Top 20+ best shooting games of all time

1. Call of Duty Mobile (2019)

If you are a fan of the Call of Duty shooting game series, you definitely cannot miss Call of Duty Mobile. With this version played on the phone, Call of Duty Mobile still retains the first-person role-playing gameplay, maps, characters and even the weapon system.



However, the game also adds many new and attractive features such as arenas up to 100 players, survival with zombie maps, sniping and sniper shooting, waiting for you to explore.

2. PUBG Mobile

PUBG Mobile, also known as PLAYERUNKNOWN'S BATTLEGROUNDS MOBILE, is currently the most popular online survival shooter game. PUBG Mobile will take players to a vast deserted island with nothing. Here, you will have to hunt other players, find resources such as medicine, weapons, . scattered on the island.



The more items you collect, the stronger your survival ability will be. However, you also need to pay attention to your position, because over time the system will narrow the area of operation. You will die if you stand outside the safe area.

3. Garena Free Fire

Garena Free Fire is an attractive survival shooting game on Android and iOS phones, you will have to fight and win a match with 49 other gamers.



In Garena Free Fire, you can choose your parachute location, collect as many weapons as possible, and ride a vehicle. In addition, the game also has a team mode, where you and 3 other players will form a group of 4 to fight.

4. Valorant

Valorant is a PC game that takes strong inspiration from two popular first-person shooters and refines the formula in a subtle way that only a developer like Riot Games can do. Borrowing but still adding a freshness that keeps players coming back for more.



Simply put, Valorant combines the character-specific superpowers of Overwatch with the intense, brutal tactical shooter model from Counter-Strike: Global Offensive.

5. Half-life: Alyx

Half-life: Alyx does not continue the story of Half-life but takes place 5 years before Half-Life 2. In this part, you will not play as Gordon Freeman - the main character of the series but Alyx Vance, a 19-year-old character fighting in the war against an alien invasion force called the Combine.



Half-life: Alyx is a fantastic VR experience that captures and enhances what makes the Half-life series so special.

6. Counter Strike (2000)

In fact, Counter Strike is the most famous mod in the history of shooting games and was developed by a Vietnamese-Canadian - Le Minh. Even the original creator of Half-Life himself had to admit that the uniqueness and appeal of Counter Strike continues and prolongs the life of their FPS game.



The game Counter Strike continues to be a struggle between two familiar forces: the police and terrorists. With a modern and strategic weapon system, gamers can choose their favorite side through attractive single-player or team modes. Winning the other side will give you useful rewards.

7. Overwatch (2016)

In fact, Overwatch is a game that mixes the genres of FPS and MOBA. However, the shooting action in the game is still the highlight that many people cannot forget. Moreover, it seems that Blizzard's Overwatch is the game that laid the foundation for the combination of genres in shooting games and was a great success.



8. Half-Life 2 (2004)

Mentioning FPS games without mentioning Half-Life, specifically Half-Life 2, is a big omission. The game was developed by Valve to become a legendary shooting game throughout the ages. Although many games of the

same genre were released, they could not overshadow Half-Life 2.



The gameplay in Half Life 2 not only focuses on the Run and Gun action element, besides the fighting scenes, but also includes puzzle solving sections combined with jumping, climbing, interacting with the surrounding environment. In general, the expression of character movements in the game is quite diverse and flexible. You can know and be impressed with the character named Gordon Freeman, a physics doctor who survived a failed experiment that created resonance waves that punctured space. You will follow this character to explore the entire story in the game.

9. Apex Legends

Respawn Entertainment, the developer behind the hit Titanfall series, surprised everyone when it released Apex Legends in 2019. As a free-to-play survival shooter, Apex Legends takes a different path than other games in the genre.



Apex Legends features a cast of characters called Legends with unique skill sets built for teamwork. Some really cool characters and abilities that will keep players engaged for a long time.

10. Battlefield 2142

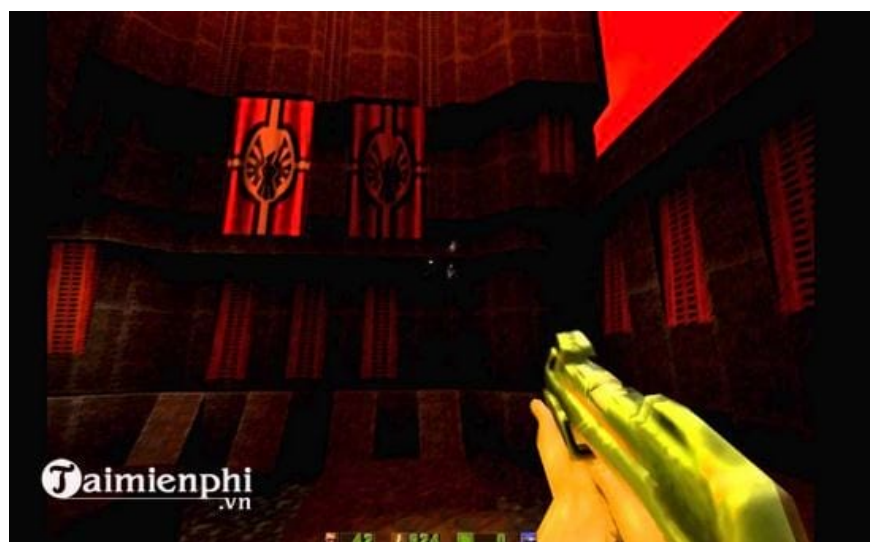
The Battlefield 2142 shooting game is set in World War II, which broke out in 1939 and was released by the famous game company EA. The gameplay of Battlefield 2142 is initially quite simple with single player against AI or when playing online, gamers will have to confront other players.



Players can choose one of the character types such as Scout, Assault, Anti-tank, Medical or Engineer. You will experience the weapons and equipment used in World War 2 such as bombers, submarines, aircraft carriers, armored vehicles. quite interesting. Many campaigns continue in the game Battlefield 1942 taking players on adventures through many historical events of the war.

11. Quake 2

Released in 1997, the best shooting game of all time Quake 2 was highly praised by the gaming community. The game was developed by id Software and launched by Activision. The soundtrack for Quake 2 was provided by Sonic Mayhem.



Quake 2 is a first-person shooter game with familiar mechanics. In it, players shoot and destroy enemies from the perspective of the main character. In terms of movement and control, the player's movement speed is quite slow. You can choose one of 4 powerful weapons: Shotgun, Super Shotgun, Grenade Launcher and Rocket Launcher. As a platform game, id Software's Quake 2 has been recognized by experts for its achievements in developing shooting games.

12. Far Cry

As you may know, Fly Cry 3 is an action-adventure FPS game produced by Ubisoft Montreal in collaboration with Ubisoft Massive. The game was officially released for PC, Xbox 360 and PS3 in 2012. The game quickly received attention and love from players.



The game takes place on a tropical island between two oceans, the Indian Ocean and the Pacific Ocean. The main character in the game is Jason Brody - a warrior who must fight to protect his comrades while fighting pirates and escaping the deadly island. With many interesting game details and bright graphics, Fly Cry 3 is considered a shooting game that will go down in history.

13. BioShock (2007)

A rather strange name to many people, but the top survival shooter game of all time must include BioShock. This game was developed by Irrational Games on PC and Xbox 360 operating systems.



The setting of the zombie shooter BioShock is fictionalized in 1960. At that time, the player takes on the role of a survivor in an underwater city and fights against mutants. In addition to action, the game also has quite attractive adventure, horror and survival elements.

14. Team Fortress 2 (2007)

One shooter product that cannot be missed is Team Fortress 2, which was first released in 2007 by Valve. The game is sold on the Steam portal and EA is responsible for retailing the product.



In Team Fortress 2, players choose one of two teams and choose one of nine characters. Initially, many people commented that the game was too realistic and military. However, this has gradually improved and satisfied players through updated versions.

15. Doom (1993)



A spin-off of the film, Doom is a first-person shooter with a lot of action elements. The game is considered one of the first shooters to pioneer IBM PC-compatible features from 3D graphics, third-dimensional environments, online multiplayer, and support for player-created edits in the Doom WAD format. Since Doom's release in 1993, the series has spawned numerous sequels, expansion packs, and a hit film.

16. Halo 2 (2004)

Halo 2 was developed by Bungie and completed quite early. The game was released for Xbox since November 2004. Meanwhile, the PC version of the game was released in 2007.



Halo 2 is set in the future during a 26th century conflict between the United Nations Space Command and the Genocide Covenant. Players use a combination of weapons and vehicles to carry out operations to complete missions. The health status of the role-playing character will not be represented by a health bar but by a shield index.

17. Wolfenstein

Wolfenstein marks one of the most exciting journeys in the first-person shooter genre. The series has gone through many ups and downs and changes since its release in the 80s.



As you can imagine, a decades-old game series doesn't always have smooth sailing and there are good and bad reviews every time a new installment is released, but Wolfenstein still stands as one of the best FPS games of all time.

18. Arma

Arma is considered the "king" of battlefield simulation shooters. The scale and simulation of the battlefield in the game is outstanding. The greatness of the map is the foundation for the experience that distinguishes Bohemia Interactive's flagship brand from other games.



It's what allows players to pull off headshots from miles away and thrilling convoy raids. It's what makes your eyes spot locations where enemies are hiding.

19. Crysis

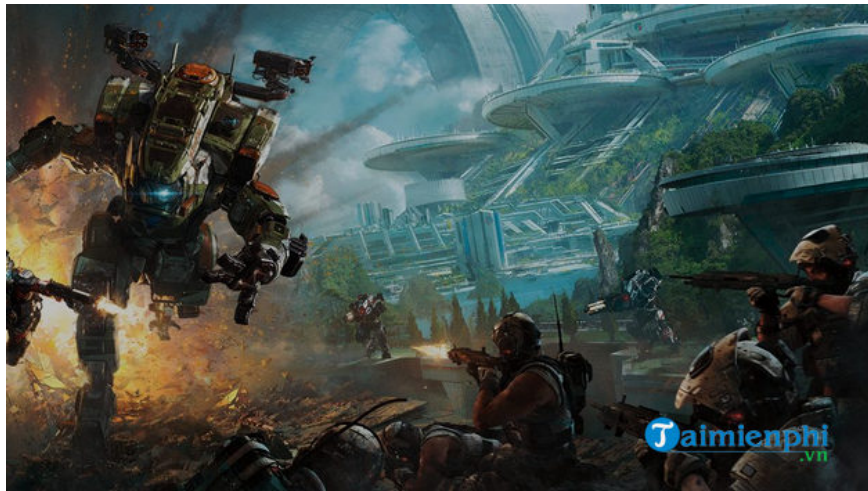
Crysis is consistently ranked among the best-looking FPS games ever made, and it's an amazing shooter. The vast arsenal of weapons, intelligent enemies, and open level design combined with the power of nanosuits make Crysis one of the most exciting shooting arenas around.



Crysis simulates an island and its tropical ecosystem using visual technology so sophisticated that bullets fired through foliage make leaves shiver, while massive explosions thousands of meters away can create clouds of dust that drift over dense jungle canopies like mist.

20. Titanfall

Titanfall is a multiplayer shooter where robots called Titans are summoned from space, where jet-powered pilots appear everywhere along with a beautiful sci-fi setting.



The 3d shooter Titanfall gives you the ability to jump, climb, run on walls and these simple actions create a series of interesting possibilities that you can hardly find the same experience in other games.
