Next October, the Toshiba Qosmio X500 - the first laptop model of a Japanese computer company to use Intel Core i7 processor, running Windows 7 operating system will officially be available in European and North American markets.

It also has other advanced equipment such as a backlit LED keyboard, a well-known Harman Kardon speaker system, multitouch touchpad, and super-sharp webcam

integration.

Toshiba said the official information about the configuration and price of the Qosmio X500 will be announced by the company on October 13. But certainly, new members of the Core i7 laptop village will cost more than the \$ 2,135 of the predecessor Qosmio X300.
