

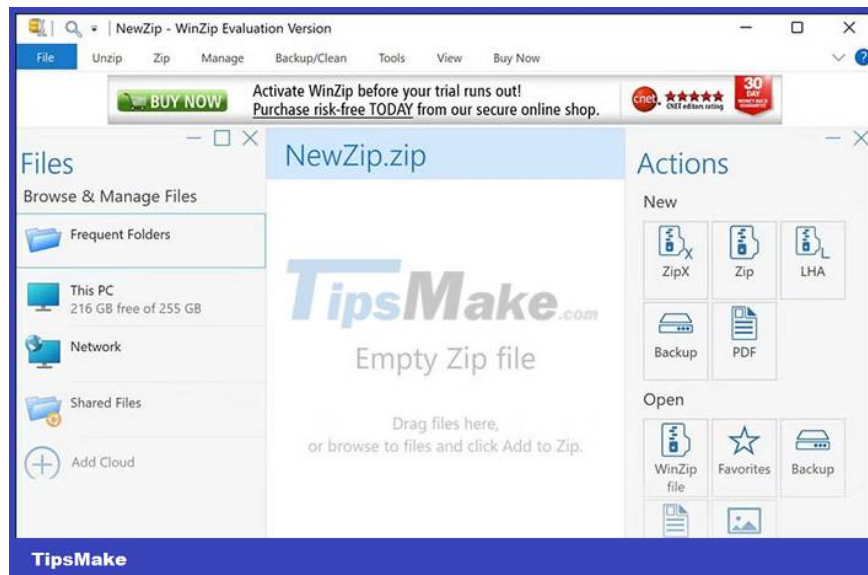
TOP file decompression tools for Windows

WinZip

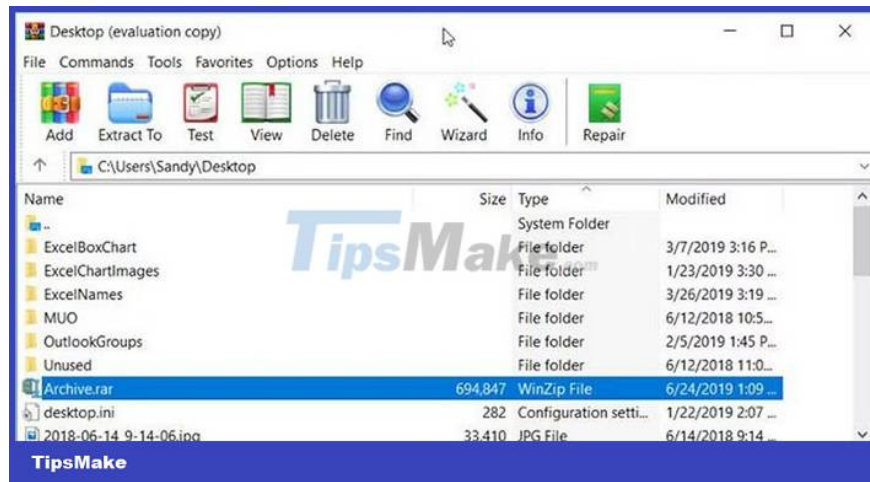

WinRAR

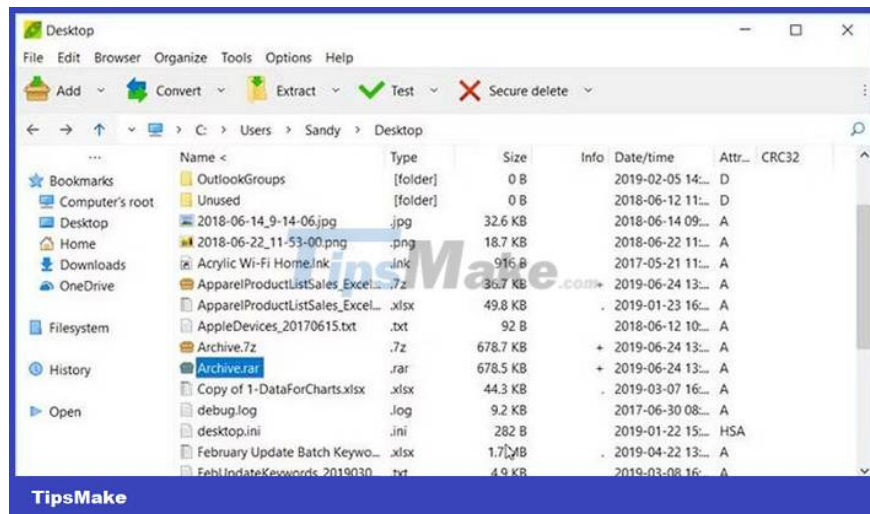

PeaZip

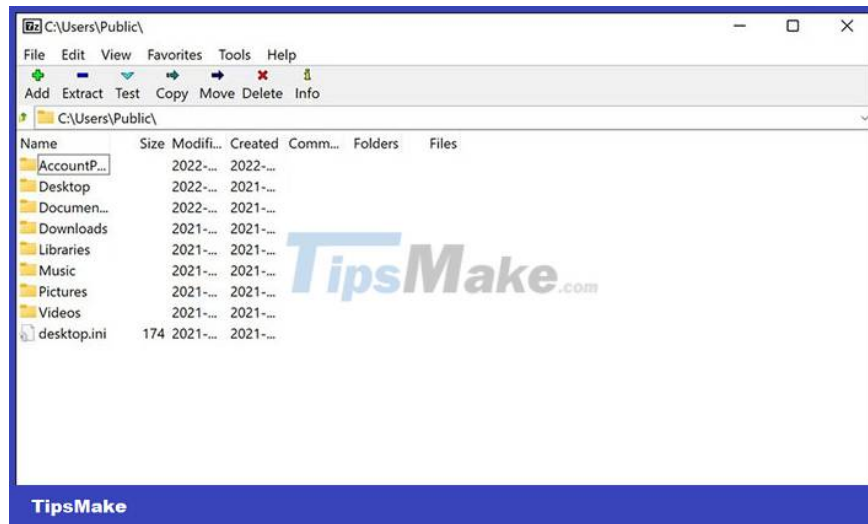

7-Zip

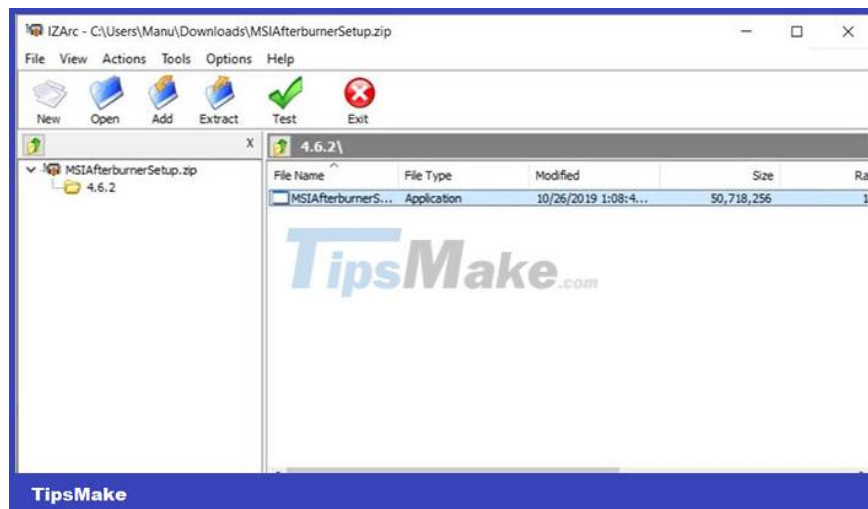
After WinRAR, 7-Zip is the most popular tool for extracting RAR files. The intuitive interface with minimalist design makes using this software easy.



In terms of usefulness, 7-Zip supports all major archive formats and allows users to decompress multi-capacity files. This freeware also offers AES 256-bit encryption. Currently, this tool is only available for Windows and can be downloaded on both 32-bit and 64-bit Windows operating systems.

IZArc

Packed with features but still very lightweight, IZArc is a great file decompression tool. Its features rival those of leading tools like WinRAR, all without a major impact on system performance. The interface is easy on the eyes and doesn't contain any glitchy animations.



IZArc allows to expand disks, create self-extracting archives, and add comments to archives. In addition, it also contains typical features one would expect from a file extractor, such as zip encryption, virus scanning, and creation of multi-volume archives.
