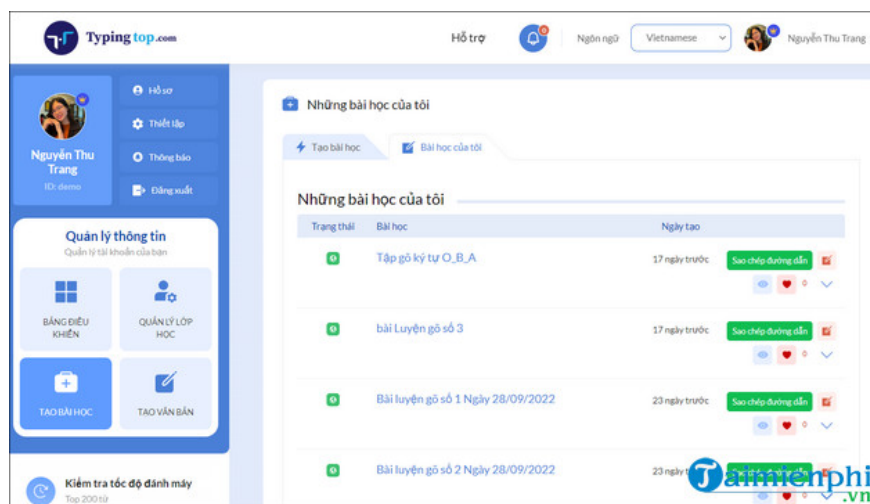

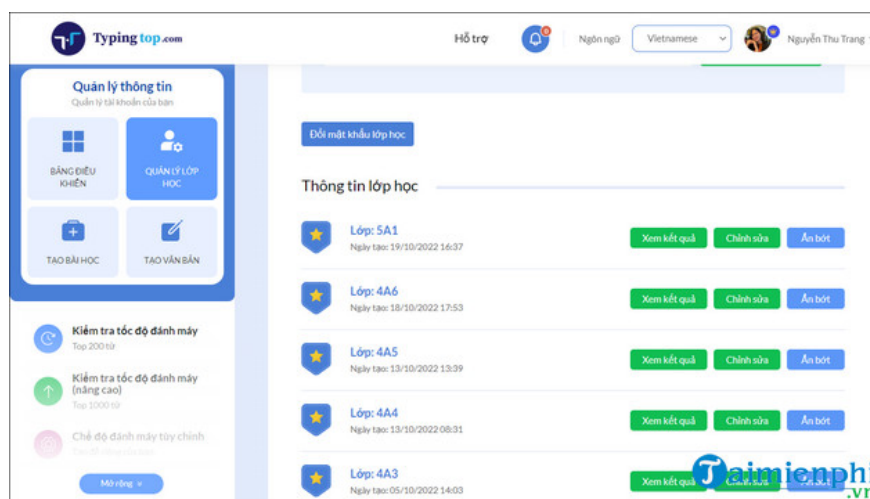

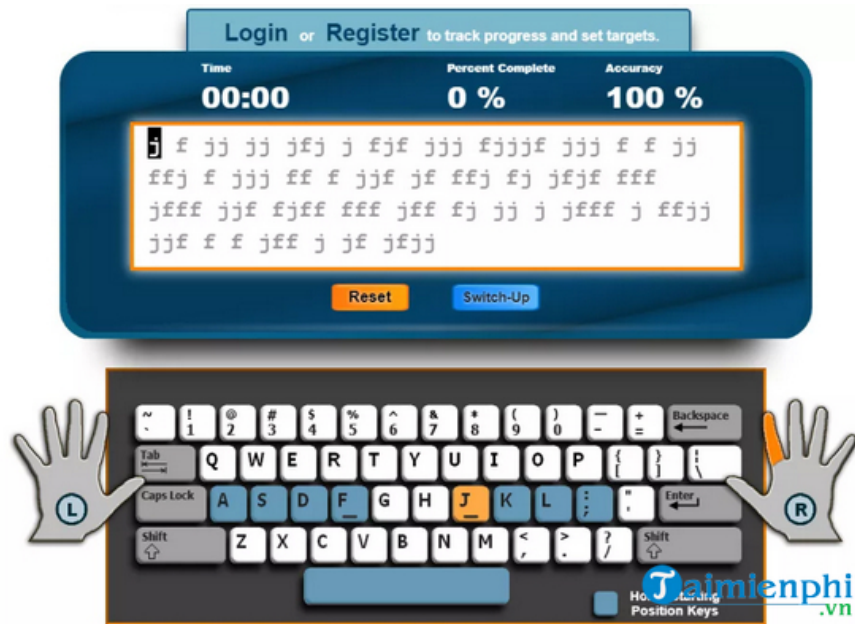

#### 4. Ratatype

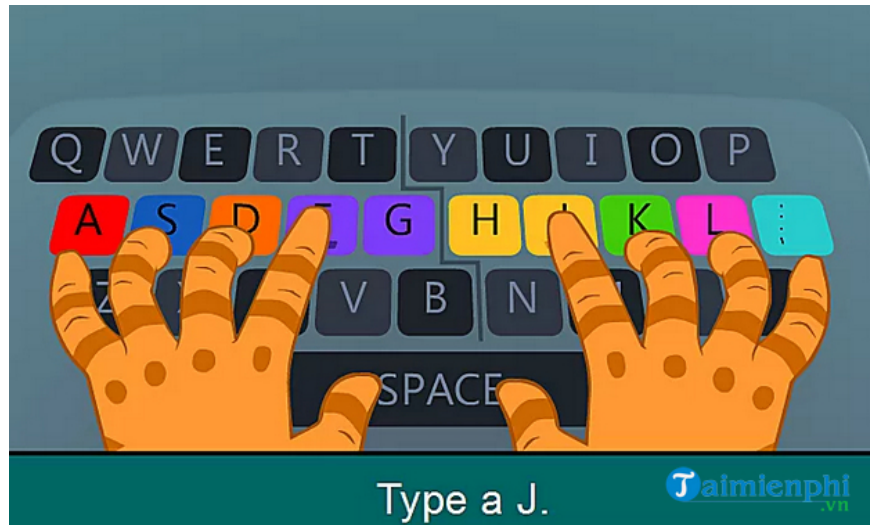

### 5. *Dance Mat Typing*

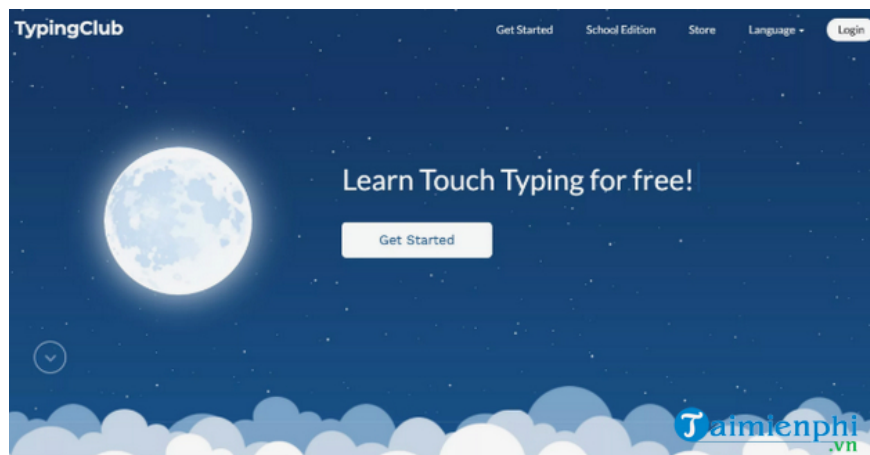


Dance Mat Typing uses unique animal characters and colorful games to make their free typing lessons more fun for elementary school-aged children.

## 7. *Sense-Lang.org*

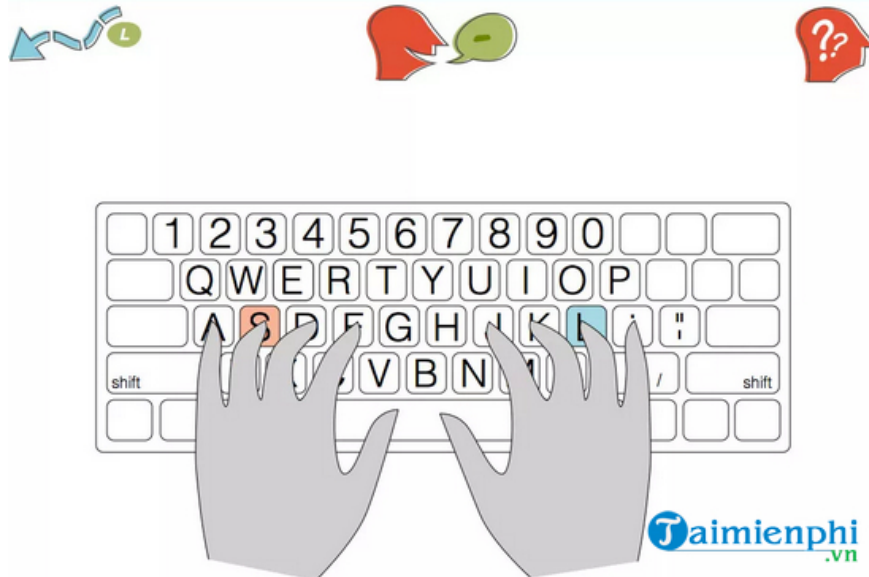

## 8. *GCFLearnFree*

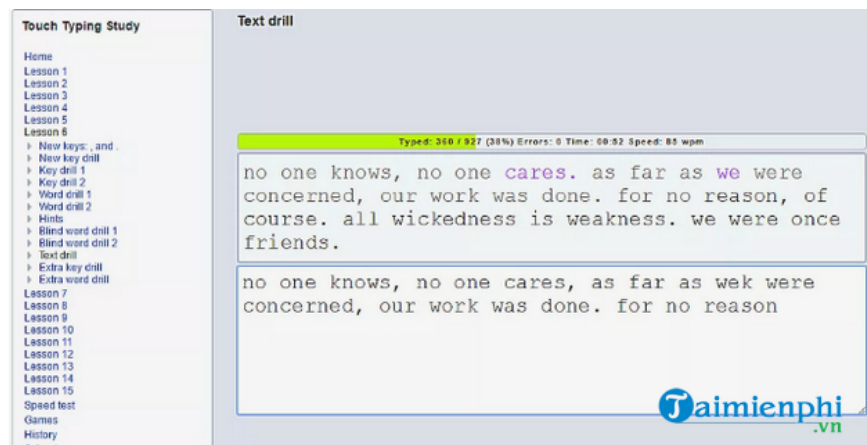


GCFLearnFree offers free typing lessons aimed at adults with little or no typing skills. For each lesson, you have the option to learn how to type the keys or jump straight into practice.

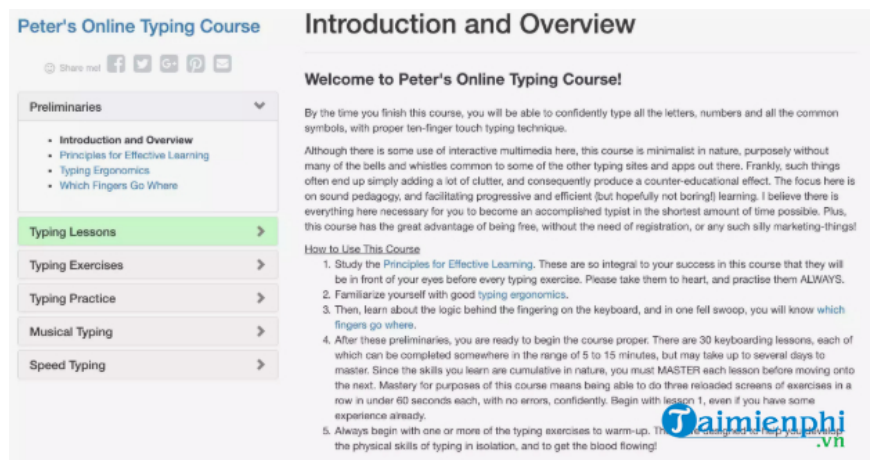
### 9. Touch Typing Study

### 10. Peter's Online Typing Course

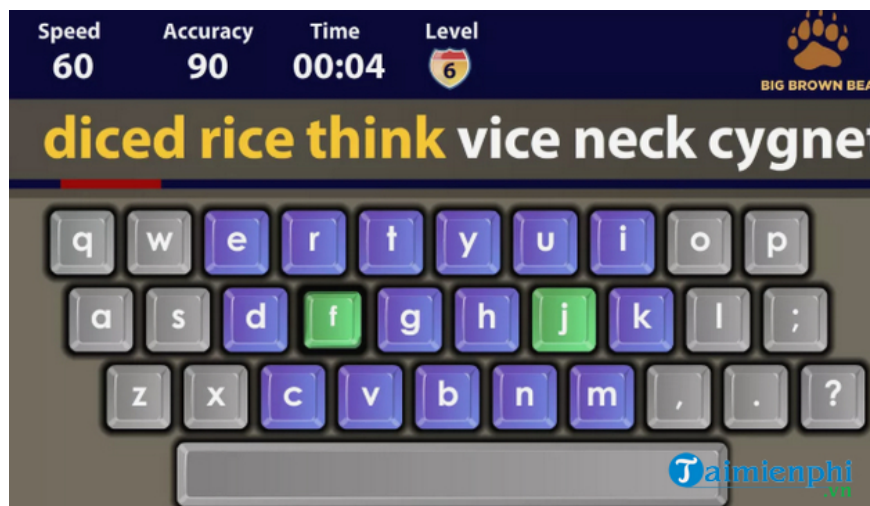
