

Top ranked easy generals in League of Legends 9.24 in every position

These are the appropriate generals for you to climb the rank in every position in League of Legends 9.24 this time.

After a few changes in the League of Legends preseason, we have seen many generals take the throne in their proper positions. Such as the Darius - Mordekaiser - Garen trio in the top or the middle with Kassadin and Senna in the bottom .

However, with the adjustments in League of Legends version 9.24, we have added a few other emerging names to be able to replace the above options. Here are the team of 5 most useful generals that help gamers climb the rank based on the position played in League of Legends 9.24

1. How to view detailed history of the Arena of Truth, the history of League of Legends
2. Configuration play League of Legends Express
3. Collection of Draven wallpapers for computers and laptops

Champions rank well in League of Legends 9.24 in every position

Gunner - Aphelios



Why is Aphelios on this list when he is a new champion, and Aphelios's win rate is very low. But if you use Aphelios well, you will find him quite strong in this position.

Aphelios is a hard-to-play champion, or rather, he has a fairly complex set of skills. Requires high personal skills in players. However, the ability of a player to decide in specific situations must be accurate and fast will help you increase Aphelios' win rate in the position of a Gunner.

Support - Braum



The things that Braum received in the previous version are not noticeable. But that alone is enough to help him become an option in the position of Support without being too strong to be imbalanced.

Specifically, Braum has increased base health per level and heals. These buff stats are still poor compared to other high level Support generals in the current meta game. It is easy to understand because this is one of the generals that is popular with professional gamers, so Riot Games does not buff too much for Braum.

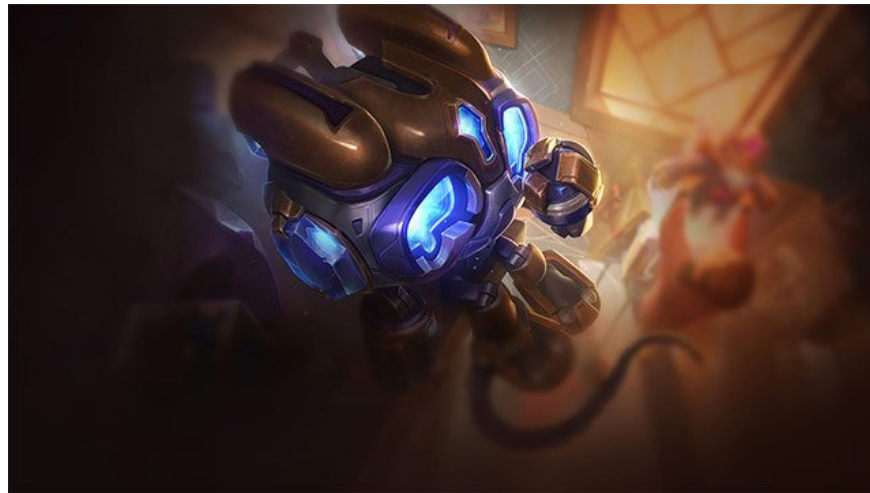
Mid lane - Cassiopeia



Kassadin is the champion that plays in the mid lane when he benefits from the meta. With the return of the wizards, Kassadin will not gain much respect. Moreover, he has just been nerfed in League of Legends version 9.24, Kassadin will no longer be a worrying opponent of the wizards.

Now we need a replacement, Cassiopeia is the nominee. A champion that is emerging recently with a combination of the Conqueror pearl. Although it has been nerfed, when combined with Cassiopeia, the power is still very significant. Compared to her with other ranged champions, Xa Nu was still a bit faster in speed, so she could stack faster. So although not as strong as before, she is still very strong when combined with the Conqueror pearl.

Amumu - Amumu



In this version of League of Legends 9.24, Mummy melancholy buffs reduce cooldown Q early in the match. Enables him to increase maneuverability to increase the ability to stick to the target and move around the jungle faster.

But above all, Amumu still possesses great ganking ability and the ability to control the crowd when the teamfight. With this buff, hope to help Amumu not have to "struggle" to make a living in the early game.

Top lane - Ornn



The conqueror's jade drop in power in 9.24 has made many generals such as Mordekaiser, Darius and Garen once dominated the top lane when combined with the Conqueror pearl in version 9.23 now not so strong as before, although still can be pick in the top position.

That makes Ornn's name emerging gradually in this top position. He has a pretty high win rate, up to 52.63% and a play rate of 9.75%, which is not a bad number.

Those are the names that you should pick according to your forte in the League of Legends version 9.24 this time to climb easier.
