

Tricks to save and convert .Webp images to JPG / PNG quickly

WebP is a format created to replace formats like PNG and JPG, with a small size while maintaining the same image quality. However, the normal image viewer tool on Windows cannot read image files in .WEBP format

Google has developed a new image format **.WebP** with the goal of reducing image file size without compromising on quality. This comes from the fact that images make up a large proportion of a web page's capacity.







This format is divided into 2 types:

1. Lossless WebP helps reduce image size to 26% compared to the .PNG format
2. Lossy WebP shrinks the file size from 25 to 34% of the .JPG format.

This format allows web pages to load faster and consume less bandwidth, making the user experience better. Most people probably agree that the speed of web browsing is as fast as possible, so what is the problem?

However, the .WebP format is not yet widely available, only a few brands use this format like Netflix, eBay and Google on their services such as Google+, Google Play, Chrome Web Store and YouTube (pictured). thumbnail image).

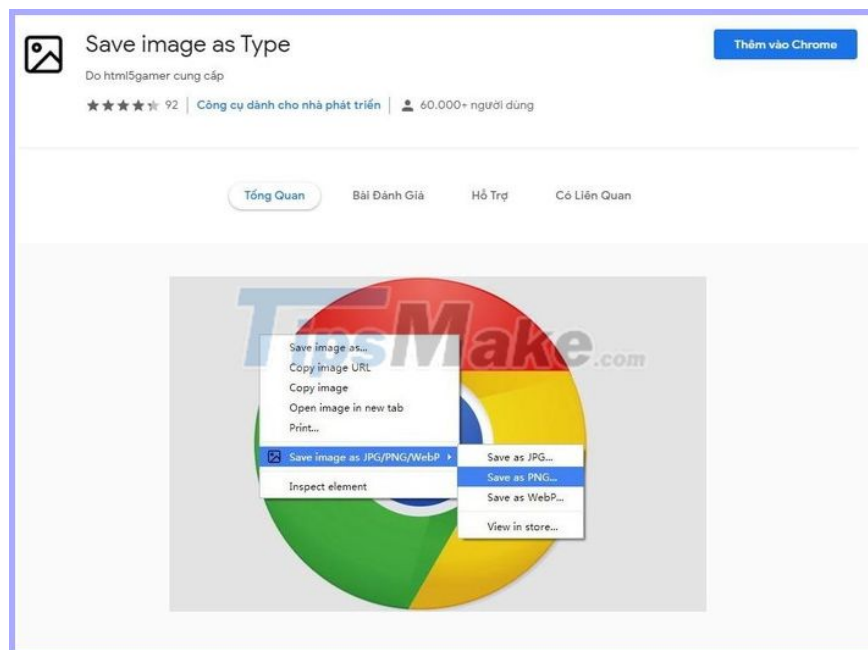

One problem with .WebP image files is that they cannot be read using common tools like Windows Photo Viewer, so if you want to save and view these images on your computer, you will have to perform a conversion. format (convert) format for them, you can refer to the following way:

Use the Chrome extension: Save image as Type:

This is a utility capable of converting photos of any format into PNG, JPG or WebP.

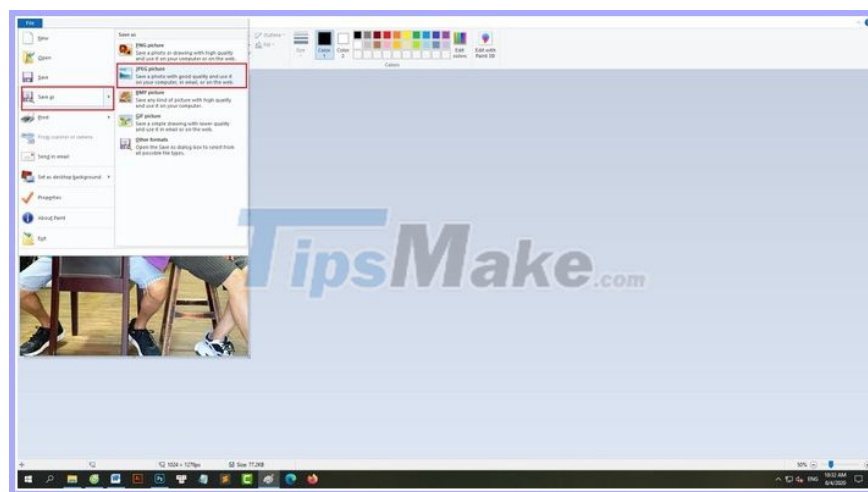
Step 1: Click here or this [link](#) to install for Chrome.



Step 2: Installation is complete, right-click on any image > select Save image as Type and choose the image you want to save:

1. **Save as JPG:** Convert and save as JPG.
2. **Save as PNG:** Convert and save as PNG.
3. **Save as WebP:** Convert and save as WebP.

Use the Paint tool available



If you've already downloaded an image file with .Webp extension, however, some tools like Photoshop won't open the image format. You only need to use Paint to open the file with .Webp extension and Save As, select the format you want to save.
