Some tips to help you climb easily in the Truth Arena

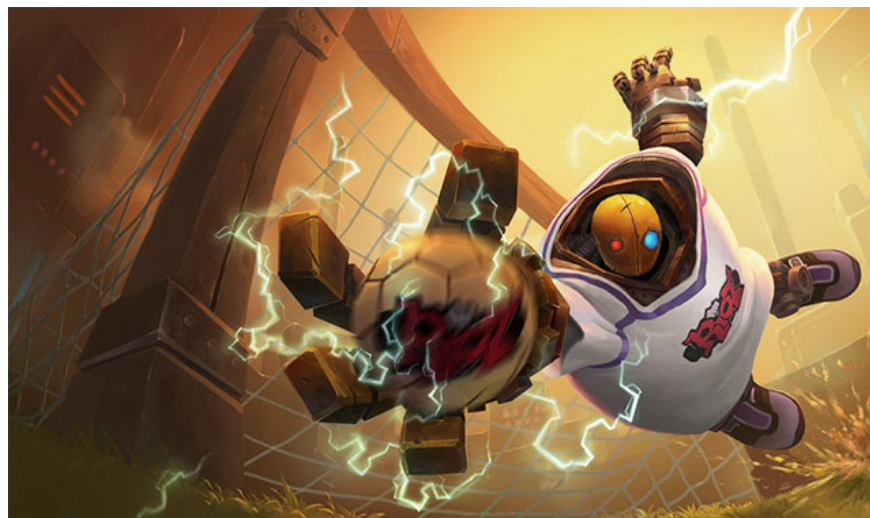
Pay attention to your blood



If you lose a round then you will lose a certain amount of blood, the more time after the match the more blood will be lost than before. How can you look at the deducted Blood in the Truth Arena article? to know the amount of blood will be deducted after each defeat.

And when you see yourself being eliminated too much after every game, you should put all your possessions to upgrade the general in your squad. Don't be too thrifty, and then you have to receive a rewarding part.

Remember to observe the enemy's formation



Just looking at the opponent's chess board will help you win more easily. When you know your opponent's squad information, you will have a different way or at least defend yourself first. Some tips that you can use when observing your opponent are:

Blitzcrank, this is a fairly long-handed hero capable of pulling the most distant opponent. If you know the main hero of the opponent's squad in any position, you can let the Blitzcrank pull the easiest way.

On the other hand, when you know your opponent has a waiting Blitzcrank, change your team's main position, avoid being controlled and unable to do anything.

In addition, if you see the player's team having a Hextech champion, let the generals stand apart, but don't be too far apart because the main carry will not be protected with certainty.

Another trick you can use to overcome Hextech is to add small equipment to unimportant generals in the team. At that time Hextech was able to target these generals, and the main carry still had the effect of equipment and just discharged the damage.

Also, if you look at the enemy formation and you see that there are many people who own Cho'Gath, Draven or Jin X, the chances of you getting those generals are very low. It is at this point that you should change the tactics for your squad.

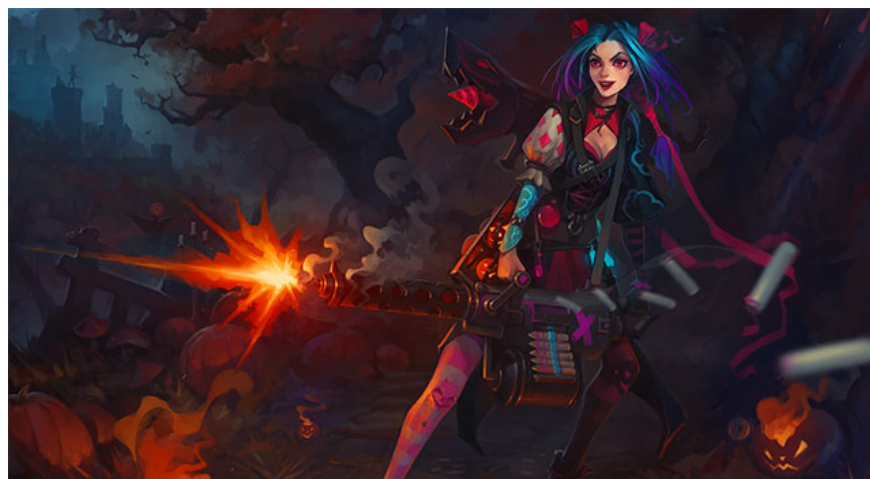
Have to improvise

You have looked at a dream squad at the beginning of the game and just follow that formation, regardless of how bad the situation is in the game. Worse than when you spend money just to build a favorite team.

So you will be in trouble, you need to improvise with what the Truth Arena is for you. If the dignity is good, you will probably get what you want, otherwise you will have to change your lineup.



A good example is the Nobility squad, you have 5 noble generals but you don't have Kayle. Instead, there are related names such as Aatrox, Draven, and it is possible that the game wants you to switch to another team.



So from now on, find a way to change your lineup, eliminate unnecessary generals and build the strongest squad possible based on your dignity. Don't try to follow a line that you want.

That's a few tips for gamers if you want to rank high in the Truth Arena. In short, you just need to pay attention to your opponent's lineup and don't try to pursue a team you want, just use what your dignity brings. Surely you will achieve high rankings in the game.
