

Translate text directly on iPhone keyboard with Gboard's Translate

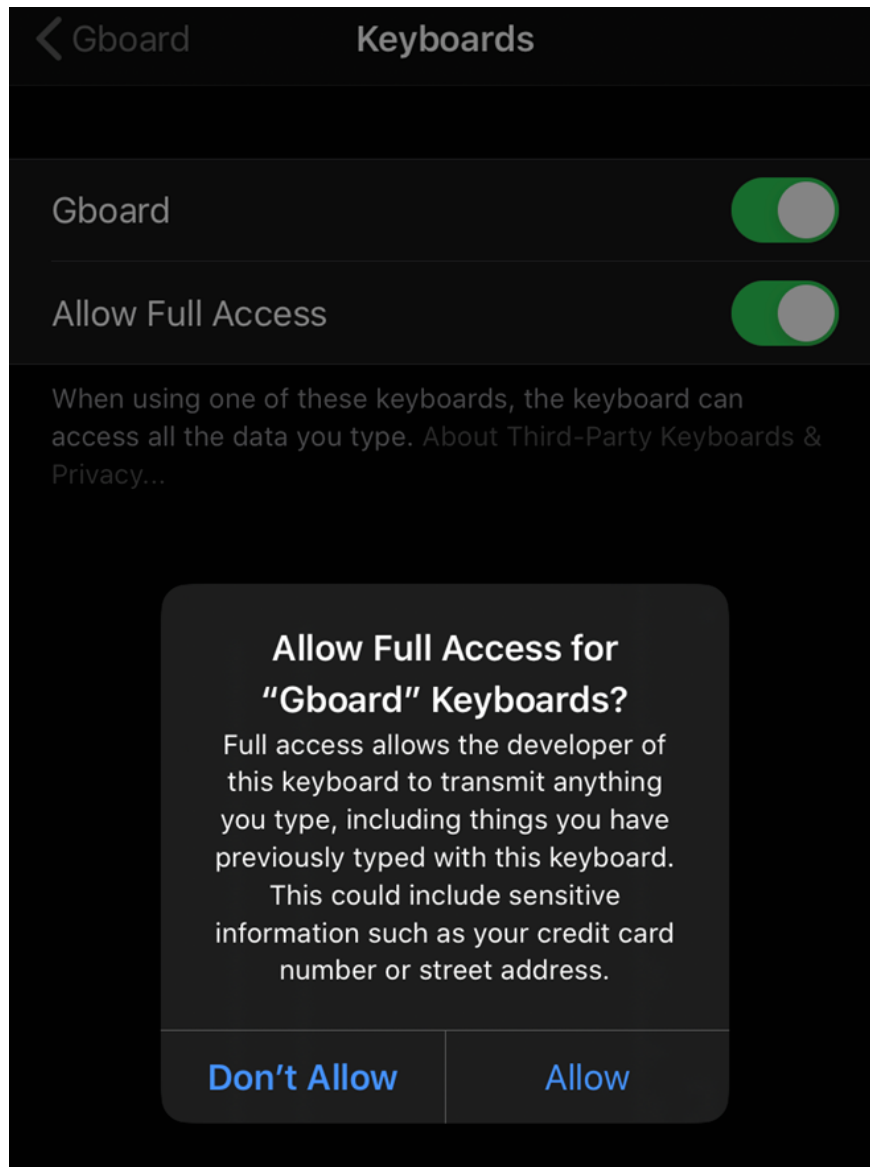
Gboard's Translate is an interesting feature on iPhone that allows users to easily translate languages ??you are typing automatically on the keyboard.

To use you need to download Gboard from the App Store, after installation you launch the application and click Get Started.

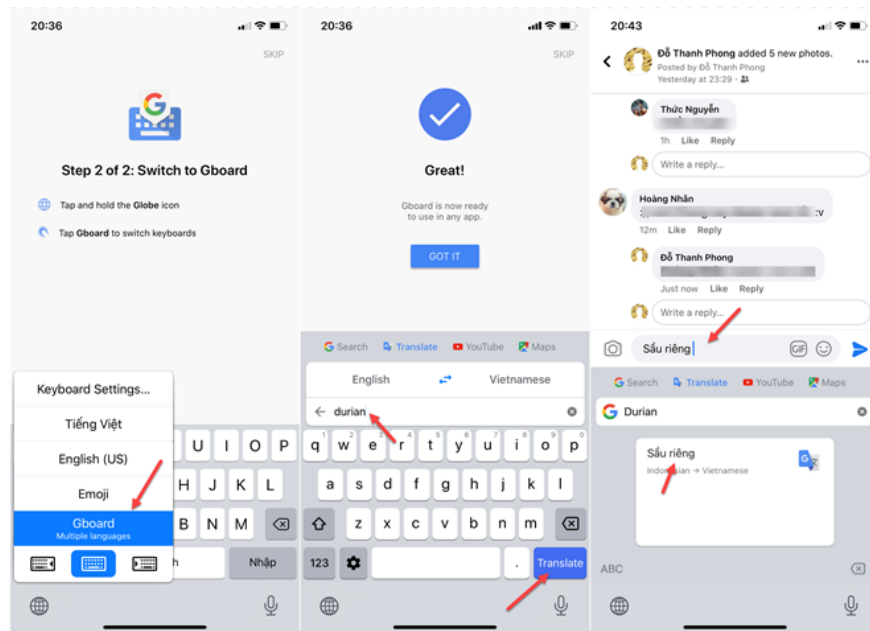

How to use Gboard's Translate to translate input

To use Gboard's Translate, at the keyboard interface, hold the globe icon in the left corner of the screen and select Gboard. Next, click the Google Translate icon located on the toolbar above the keyboard, then select the language to translate and enter the content directly into the box below. Then click Translate to translate.

After clicking Translate, Gboard will translate into the language you need and automatically fill the translated text in the text editor conveniently.
