

TOP rarest mobs in Minecraft

Minecraft's block world is very much alive with countless creatures, called mobs, that live in it. Some mobs are neutral or even player-friendly, while there are hostile mobs that are constantly trying to kill the player.

Some mobs like Zombie or Chicken, which are extremely common, appear everywhere but there are also mobs that are so rare, many longtime gamers haven't even seen them. Let's explore the list of rarest mobs in Minecraft.

TOP rarest mobs in Minecraft

Zoglin



Zoglin is a scary mutant monster mob

Hoglins are sadistic pig mobs that lurk in certain biomes in the Nether and can be killed for meat. In extreme cases, a Hoglin enters the Overworld, which after a few seconds transforms into a zombified version of itself called a Zoglin.

Zoglin resembles Hoglins, but with some rotten green patches and lack of flesh. These powerful zombie monsters will attack anything they see, so players need to make sure their portals are safe from any roaming Hoglins.

Evoker



Evoker is the leader of Pillager

Players will rarely see Evokers in raids. It is this extremely powerful magic-using mob that only appears in the last few rounds of the biggest battle.

Evokers are fearsome and rare enemies. If you kill an Evoker, you will earn a Totem of Undying – one of the most powerful items in Minecraft.

Evokers can also be found in Woodland Mansion, where a few mobs guard the upper rooms. However, Evokers are rare in Woodland Mansion, with an average of one mob every 10,000 blocks.

Polar Bear



Polar Bears are quite docile mobs, unless someone tries to attack their children

Polar Bears are not noticed by many people due to their rarity. These gentle giant mobs roam the biomes as cold as the frozen ocean. Characters can walk thousands of blocks without seeing any Polar Bears.

If you are lucky enough to find this mob, watch out because if an adult bear thinks people are a threat to its cubs, it will attack the character.

Parrot



Parrot can imitate surrounding sounds

Parrots are one of Minecraft's tameable mobs. When one is obtained, it will sit on the character's shoulder - one of the loveliest mob behaviors in the game. Parrot will also mimic the sounds of other mobs it hears, which is a cool, though terrifying feature in the event it hears a Creeper approaching behind it.

However, catching a parrot is not too much of a feat. Gamers will have to look in the forest, the game's rarest biome, walking around it until they find an adorable little bird. Fortunately, their distinctive calls make them easier to find when nearby.

Ocelot



Ocelot can be tamed into a very cute spotted cat

Ocelots can previously be tamed and turned into cats, the same way wolves become dogs. This was changed when real cats were added, but Ocelot is still a tameable mob. However, if you want to make one of these spotted cats your friend, be prepared to spend some time hunting.

The forests that Ocelot is in are very rare and this mob also rarely spawns in them. Also, the poor visibility of the forests, and the tracking of Ocelot, make this a nightmare quest, but it's well worth it for the player to get such a cute mob companion.

Electric Creeper



Charged Creeper is one of the most dangerous enemies in Minecraft

Charged Creeper (Electric Creeper) is a mob that can only spawn if interacted in a special way. To create a Charged Creeper, you need to hit the Creeper with a trident with lightning while it's thundering. This way, a lightning bolt will strike the Creeper and spawn its electric version. The explosion caused by a Charged Creeper is twice as powerful as an explosion caused by a regular Creeper. This is why this is one of the most dangerous enemies in Minecraft.

Brown panda



Brown pandas are quite scarce

Pandas in Minecraft have two "genes" that determine their appearance and behavior when breeding. Each group of genes will produce a different panda. The brown gene is the weakest, so the chance for a brown panda to appear is only 1 in 64. The reason for this scarcity is that only the combination of two brown genes produces brown pandas.

Killer Rabbit



Killer Bunny is the enemy of the player, fox and wolf

Killer Bunny - The Killer Rabbit (formerly known as the Caerbannog Killer Rabbit, in reference to Monty Python and the Holy Grail) is a rare mob added to the game as part of the 1.8 update. The killer rabbit is the enemy of the player, fox and wolf. They have white fur and red horizontal eyes, which are different from the vertical eyes of normal rabbits. You can only spawn the killer rabbit with the command `/summon rabbit ~ ~ ~ {RabbitType:99}'` because it has been removed from the Minecraft spawn list.

Brown Mooshroom Beef



Mooshroom is a cow variant dedicated to a rare mushroom field

Mooshroom is a cow variant with a full body of mushrooms, dedicated to a field of rare mushrooms. There are two variants of Mooshrooms - red and brown, but brown Mooshroom cows spawn naturally. You need to use a trident enchanted with lightning when it's thundering in order for the lightning to hit the cow. The red version will turn brown and vice versa.

Pink sheep



Chances of getting pink sheep are extremely rare

4 out of 5 sheep are white, with an 81.836% chance of spawning. Black, gray and light gray variants, each with a 5% chance of spawning or a 15% chance of spawning together. Brown sheep are quite rare, only 3% chance to spawn. However, the pink sheep are the rarest - there is only a 0.164% chance to spawn naturally. 5% of sheep lay eggs when young. This means that a pink lamb is even rarer, with only a 0.0082% chance of spawning. So the chance of getting them is extremely rare.
