TOP biome has the most beautiful scenery in Minecraft 1.18

Meadow

This beautiful biome is a great candidate for base building. It is a biome with endless fields of flowers and grass. Grasslands are commonly found at the base of mountains, where they intersect with plains biomes.

Oak and birch trees have a small chance of appearing here, but if they do, 100% of the players will find the hive. This is the only mountain biome where villages can spawn. Passive mobs like rabbits, donkeys and sheep also spawn here.

Old Growth Taiga

Old Growth Taiga features giant Taiga trees, a cooler version of the jungle biome. Similar to other jungle biomes, Old Growth Taiga develops in locations with very high humidity and is often surrounded by common taiga biomes.

This is a great biome to get up and running in Minecraft 1.18. Old Growth Taiga has giant trees everywhere, making it easy to collect wood.

Furthermore, the player can tame wolves for attack purposes and capture rabbits for rabbit farms. There are also podzol blocks that allow the fungus to grow in all light levels.

Lush Cave

Lush Cave is a variant of an underground cave biome with unique flora. The cave floor is covered with Dripleaf leaves, while the ceiling is where the Glow Berry grows. Players can find Glow Fish, Axolotl and Tropical Fish here. This biome can be found underground, beneath the Azalea trees.

Warped Forest

Warped Forest is a palette swap of the Crimson Forest in the Nether, with giant cyan mushrooms. Only Endermen appear here, making this biome pretty safe to explore if the character has a pumpkin helmet.

Overall, this biome is pretty nice and perfect for building a base in the Nether. This is the only biome in the game that doesn't have music. Hoglin is afraid of warped mushrooms so can be useful for navigating around the Nether.

Warm Ocean

Warm Ocean has a blue water tone in its surface and appears next to deserts and Badland. It is filled with tropical fish, puffer fish and squid. Unlike other ocean biomes, Warm Ocean looks incredibly beautiful with coral reefs and a variety of other fish. This is the only biome in Minecraft where the player can find a coral reef.

Roofed Forest

Roofed Forest is a variation of biome Forest, with some additional features. In general, the trees and giant mushrooms in this biome are very dense, which can make it difficult to move around.

The plants in this biome are very large, preventing sunlight from reaching the ground. As you make your way through the dense forest, prepare to battle countless mobs in super nasty terrain.
