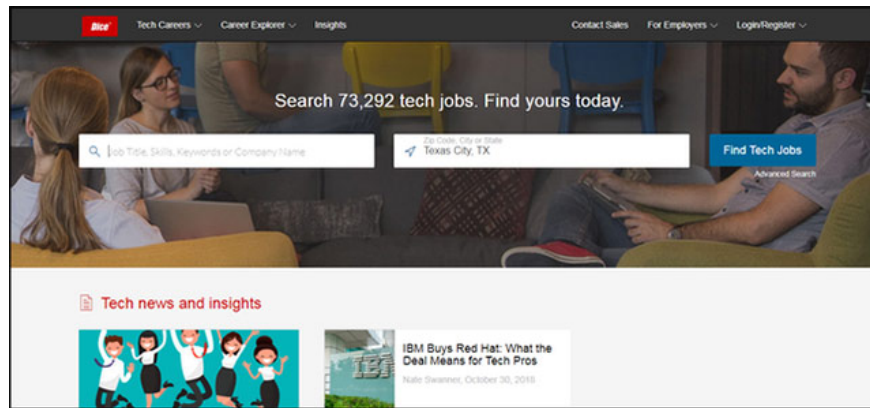

## Dice.com

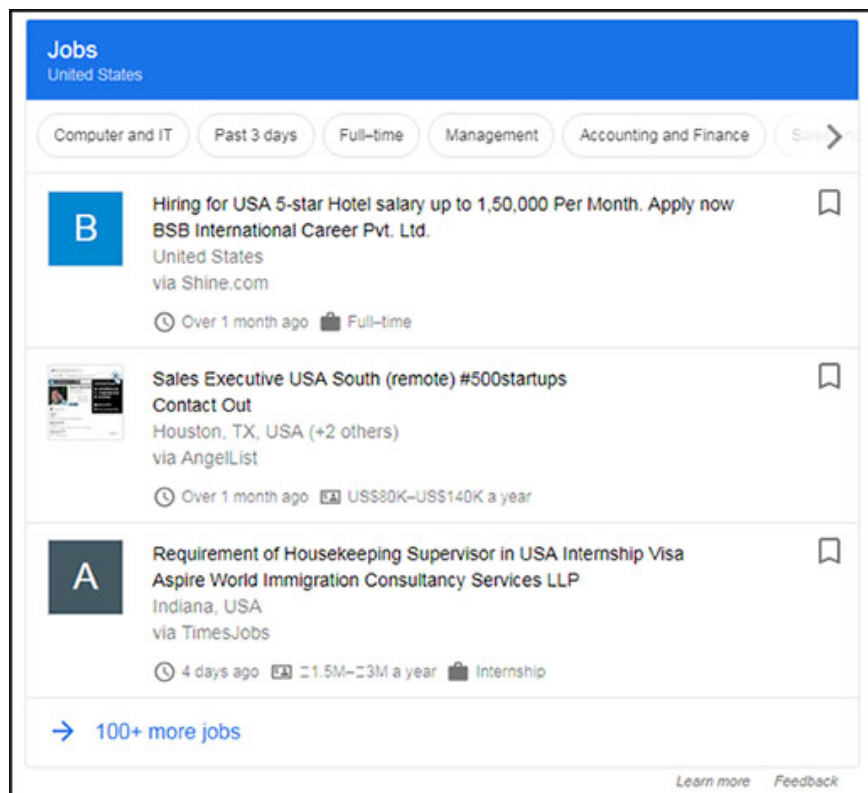

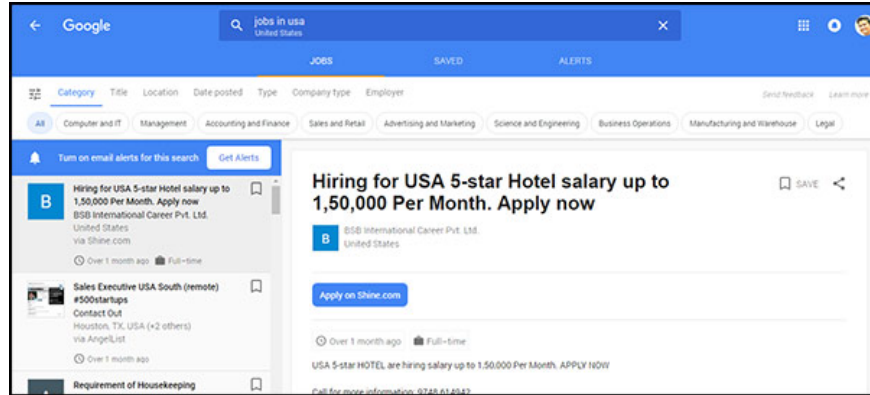
