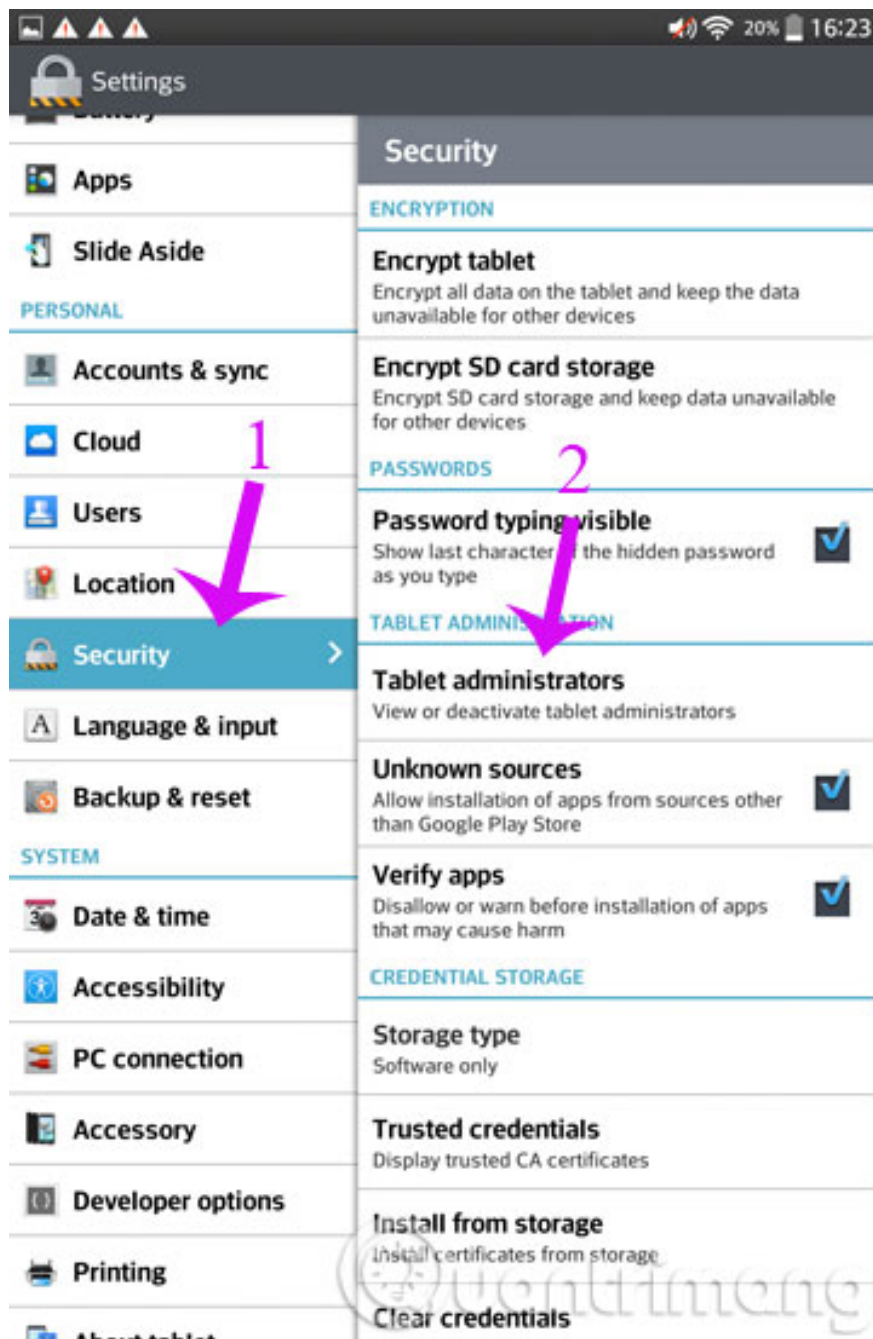


Turn on the retrieval of lost phones on Android

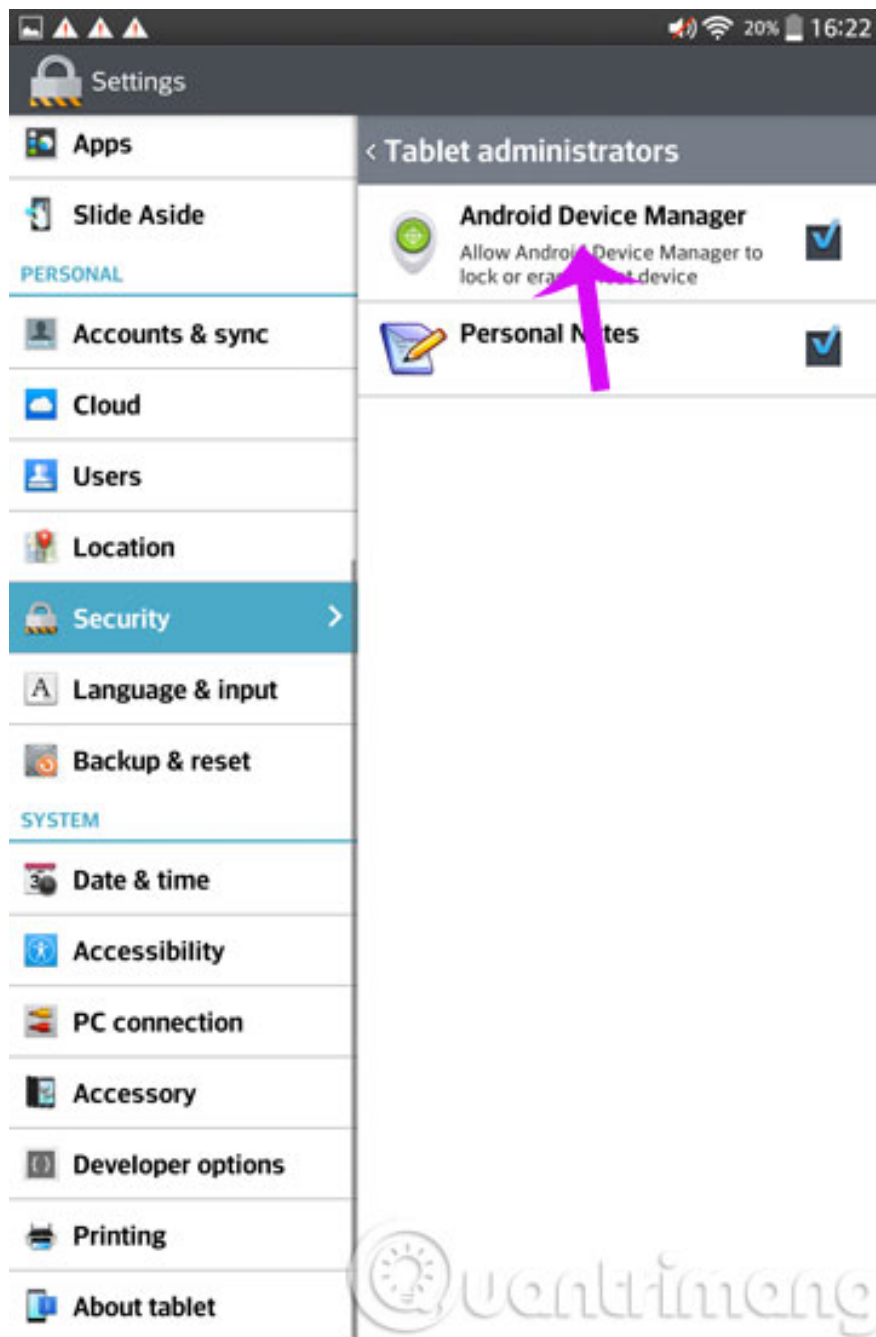

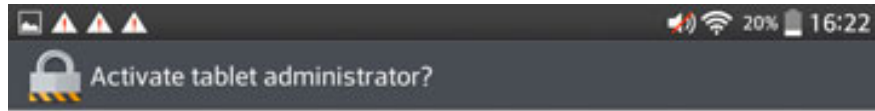
Step 1 : Go to **Settings** , select **Security** > **Tablet Administrators**



Step 2 : In the **Tablet Administrators** section, select **Android Device Manager**



Step 3 : Here, you turn on the feature to find the phone with the secret by pressing **Active**



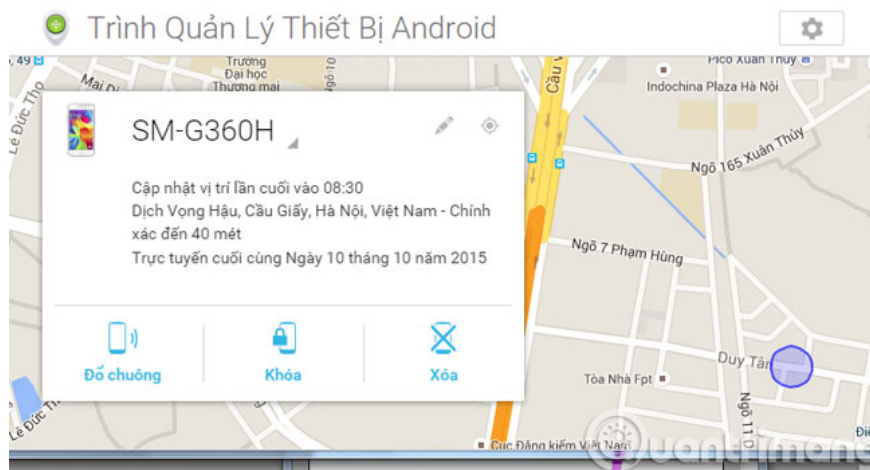
Android Device Manager

Activating this administrator will allow the app Google Play services to perform the following operations:

- **Erase all data**
Erase the tablet's data without warning, by performing a factory data reset
- **Change the screen-unlock password**
Change the screen-unlock password
- **Lock the screen**
Control how and when the screen locks



From now on, if you don't know where your phone is, you can visit the [Google.com/Android/devicemanager](https://www.google.com/Android/devicemanager) address to determine the location of the device at the present time. You need to log in your email address and password, you can immediately locate your phone.



You can click the **Ring** option (Your device will ring at the highest volume for 5 minutes. Press the power button to stop ringing), **Lock** (Lock the phone by setting a new password), **Delete** (Delete all data on the device but only delete the data stored in the internal memory and if your device is in offline mode, when enabled, whenever there is a connection connecting it will perform a factory reset to erase all data .

Note, the Google account you use must match your account on your Android device.
