

# Top best gaming keyboards in 2024

You may not have noticed, but keyboards have actually become a lot more complicated and expensive in the past decade or so, especially when it comes to gaming keyboards.

With thousands of models, from hundreds of different brands and spanning all segments, choosing the best gaming keyboard model is not a simple task for most users. Besides, with dozens of styles, design philosophies, as well as a huge set of additional features integrated into modern keyboards, the variety and quality of options available on the market can be overwhelming and 'disorienting'.

Not to mention that there are more and more new manufacturers entering this already crowded and extremely competitive market, making it even more difficult for you to choose a product for yourself. Fit.



However, don't worry too much, hundreds of both in-depth and general tests have been conducted around the world to find the best gaming keyboard models, and now we will point out right here the best gaming keyboard models. The brightest names have gone through many rigorous 'testing rounds'. However, a new problem appears: how do you know what characteristics the keyboard that is right for you contains?

One of the most important considerations you must take into account when choosing a mechanical keyboard is the type of switch it is using. The switch here can be roughly understood as the elastic mechanism of a mechanical keyboard, this mechanism is made up of many different mechanical components. The switches on mechanical keys not only have a lifespan many times longer than regular rubber keys, but also help provide a smooth, sturdy, and especially more accurate typing experience.

However, the switch mechanism on mechanical keyboards will also be divided into many different forms. There are currently 4 types of switches considered the most basic including Blue, Black, Brown, Red that are being chosen by many gamers. In particular, the main differences between switches revolve around the following 3 factors:

1. Tactile: When you press a key, the tip of your finger will feel like it just slid over a notch.
2. Clicky: When pressing the key down, a small clicking sound will be heard.
3. Linear: When you press the key down, there will be no sound, nor will it feel like you just slid over a notch, basically 'slippery'.

Regarding the characteristics of switch types, we can generalize as follows:

#### Blue switch

1. Typing feeling: Tactile + clicky
2. Pressing force: About 35g - 65g
3. Durability: About 50 million clicks

#### Brown switch

1. Typing feeling: Tactile
2. Pressing force: About 25g - 65g
3. Durability: About 50 million clicks

#### Red switch

1. Typing feeling: Linear
2. Pressing force: About 30g - 60g
3. Durability: About 50 million clicks

#### Black switches

1. Typing feeling: Linear
2. Pressing force: About 40g - 80g
3. Durability: About 50 million clicks

There are also many other switch mechanisms on the market, but we will only temporarily list the most commonly used types.
