Type : Wired (USB) | **Features :** 7.1 surround sound, 50mm driver, Dolby DSP, 3.5 mm jack

Advantages:

1. Great overall sound
2. Comfortable to use all day

Defect:

1. Difficult to locate mic

2. The cable may be too long



Recently, the sub brand for Kingston game accessories, HyperX has released their top headphones. Cloud Revolver S headset has a comfortable, hard foam, ear cup frame, an in-line controller with independent adjustment for sound and microphone, adjustable buttons adjust the surround sound. But the outstanding features of this model are its big 50mm drivers, good bass, suitable for the best audiophile headphones on the market. With great sound quality and sound recording and high surround and sound support, you won't find a better headset.

2. Headset of SteelSeries Arctis Pro Wireless (\$ 330)

Type : Wireless (Bluetooth) | **Features :** Dual battery charging system, Bluetooth connection, 40mm driver

Advantages:

1. Lossless audio
2. Convenient dual battery system

Defect:

1. Expensive



Perhaps this is the most expensive headset on this list. SteelSeries Arctis Pro Wireless has many great features such as wired audio support through a standard headphone jack, wireless 2.4GHz radio frequency for non-lag operation with surround sound support and a Bluetooth radio to connect to mobile devices and other devices. The base station manages your connection with an OLED display and a large volume control button. It also has an interchangeable battery charger. This headset comes with two batteries so you can use one to charge, one to use. The attractive Arctis design is thanks to its compact layout, breathable ear cushions and a pull-in microphone. This headset uses 10Hz-40Khz coverage frequency, making sound quality better.

3. SteelSeries Arctis Pro headset (USD 159)

Type : Wired (USB) | **Features :** 40mm driver, pullable mic, DTS Headphone: X v2.0, RGB light, DAC

Advantages:

1. Comes with DAC
2. Audiophile sound

Defect:

1. Surround sound is not great



If there is something you can trust at SteelSeries, it is pristine sound and SteelSeries Arctis Pro is the best proof. This headset not only provides surround sound for all actions in the game, but also serves well for common music purposes thanks to the included DAC (Digital to Audio Converter - electronic signal converter into sound). This headset is a bit expensive, but when you consider the comfort and features it offers, it's not hard to explain why it is one of the best gaming headsets.

4. Logitech G Pro headset (\$ 90)

Type : Wired (Analog) | **Features :** Passive noise suppression, Pro-G drivers, removable microphone, Dolby Atmos support

Advantages:

1. Lightweight design
2. Comfortable for long use

Defect:

1. The bass is too loud



Logitech G Pro headphones bring great sound quality even when used for a long time. It costs about 90 USD (65 Euro, 115 Australian dollars). Logitech ensures the money you spend deserves great sound and comfort when used and does not waste on flashy RGB light or other frivolous features.

5. Astro A20 headset (130 USD)

Type : Wireless | **Features** : Good battery life, Astro Command Center software, compatibility with game consoles

Advantages:

1. High quality sound
2. Comfortable to use

Defect:

1. More expensive than the same kind of headphones



Wireless Astro A20 headphones deliver great stereo sound with an impressive battery life of up to 15 hours. This is a headset with all the necessary features you need at this price. It does not support surround sound but compensates for long battery life and savings.

6. Creative Sound BlasterX H7 Tournament Edition headset (USD 129)

Type : Wired (USB and Analog) | **Features** : 50mm driver, using reinforced and aluminum materials, flexible removable mic

Advantages:

1. Very comfortable
2. Clear sound, honest

Defect:

1. No balance between Mid and High tones



Over the years, Creative has made a name for its sound products. Instead of just sitting and repeating the winning formula of previous products, Creative changed and created the Sound BlasterX H7 headset with good sound quality. If you're looking for a deep, comfortable audio headset, try Creative Sound BlasterX H7 Tournament Edition. Especially at a price like this, it is one of the best gaming headsets worth buying.

7. HyperX Cloud Flight headset (160 USD)

Type : Wireless | **Features :** Long battery life, durable adjustable slider, PC and PS4 compatible, removable noise canceling microphone

Advantages:

1. Battery life up to 30 hours
2. Excellent sound quality

Defect:

1. Put more than competitors



HyperX Cloud Flight is a wireless gaming headset with a long battery life of up to 30 hours, meaning you can play games for two days without charging. However, unlike the Astro A20 competitor of Cloud Flight, HyperX Cloud Flight only provides stereo sound.

8. c (99 USD)

Type : Wireless | **Features :** Corsair CUE, 7.1 surround sound, one-way microphone certified Discord

Advantages:

1. Great sound for playing games
2. Mic supports ducking

Defect:

1. Can't store the mic



Corsair released one of the best gaming headsets late last year, Corsair HS50. And now it makes the headset even better by using wireless and surround sound support. These features will create a great gaming headset but the more you add Corsair CUE software, the better.

9. Corsair Void Pro RGB Wireless Headset (USD 137)

Type : Wireless | **Features :** 50mm driver, noise canceling microphone, RGB light, Dolby Headphone 7.1

Advantages:

1. Excellent sound quality
2. Beautiful design



Not long ago, Corsair was known only for PC components, but over the past five years, they have become more popular with gaming peripherals. For products like the Corsair Void RGB Wireless, it's not hard to explain why. Void Pro RGB Wireless offers excellent quality, realistic sound, and perhaps most importantly, RGB light at such a price. In addition, if you already have Corsair's other peripherals, Void Pro RGB Wireless is suitable and can even synchronize lighting effects with other peripherals via the Corsair Utility Engine.

10. Corsair HS50 Stereo Headset (50 USD)

Type : Wired (analog) | **Features :** 50mm driver, mute control and easy, multi-platform compatible headphone output

Advantages:

1. Powerful stereo sound
2. Great value

Defect:

1. Mic is easily lost



As a general rule when you buy anything, you pay what is received. You can't buy a headset for \$ 50 and expect many booming features. However, at such a price, the Corsair HS50 offers excellent sound quality and mic quality while other headphone competitors sell twice the price. If you're looking for a cheap gaming headset and don't mind leaving 7.1 surround sound and Bluetooth connectivity features, try Corsair HS50.

11. Beyerdynamic Custom Game Headset (USD 199)

Type : Wired (3.5mm) | **Features :** Sound Slider, soft ear cushions, interchangeable design covers, removable cables

Advantages:

1. Extremely comfortable
2. Impressive sound quality

Defect:

1. Slightly expensive



Although the price is quite expensive, but Beyerdynamic CUSTOM GAME is one of the best gaming headsets. It does not feature flashy or wireless surround sound, but in return it has two outstanding features: sound quality and comfort.

12. Turtle Beach Elite Pro Tournament headphones (USD 200)

Type : Wired (USB and 3.5mm) | **Features :** Multi-platform support, 50mm driver

Advantages:

1. Comfortable
2. Good sound quality

Defect:

1. Slightly expensive



This headset offers gamers comfort when in use, providing superior sound quality thanks to its 50mm driver. Its design is plastic and has eye-catching orange accents.

13. Razer ManO'War headset (60 USD)

Type : Wireless | **Features :** Software-based 7.1 surround sound, earcup-mounted control buttons, Chroma RGB multicolor light, 14 meters range

Advantages:

1. Great surround sound
2. Easy to set up
3. Multi-colored lighting

Defect:

1. Slightly bulky
2. There is no wired option



Quick and easy to set up using a wireless USB receiver stored inside the headset for transport, the Razer ManO'War is a user-friendly device designed to play surround sound games. . It has a slightly bulky appearance compared to other headsets, but the two ear tubers are made of soft leather that makes it comfortable to wear for a long time.

14. Astro A50 Wireless headset (290 USD)

Type : Wireless | **Features :** Dolby Digital 7.1 surround sound; Works with PS4, Xbox One, Xbox 360, PS3, PC and mobile; Astro Audio; 5.8GHz wireless technology with MixAmp; mic for eliminating single-directional noise 6mm; Charge USB with base station

Advantages:

1. Full Dolby 7.1 surround sound
2. Extremely comfortable

Defect:

1. Finnick charging dock



Astro's latest headphones have a compact design and add wireless connectivity. It can work on PC, PS4, Xbox One and other antique gaming machines.

15. Asus ROG Centurion 7.1 headset (USD 275)

Type : Wired (USB) | **Features :** 7.1-driver surround sound 7.1, two-port USB amplifier, compatibility with Sonic software, HDMI passthrough, amplifier with audio configuration and volume control, unidirectional microphone

Advantages:

1. Great space sound
2. Speaker passthrough

Defect:

1. Can only be used with its amplifier
2. Heavy and bulky



Ignoring all the traditional aesthetics, ROG Centurion 7.1 is a great headset. Although the setup process is not easy, it is one of the darkest gaming headsets for unique style and great sound. The onboard amplifier controller of the Asus ROG Centurion 7.1 gives you complete control of sound, and this "beast" can even enhance its excellent sound for an external speaker set.

16. Logitech G430 headset (39 USD)



For about \$ 40, Logitech's G430 headset has 40mm drivers, provides great sound and a fold-down microphone to make good sound when doing group talk. You can use this headset with standard audio and mic cables, but the in-line controller plugs into the USB port that can activate surround sound on Dolby or DTS standards (this is not a common feature at all). This price). This headset is comfortable to use thanks to a replaceable net cloth on the ear tub and its long cable that helps you to route to avoid being affected by settings on your computer. If you want to find an even cheaper headset, you can try the G230 model with the same features except surround sound and in-line control.

17. Cougar Megara headset (35 USD)



If you like a smaller earbud for gaming and enjoy the combination of a stereo sound quality and a USB microphone, you'll love the Megara's Cougar headset. The portable earbud headset provides a removable microphone for communication during game play. Just like any other portable earbud, it comes with an optional ear clip and a multi-size silicon tip so you can choose the most suitable one. It's compact so it's not supported by surround sound, but 13.5mm drivers provide greater sound than other earbuds. For listening while on the move, Megara has inline media controls and a second mic, so you can make calls without carrying a mic.
