

Top useful advertising networks for blogs and websites.

When your blog or website has a large and stable readership, you should immediately look for an advertising network to earn money online. So, which advertising networks are most trusted by bloggers today? This article from TipsMake will introduce you to the top useful advertising networks for blogs and websites!

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1. *Google AdSense*

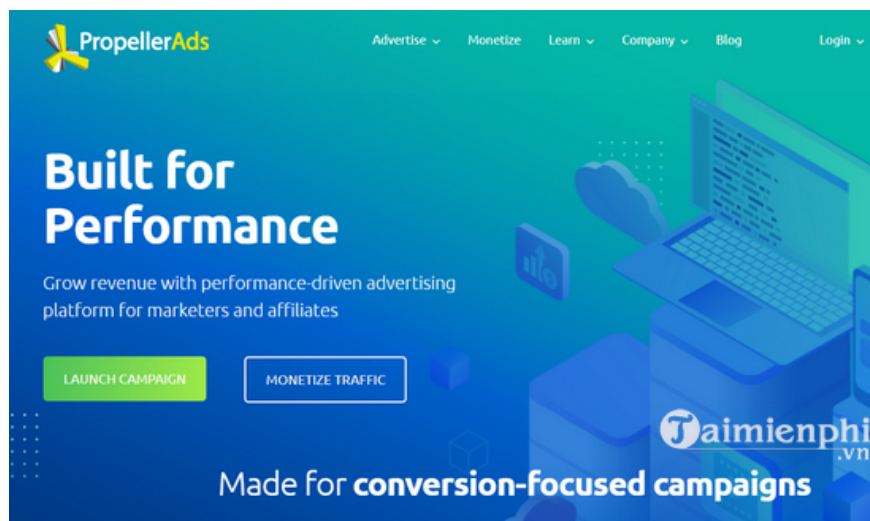


Google AdSense is a well-known advertising network used by most publishers worldwide. Bloggers use AdSense extensively because it's easy to use, has secure features, and offers high-quality ads. Google AdSense will pay you when you earn \$100 or more, and you can receive payments via Western Union, bank transfer, EFT, etc. AdSense also has a Net30 payment policy, meaning payments are processed and sent to customers within 30 days.

Many people want to use AdSense to earn money online on their websites. However, getting AdSense approval is not easy at all because you must strictly adhere to the following regulations:

- Use a custom domain name for your website
- Integrate Google Analytics with your website
- Wait at least 6 months before submitting a newly created website to start earning money.

2. Propellers Ad




Bloggers who manage their site activity via phone, desktop, social media, etc., will be frequent users of Propellers Ads because it's an easy-to-join ad network with quick approval times. Propellers Ads provides fast, real-time reporting and can be used across mobile and social media platforms.

Propellers Ad leverages various ad types such as pop-up ads, pop-under ads, dialog boxes, etc., and applies an 80:20 revenue sharing ratio for all publishers. Furthermore, the cost of displaying an ad ranges from \$1 to \$10, depending on the geographical location of visitors to your website.

Regarding payment methods, Propellers Ad will process your payment via bank transfer, PayPal, PayZa, Payoneer, etc. For bank transfers, you must reach a minimum balance of \$550, and for other payment methods, you must reach a minimum balance of \$100 before Propellers Ad will process your payment.

However, the biggest drawback of Propellers Ads is that the frequent use of pop-up and pop-under ads can sometimes be annoying for website visitors. On the other hand, you can benefit greatly from these advertising methods, especially when the ads are displayed in specific geographic areas.

3. *Media.net*



Media.net is a reputable advertising company trusted by major publishers such as the NY Daily News, Forbes, Meredith, and Reuters. It is a well-known contextual advertising network because it runs on the contextual advertising platforms of Bing and Yahoo.

Media.net is a top choice for small and medium-sized blogs. However, to join Media.net, you will need to meet certain requirements:

- The blog must be in English.
- The content must be original, high-quality, and relevant to the readers.
- Blog content must be updated regularly.
- No adult content
- . - Avoid excessive advertising.
- Do not host chat rooms or forums on the blog/website.

Once you're approved by Media.net, they'll provide you with an account manager so you can customize your ads and manage revenue reports. Media.net will pay you when you earn at least \$100. Payments are processed according to Net30's policy and via PayPal or bank transfer.

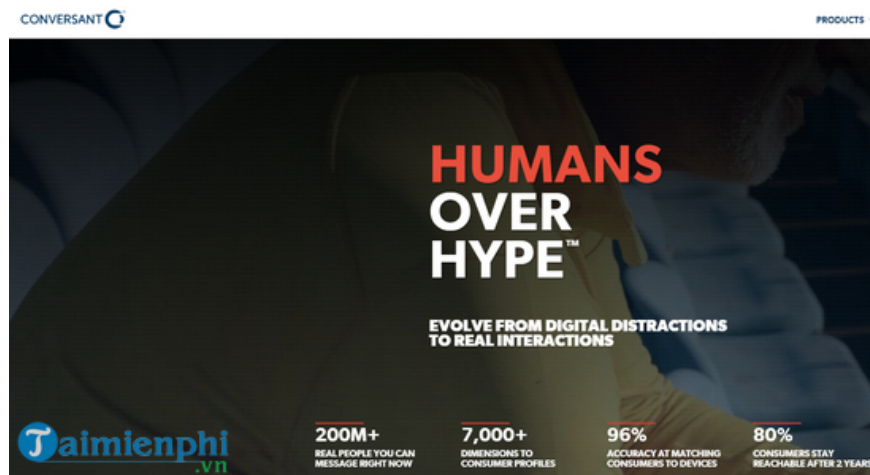
4. *Conversation Media*

Conversant Media is a popular advertising network that start-up bloggers should consider because of its relatively simple membership policy and high-quality ads from major brands. To join Conversant Media, you need to meet the following requirements:

- The blog must have at least 3000 visitors per month.
- The site must display original, high-quality content and be regularly updated.
- The websites must be in English only.

Conversant Media makes payments via PayPal, transferring funds according to the Net60 policy (processing and payment takes 60 days) when bloggers reach \$25. However, many bloggers say they received their money within 25 days.

5. Technorati Media



Bloggers who are very active on social media should choose Technorati Media because this company is one of the largest social media advertising networks in the world and is known for the quality of its ads. To be approved by Technorati Media, you need to meet the following requirements:

- This page does not contain adult content, gambling, illegal content, etc.
- The blog is in English only.
- It does not participate in any advertising networks other than Technorati media.

Payments will be processed according to the Net60 policy with a minimum threshold of \$50, with payment options including PayPal and check.

Besides supporting advertisers in running ads and promoting products to reach customers through online platforms, websites and applications also act as intermediaries, distributing and paying users for viewing advertisements.
