Every time the computer is idle by the time set to activate screensavers, Auslogics Disk Defrag Screen Saver will automatically perform defragmentation of the hard drive.

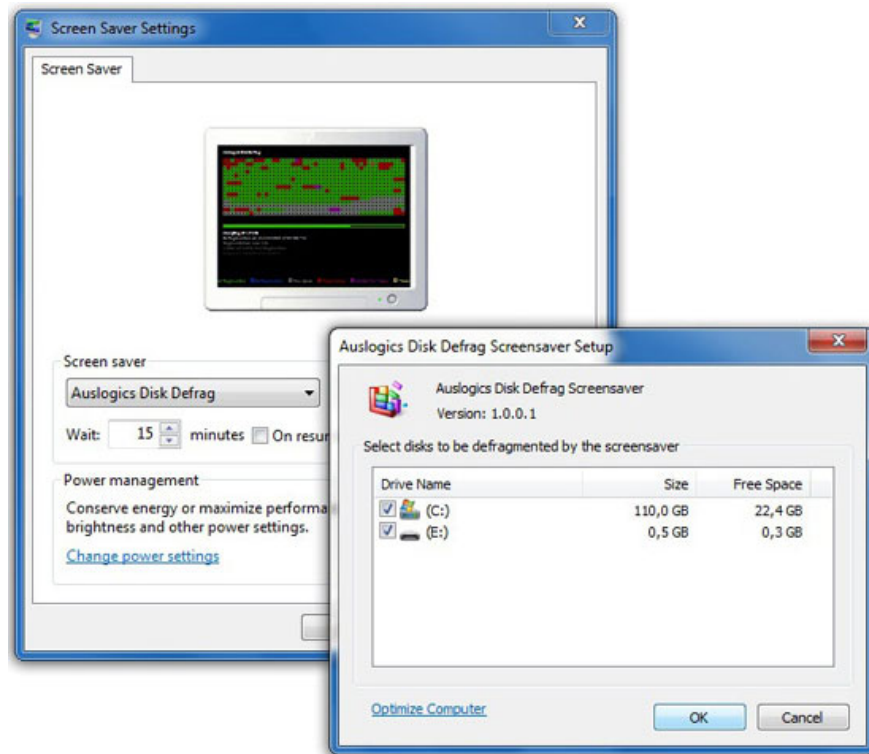
Every time the computer is idle by the time set to activate screensavers, Auslogics Disk Defrag Screen Saver will automatically perform defragmentation of the hard drive.

Auslogics Disk Defrag Screen Saver version 1.1.0.40 has a capacity of only 1.73MB, compatible with XP / Vista / 2003/2008/7 32-bit and 64-bit.

After installation, Auslogics Disk Defrag Screen Saver will add Windows a screen saver with the same name, and set this screen saver to default.

To customize which drives want Auslogics Disk Defrag Screen Saver to defragment when screen saver is turned on, in the **Screen Saver Settings** window, click the **Settings** button.



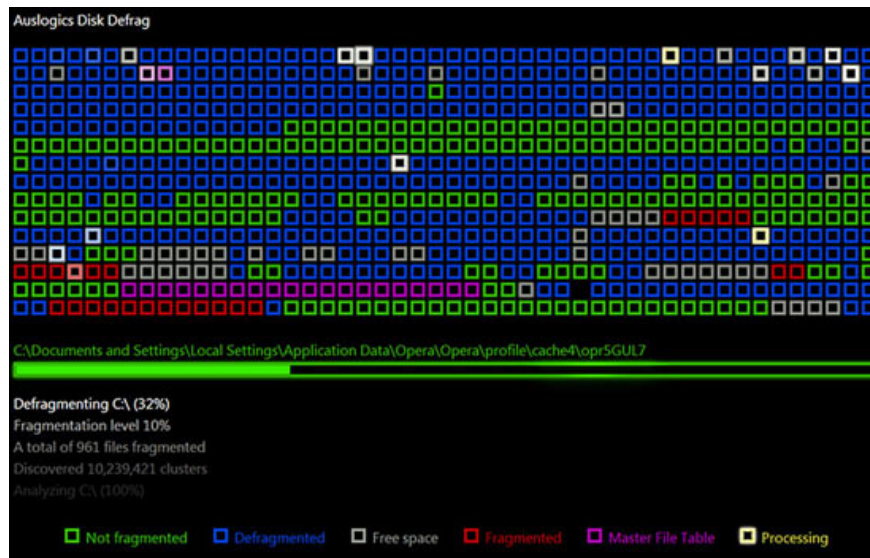
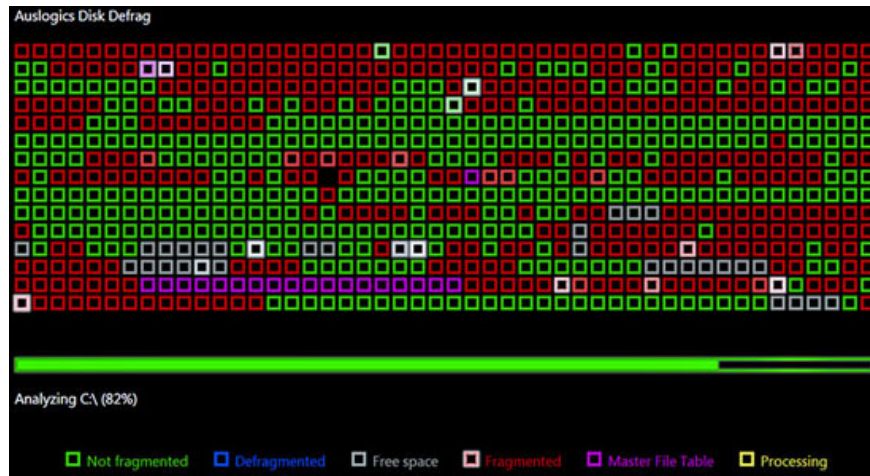
Screen Saver Settings window of Windows Vista

In the **Auslogics Disk Defrag Screen Saver Setup** dialog box that opens, you uncheck any drives that do not need **Auslogics Disk Defrag Screen Saver** to defragment automatically (by default, select all).

If you want to disable the animation effect during the time when Auslogics Disk Defrag Screen Saver defragment, check **Turn off animation when idle** under **Animation settings** . Done, press **OK** to save the setting.

Back in the Screen Saver Settings window, set the idle time to turn on the screen saver of Auslogics Disk Defrag Screen Saver in the **Wait** box, then click **Apply** .

If you want to preview the progress of the defragmentation process, click the **Preview** button. Shake the mouse or press any key when you want to stop defragmenting the drive.
