Demon's Souls

If Elden Ring is people's first experience of the Soulsborne genre, a good game to try next would be Demon's Souls. This is where it all started back on the PS3 back in 2009, introducing players to the core elements that would define the next games.



PS5 owners can choose to experience the 2020 remake. Developed by Bluepoint Games, the remake is a faithful reinterpretation of the original game with a graphical overhaul to take full advantage of the possibilities. of PS5.

Dark Souls 3

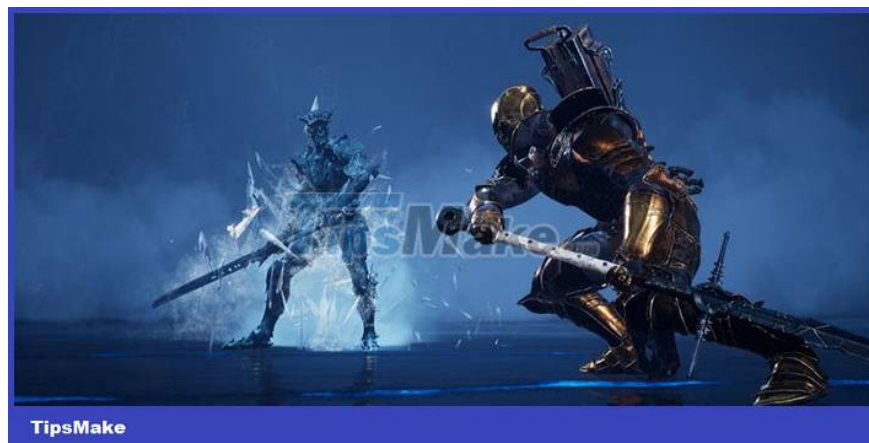
While Dark Souls originally served as an improvement on the gameplay mechanics first introduced in Demon's Soul, it is actually the third and final installment of the Dark Souls trilogy. Dark Souls 3 is the current pinnacle of what the Soulsborne game stands for.



Released in 2016, the game puts gamers in the shoes of a cursed undead (known as the Ashen One) as they battle through a land filled with poisonous swamps and menacing dragons. The game had two expansions, Ashes of Ariandel and The Ringed City, before being re-released with both DLCs, titled Dark Souls 3: The Fire Fades.

Mortal Shell

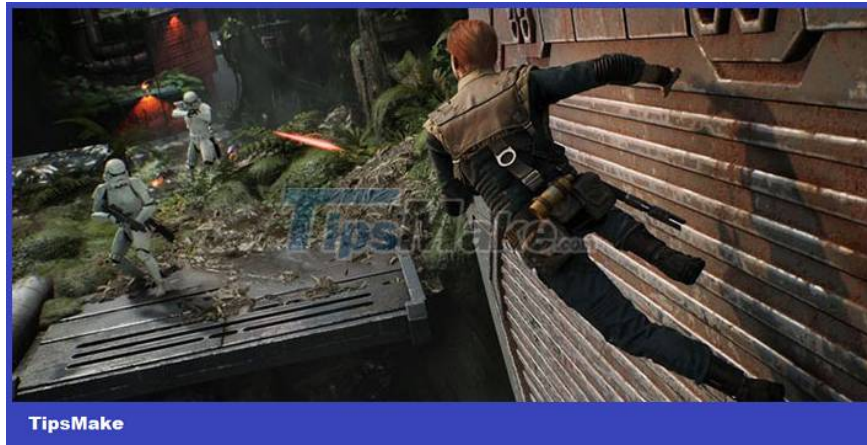
Soulsborne fans will enjoy Mortal Shell, an action role-playing game released in 2020 as the debut game from indie development studio, Cold Symmetry. The game takes a lot of inspiration from the Dark Souls trilogy but offers a level of accessibility that wasn't previously available in other games.



Mortal Shell went on to earn a nomination for Best New Game Launch at The Game Awards 2020, ultimately losing out to Kinetic Games' Phasmophobia. An update to the game called Rotting Autumn was also released, featuring new missions and photo modes, followed by a remake released for PS5 and Xbox Series X/S in 2021.

Star Wars Jedi: Fallen Order

Star Wars fans got to enjoy one of the best games, based on billions of dollars in resources, when Jedi Fall Order was released in 2019. Set in the midst of the events of Revenge of the Sith and A New Hope, which features Cal Kestis, a Jedi Padawan struggling to survive after the onslaught of Order 66.



The game itself is a mix of various genres, but most surprising is the inclusion of Soulsborne elements, by way of challenging combat and moderate difficulty.

While Star Wars Jedi: Fallen Order may not be as top-notch as what can be found in the Elden Ring, they still have a calming effect on gamers looking for similar games.

Bloodborne

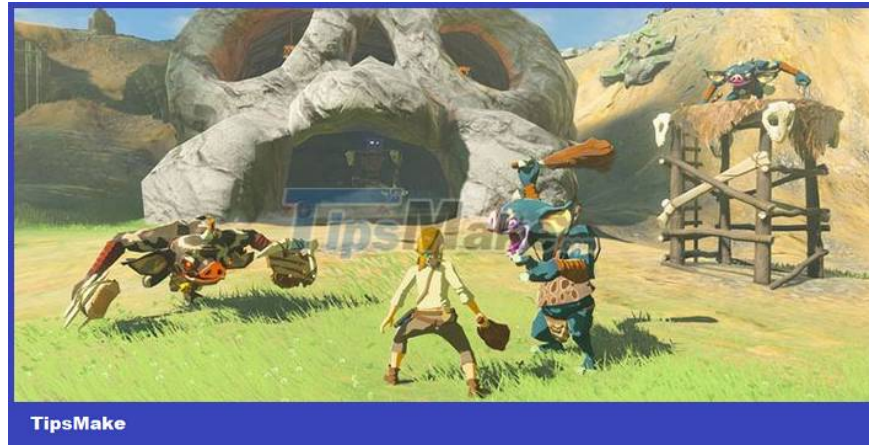
Often considered one of the best PS4 exclusives, Bloodborne is an action RPG that will instantly appeal to Elden Ring players. Released in 2015, the game puts the player in the role of a Hunter, who must battle various creatures that have taken over the Gothic city of Yharnam.



Unlike the Dark Souls games, combat in Bloodborne is much faster paced. However, players often face multiple enemies at once. It's still a game that strikes a balance between being challenging without being too hard.

The Legend of Zelda: Breath Of The Wild

Simply put, The Legend of Zelda: Breath of the Wild is one of the few games that sits at the pinnacle of open-world game design. It has set a new standard for the genre, and it may take a long time for gamers to experience a game capable of following in the footsteps of this game.



Like the Elden Ring, Breath of the Wild takes players on an adventure in a large and beautiful open world, giving them the freedom to approach the massive sandbox however they want.

It also poses its own challenges in the form of breakable weapons, and enemies will shoot the player a lot if not careful. So there is no reason to try this open world game masterpiece.
