According to the French technology blog, Blogeee, Toshiba is also planning to produce a smartbook based on Google's Android 2.1 operating system. This is similar to recent rumors about Acer's similar product or HP's Compaq AirLife 100, Skylight from Lenovo or Sharp's NetWalker PC-Z1.

According to the source, Toshiba's smartbook is codenamed AC100-114 with a 10.1-inch screen based on a hardware platform including Nvidia Tegra T2 processor, 512MB RAM, hard drive. Solid 16GB SSD, HDMI port, VGA and 3 cell battery.

Just six months ago, the smartbook seemed to have had a good start to Lenovo's Smartbook Skylight or HP's Compaq AirLife 100. However, these products keep quiet and do not attract much attention of users at the present time, especially the cult launch of the iPad and a series of other tablets during the time. Last time.

Information on pricing and the official launch date of Toshiba AC100-114 has not been disclosed.
