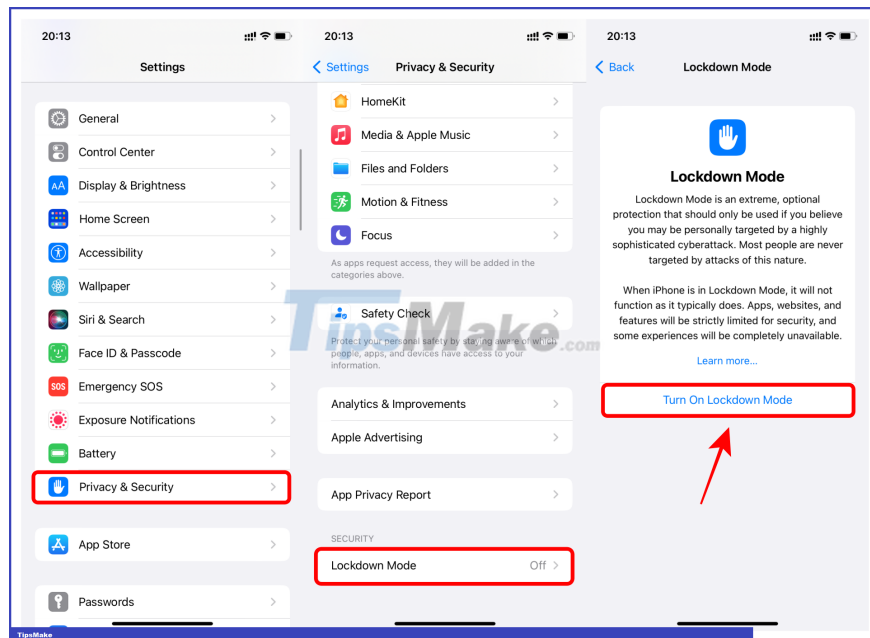


# Turn on this feature now to make your iPhone more secure, prevent malware

The malware blocking feature helps to 'raise' the security of the iPhone to a new level that many readers probably do not know.

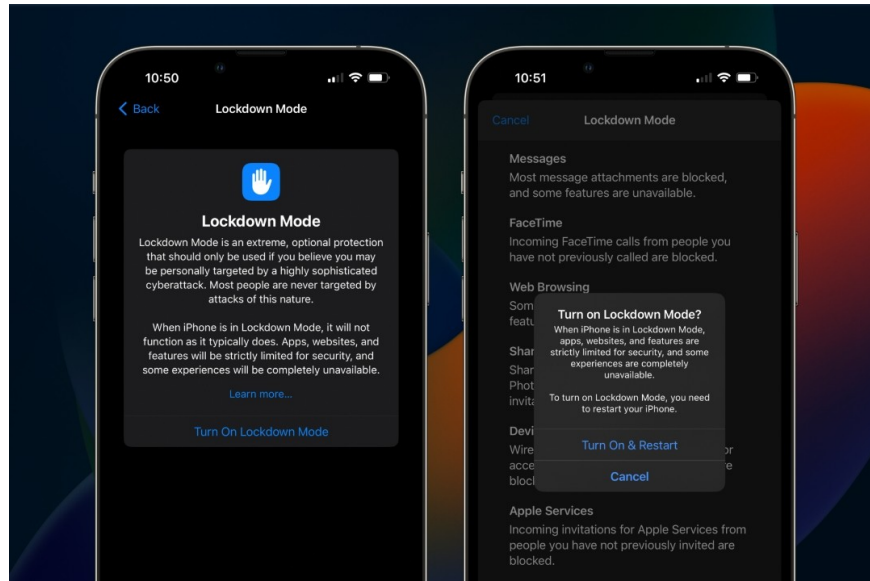

**Step 1:** Check if your device has been upgraded to iOS 16. If not, go to *Settings > General > Software Update* and upgrade to the latest version available.



**Step 2:** Open the **Settings** app > Select **Privacy & Security** > Select **Lockdown Mode** .

**Step 3:** Turn on the blockade mode by clicking Turn On Lockdown Mode. The device will then reboot to complete the feature setup.



When activating this feature successfully, Lockdown Mode not only helps prevent malware, but also blocks many features related to Internet connection to secure identity, limit the possibility of being attacked by hackers, control control your data.
