## Why can't TV access YouTube , Facebook?

You feel frustrated when you want to watch a favorite program on YouTube but you can't do it, don't understand why? Rest assured that this error is definitely not caused by you. In fact, the reason for this is mainly due to the DNS Proxy settings of the Internet that are configured to be blocked by the network, so that your home TV cannot access Internet applications such as Youtube, Facebook .

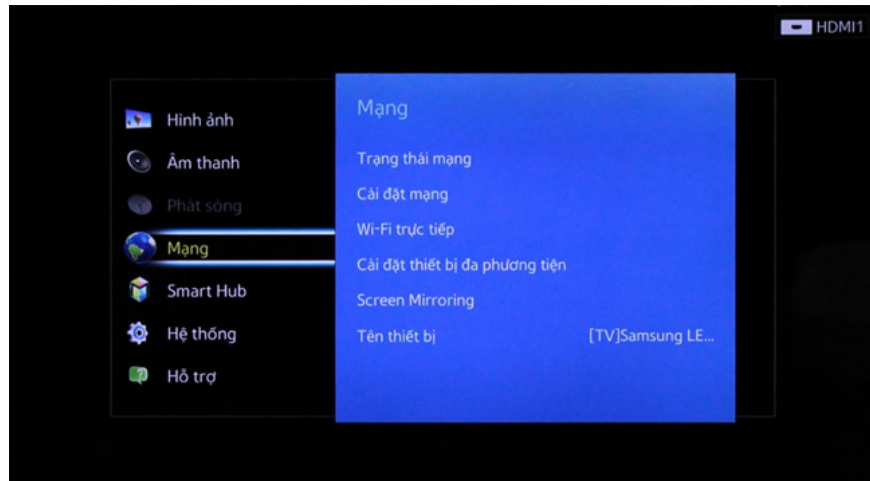


When accessing the application, the TV will notify the transmission problem and require Internet settings.

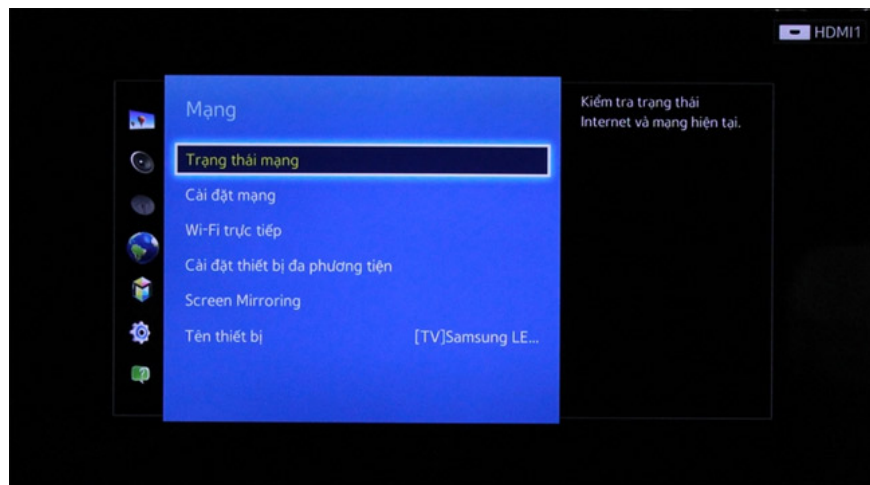
## How to fix TV does not access Youtube, Facebook

The fastest way to remedy this situation is to reset your home TV's DNS according to the following steps:

**Step 1:** Go to Menu select 'Network'.



**Step 2:** Select 'Network status'.



**Step 3:** Select 'IP Settings'.



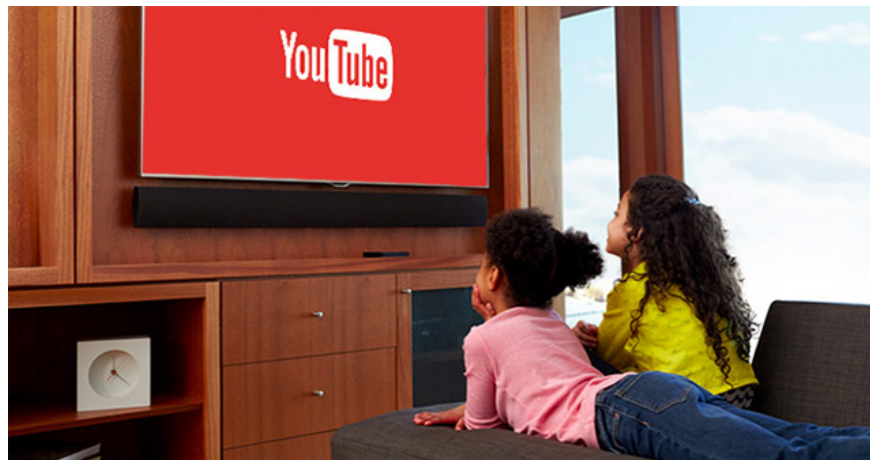
**Step 4:** Under 'DNS settings' select 'Manual import' (usually, the software configuration will default to auto-detection, so you must switch to 'manual input' mode manually ).



**Step 5:** Enter Google's DNS parameters of 8.8.8.8, then click OK.



Fully follow the 5 steps above, now your TV can successfully access to YouTube or Facebook websites.



The TV has entered YouTube as usual.

With just a few steps, you can easily fix the problem that the TV cannot access Facebook or Youtube, is it simple? Hopefully this little trick will "save" you in times of need. In addition, to use the TV safely and effectively, you should know and avoid 3 mistakes when turning off the TV, almost everyone has this.
