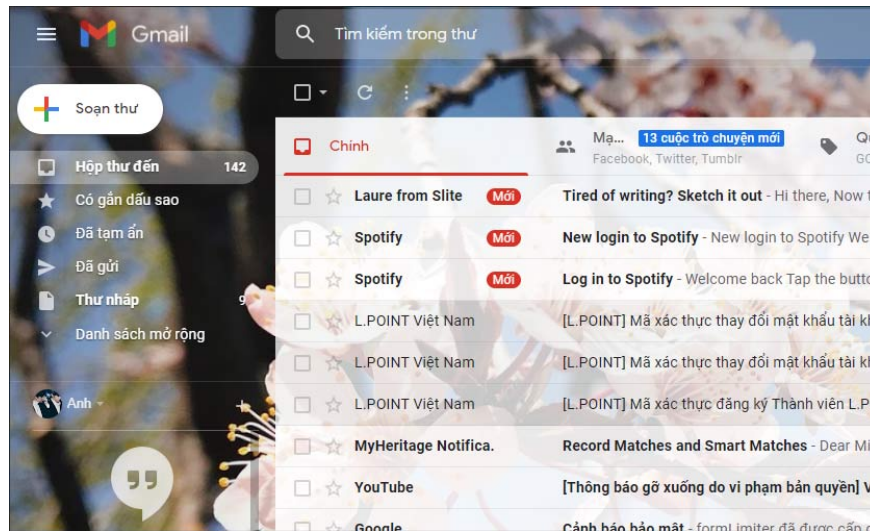
1. Gmail

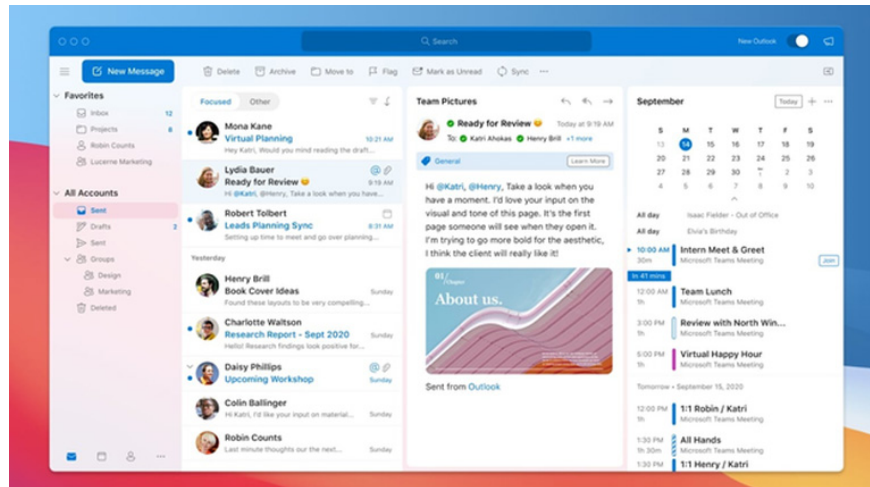
1. Automatic email filter

Notable features:

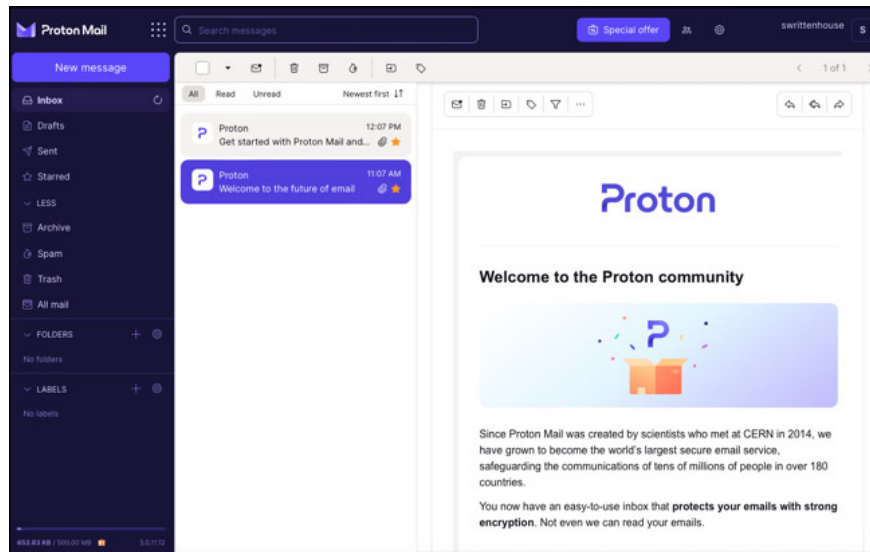
1. Schedule emails

Additionally, ProtonMail is also open source and tested by third parties, providing PhishGuard anti-phishing, link protection, device-level security, etc.



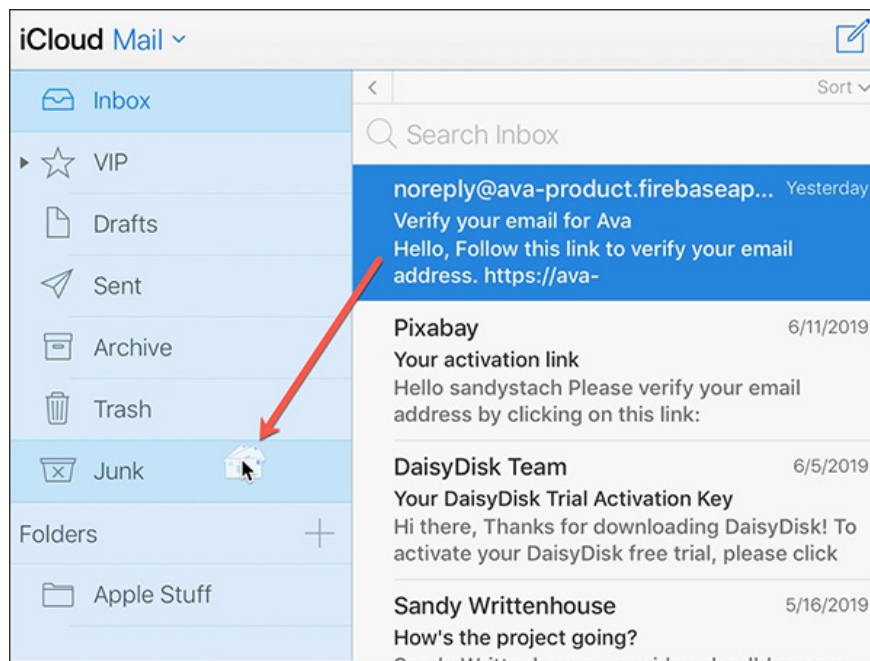
Notable features:

6. Automatically sync and share encrypted files with Proton Drive
7. Medium speed VPN connection
8. Track pixel blocking and IP address hiding with a web app
9. 2FA uses hardware security keys

Cons: ProtonMail prides itself on security and privacy. So you may not see as many features as other email services like scheduling or recalling emails.

4. iCloud Mail

iCloud Mail is a mail service for those who are using Apple devices with high security and safety with Apple ID. When creating an iCloud mail account, we can access the iCloud Mail account using the Mail application on iPhone, iPad, iPod touch, Mac computer. The default email address will end in @icloud.com.



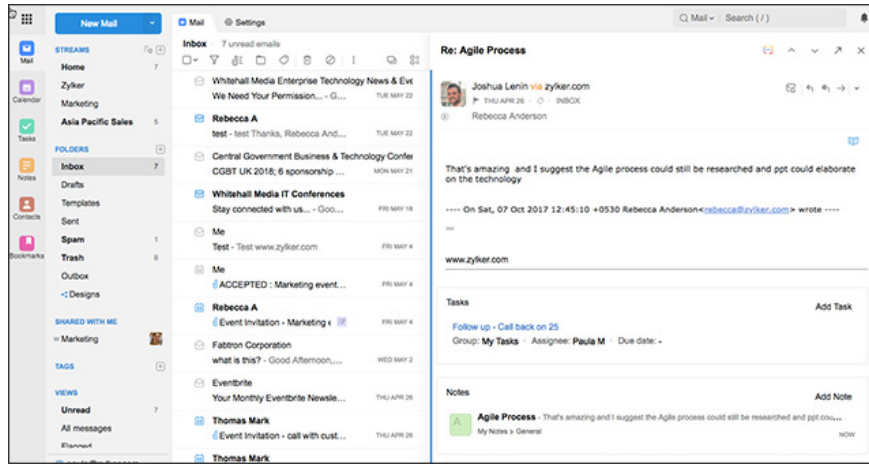
Outstanding features:
