4. *Ratatype*

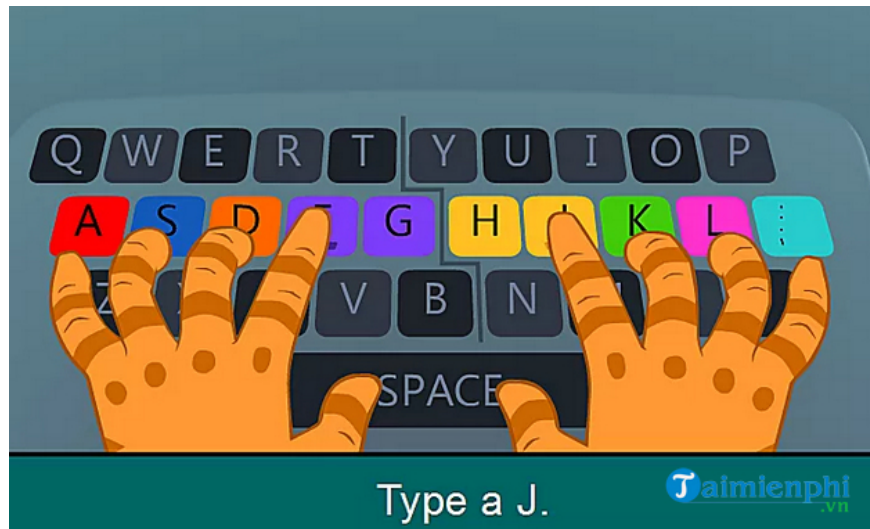

5. *Dance Mat Typing*

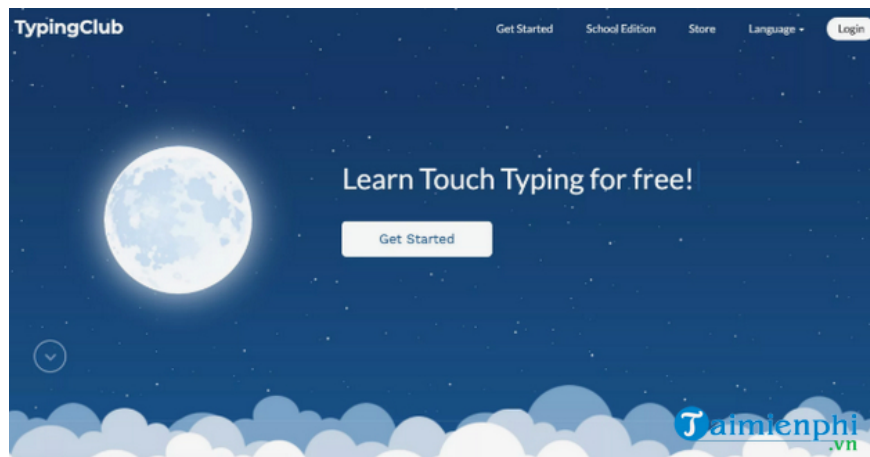


Dance Mat Typing uses unique animal characters and colorful games to make their free typing lessons more fun for elementary school-aged children.

8. GCFLearnFree

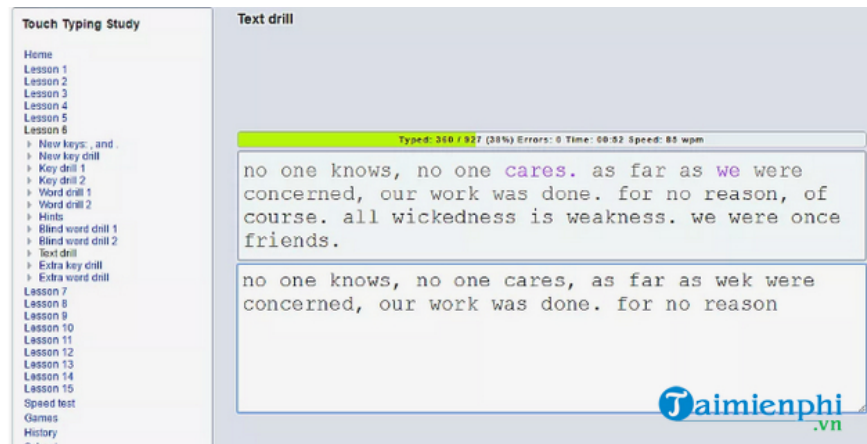


GCFLearnFree has free typing lessons aimed at adults with little or no typing skills. For each lesson, you have the option of learning to type the keys or jumping right into practice.

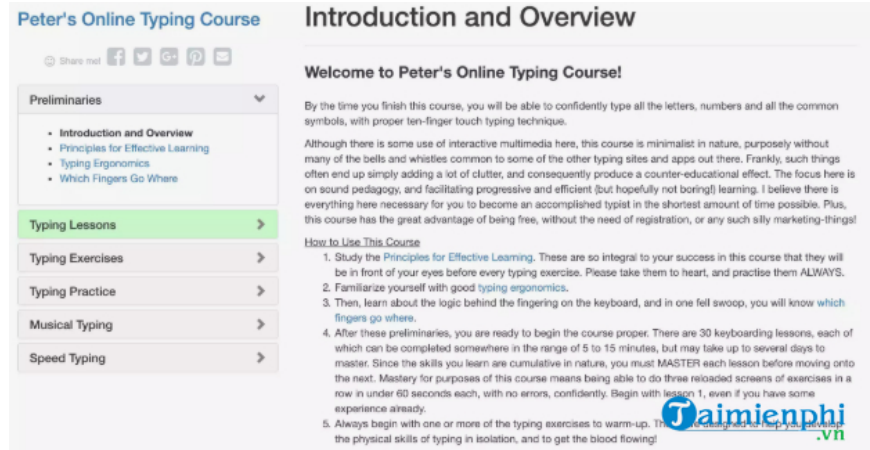
9. Touch Typing Study

10. Peter's Online Typing Course

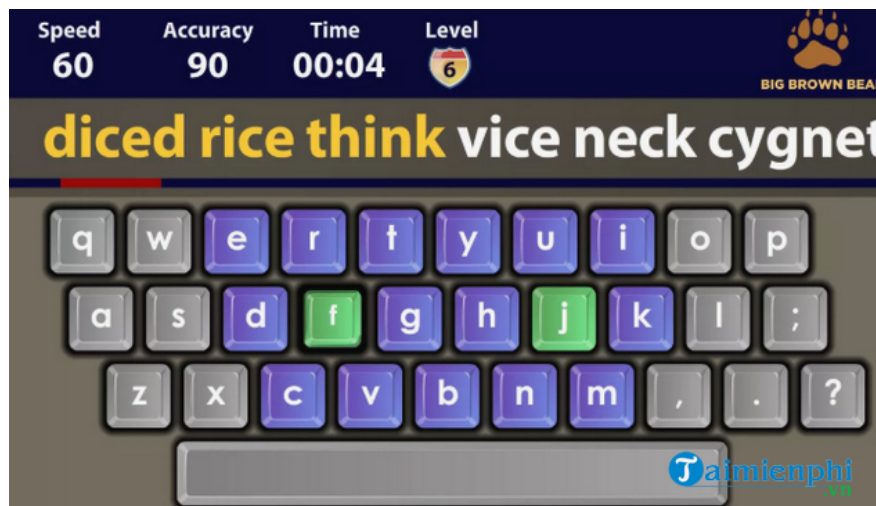
