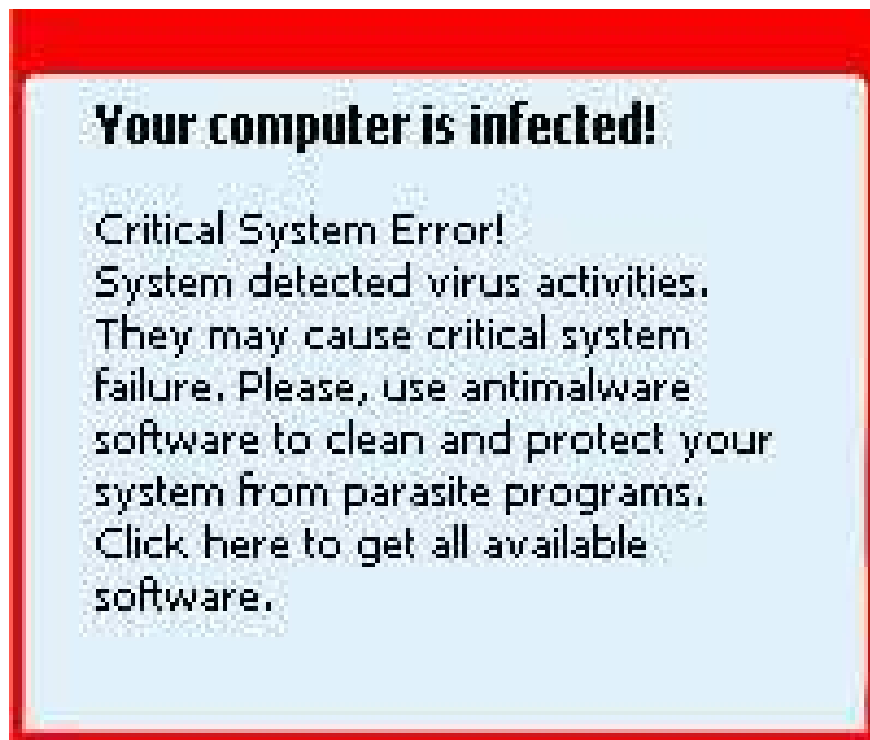


Trojan warning fake to sell products

The new trojan, called 'Troj / FakeVir-O', gives fake warnings with a software sale page and says that these software can protect users' computers from spyware.

Sophos also said the trojan was created by members of the security company to attract more users to visit their site to increase revenue. Users should be alert about this type of warning information.
