The Portégé series integrates a hard drive protection system with accelerometer sensor to protect data when a collision occurs. The USB port uses Sleep and Charge technology, allowing users to charge a variety of electronic devices.

The Portégé T130 is equipped with a 13.3-inch mirror screen, while the screen of the T110 is 11.6 inches. Both models use CSV (Clear Super View) super bright display technology and 16: 9 widescreen aspect ratio. T130

has 3 colors for customers to choose from are black, red and pearl white. Model T110 is available in black and red.



The ultra-thin Portégé laptop can operate continuously for 11 hours.
