

Turn off spell checking in Firefox, Chrome, Internet Explorer

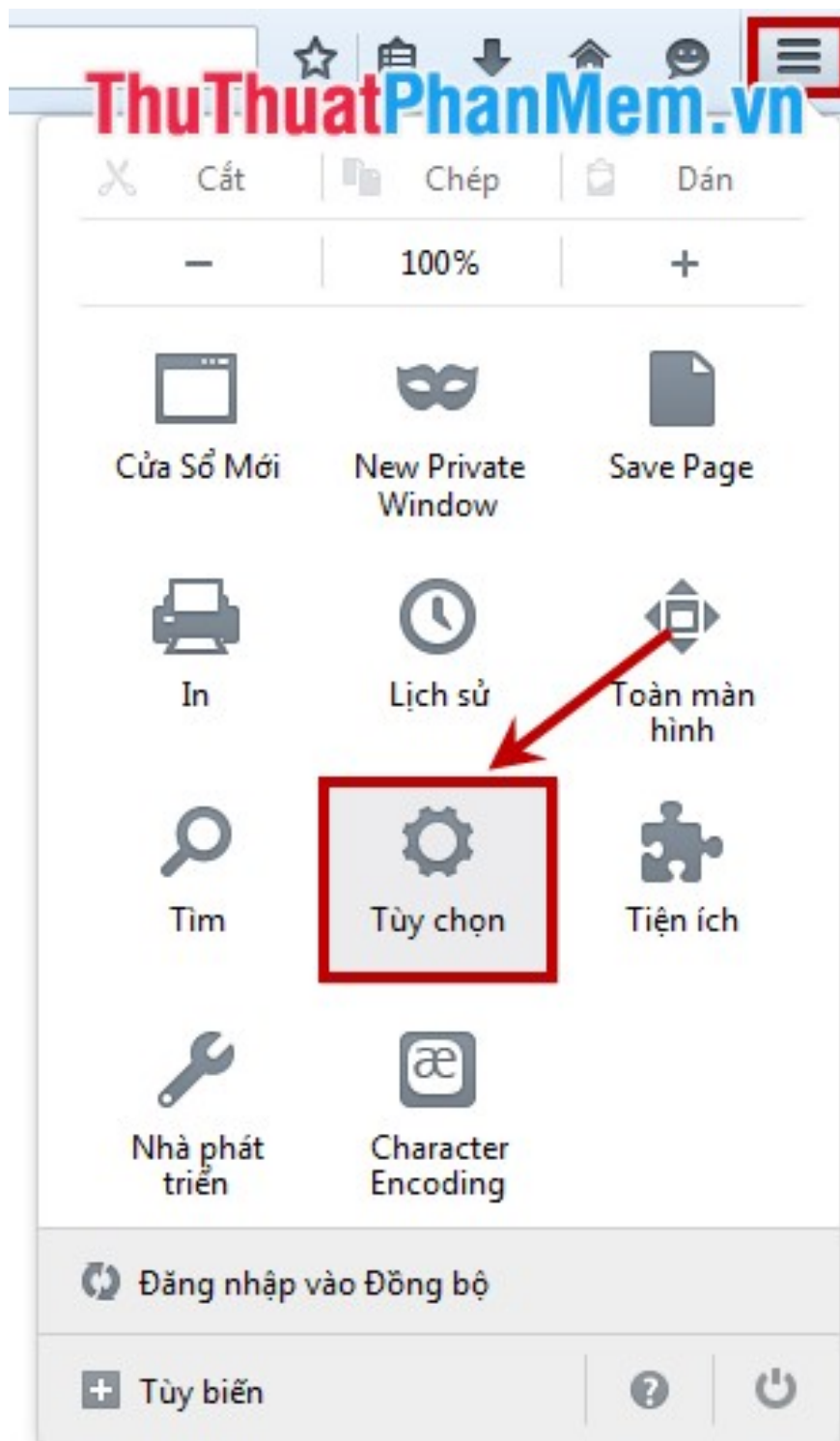

So you want to turn off the spell checking feature in the browser to avoid discomfort as well as increase the performance of the browser.

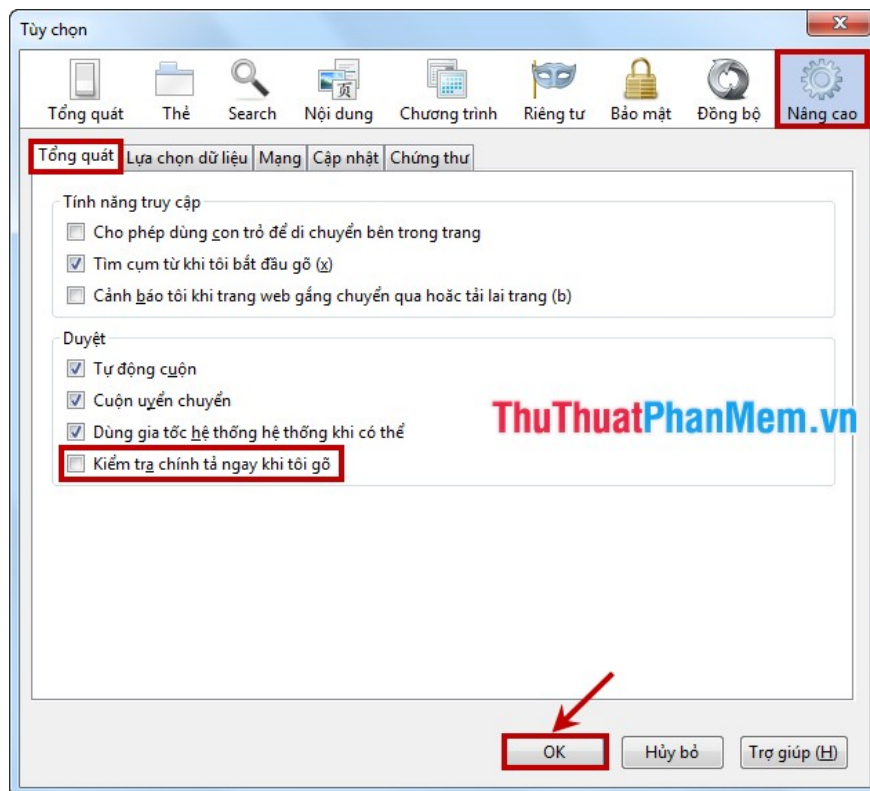
The following article will guide you how to turn off spell checking in Firefox, Google Chrome, Internet Explorer.

Turn off spell checking in FireFox browser

Step 1: Open Firefox, on the interface, select the **Open Menu** icon (three dashes) and select **Options** (Options).



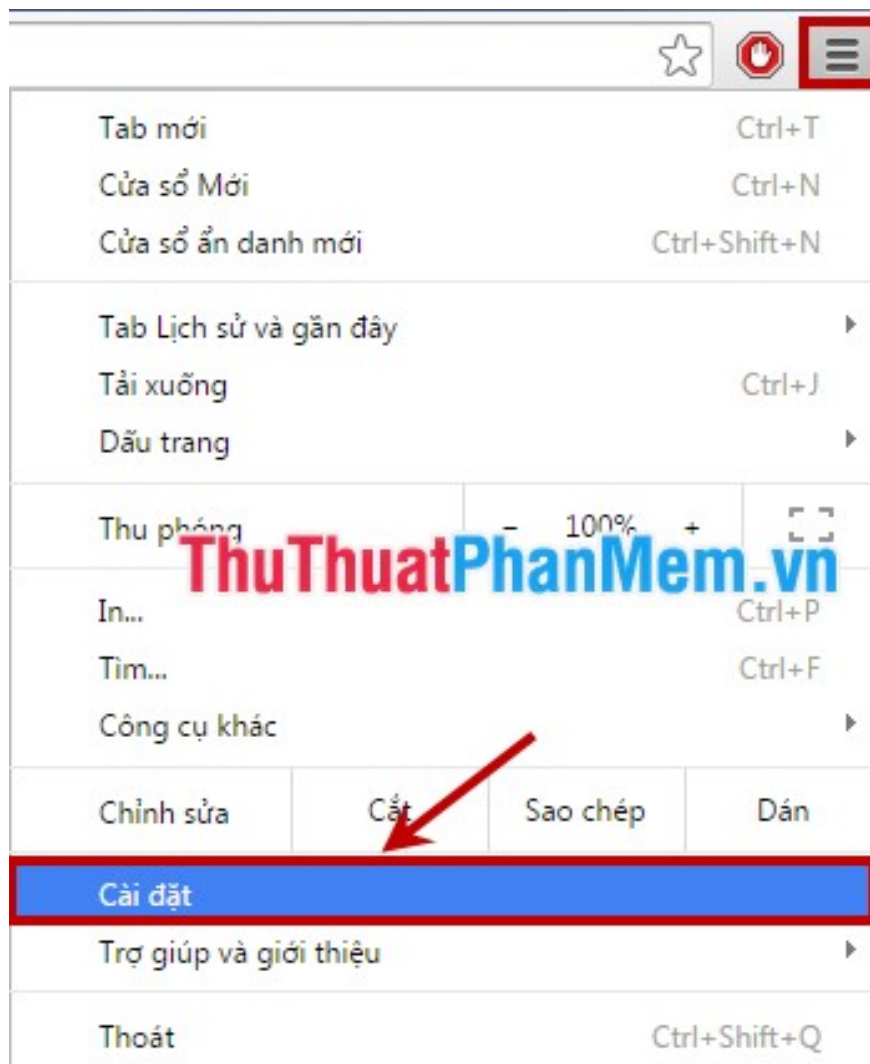
Step 2: In the dialog box **option** you select **Advanced** (Advanced) and select the **General** (General). Here you uncheck the box before the option **Check spelling as I type** (Check my spelling as I type). Click **OK** to change.



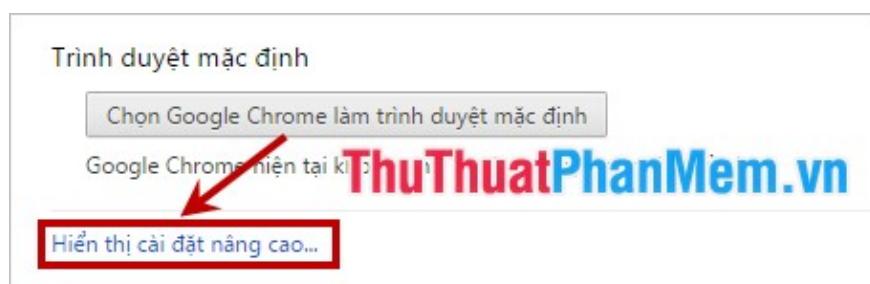
Then restart your browser to check the results.

Turn off spell checking in Google Chrome browser

Step 1: Select the **Customize icon and control Google Chrome** (three dashes) and select **Settings** (Settings).



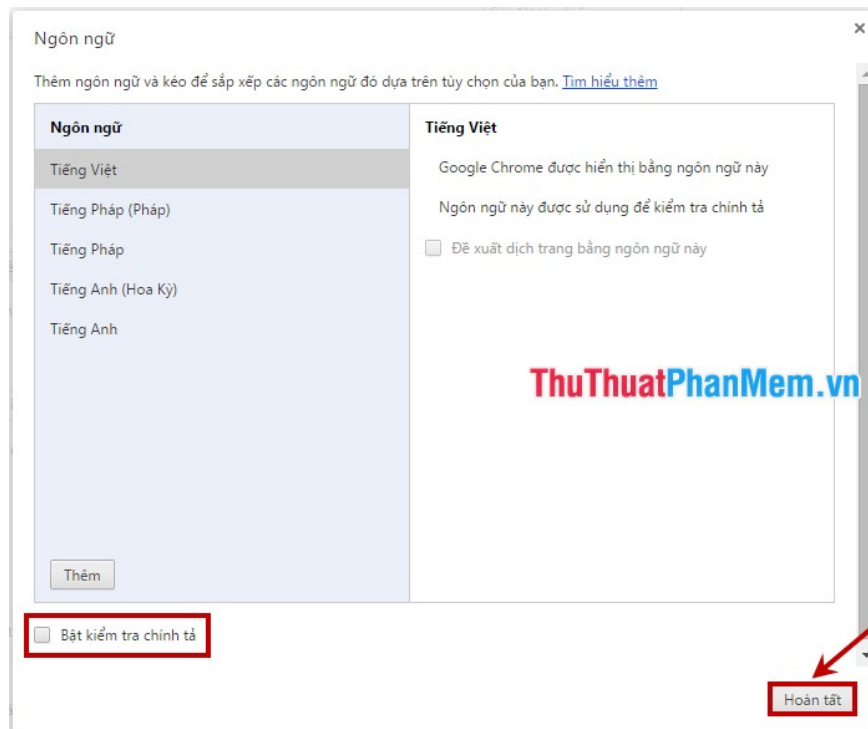
Step 2: In the window **Settings** , you scroll to the bottom and select **Show advanced settings** (Show advanced settings).



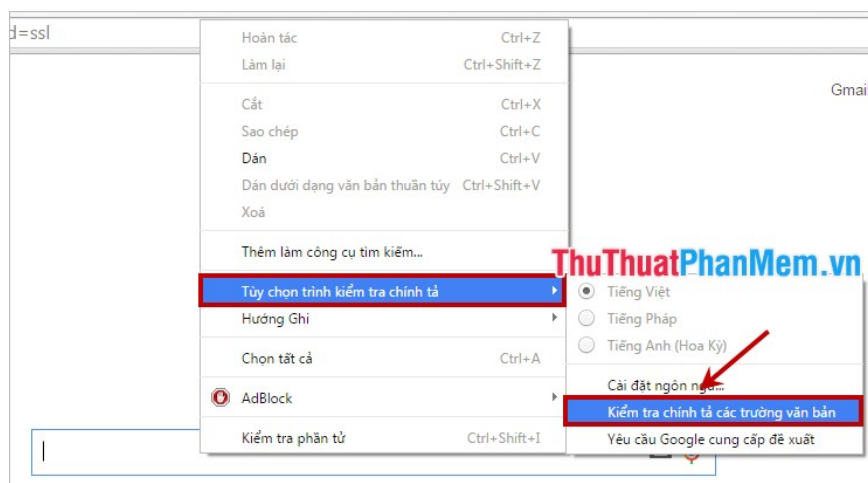
Step 3: Next, you look to the **language** (Language), and select **Settings and input language** (Language and input settings).



Then uncheck the box before *the* Enable spell checking option, click **Finish** to save the settings.

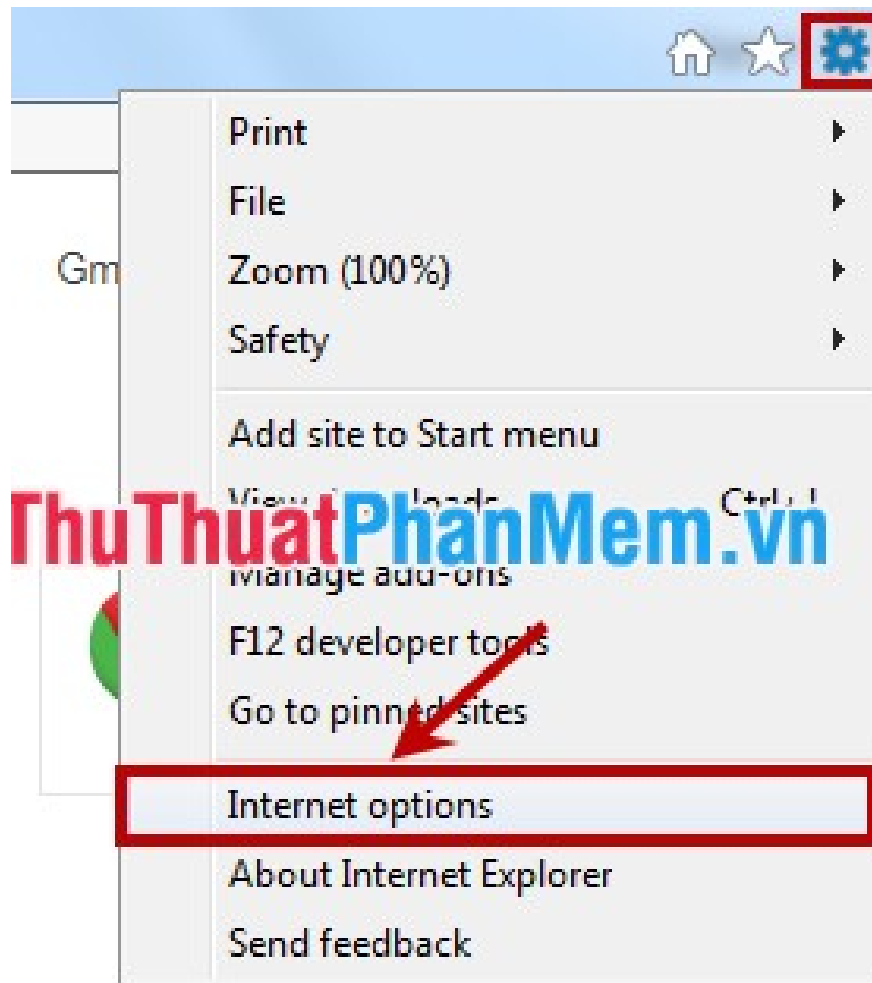


Thus, you have turned off spell checking on Google Chrome browser, in addition, you can turn off fast spell checking on Chrome by right-clicking in the editing area on Chrome browser -> **Options checker Spelling** -> Uncheck first *check Spelling of text fields* .

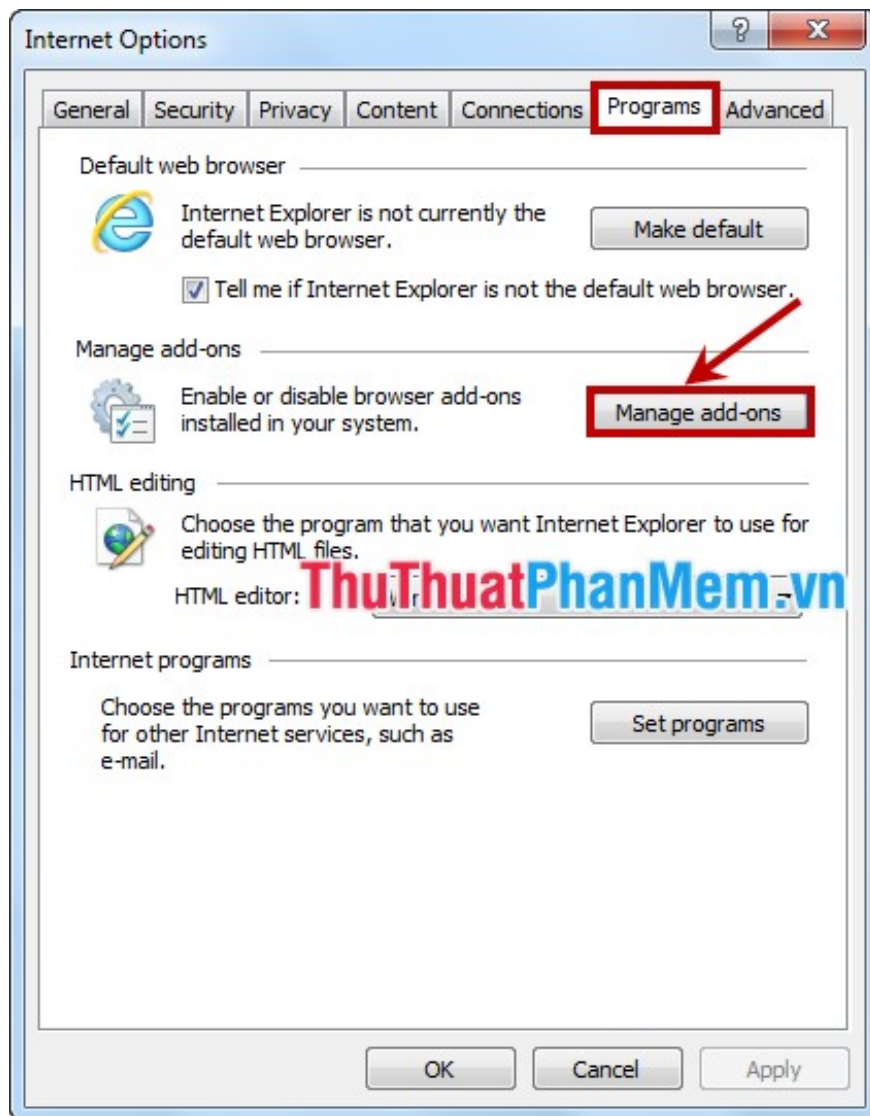


Turn off spell checking in Internet Explorer

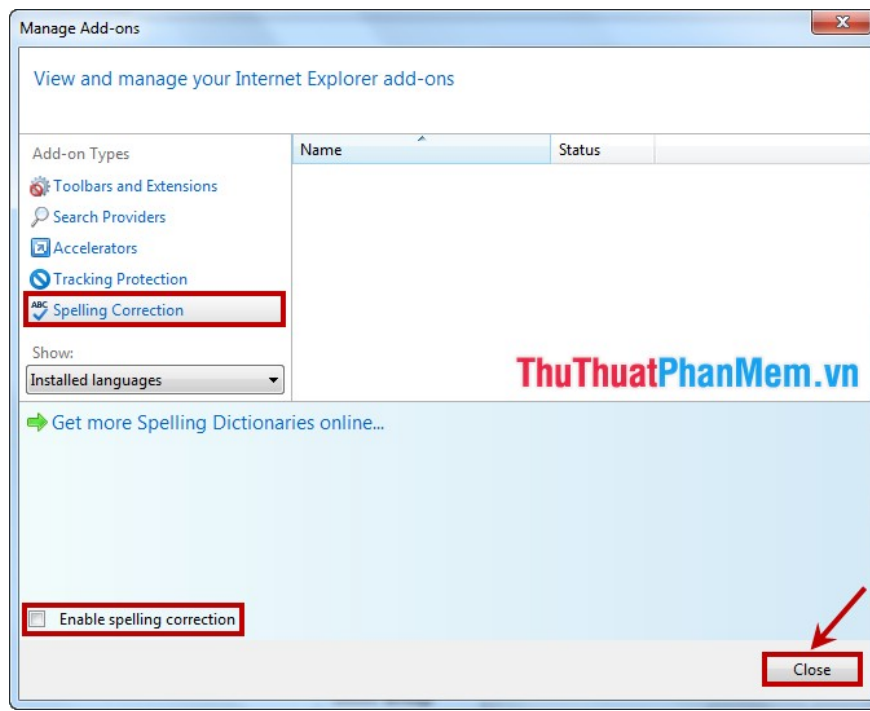
Step 1: Select the **Tools** icon (gear) or press **Alt + X** and select **Internet options** .



Step 2: In the **Internet Options** dialog box, select the **Programs** tab and select **Manage add-ons** .



Step 3: Here you select **Spelling Correction** in the **Add-on Types** section , then uncheck the *Enable spelling correction option* . Click **Close** to finish.



Finally click **OK** to close the **Internet Options** dialog box , restart the browser to check the results.
