

Toshiba touch ultrabook and Windows 8 laptop cost \$ 600

The Satellite P845t comes with a touchscreen display and an efficient speaker system while the Satellite S955 is the cheapest Windows 8 pre-installed laptop currently available.

In addition, the company also launched three other products, Satellite U945, model ultrabook and Satellite S955 15-inch screen with light size (not yet standardized ultrabook) and Satellite U845W screen 21: 9 ratio. All these products will start selling on October 26, at the same time the official Windows 8 operating system is available.



Satellite U945.

The first is the Satellite U945 model, the upgraded version of U845. This 14-inch ultrabook model is said to have a better price than the "elder" about \$ 50 but will have a shell with some plastic details. The machine does not change much in design and configuration options. Users can choose Core i3, i5 processor, 500 GB capacity hard drive and a 32 GB SSD memory chip for faster boot. The company did not specify the exact weight but only claimed less than 1.8 kg. This model also has two USB 3.0 ports, one 2.0, Ethernet and HDMI ports.

Next is the Satellite P845t, Toshiba's higher-end model with touch screen but unfortunately, the resolution only stops at 1,366 x 768 pixels. This product has a 14-inch screen size, a luxurious alloy shell. It allows optional Core i3 or i5 processor, 6 GB RAM and maximum hard drive up to 750 GB. For entertainment, the product also comes with Harman Kardon speaker system, charging or listening features with the speaker even when the device is turned off. The Satellite P845t has Intel's three USB 3.0 ports, HDMI, Ethernet and Wireless Display technology that help to transmit video without wires.

Finally, the Satellite S955 is 30% smaller than Toshiba's previous generation S, but has yet to reach the Ultrabook standard. This product owns Intel Core i5 ULV processor (low voltage) or AMD A8 processor, up to 8 GB of RAM and 750 GB hard drive. The screen of the device has a size of 15.6 inches with a resolution of 1366 x 768 pixels but no touch screen. The main point is that this product is priced from about 600 USD, according to *Laptopmag*.

Finally, the Satellite U845W model is standard ultrabook but owns 14-inch HD screen with a strange ratio of 21:9 resolution of 1,792 x 768 pixels. Wide screen makes it possible to display over 30 software content frames in the Start interface of Windows 8. Satellite U845W allows optional Intel Core i5 or i7 3rd generation processor, 6 GB RAM, hybrid hard drive with 500 GB and 32 GB SSD or totally 256 GB SSD. It also has 3 USB 3.0 ports, HDMI, Ethernet, memory card reader.
