

Twisted Fate TFT Season 10: Item Build, Gameplay, and Guide

What are the standard items for Twisted Fate in TFT Season 10 now that his price has increased to 4 gold? Twisted Fate appeared at 4 gold in Season 8.5, and in this TFT Season 10 champion list, his price remains the same.

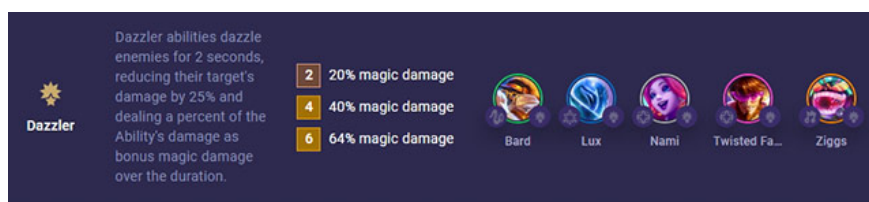
What are the standard items for Twisted Fate in TFT Season 10 now that his price has increased to 4 gold? Twisted Fate appeared at 4 gold in Season 8.5, and his price remains the same in TFT Season 10. Perhaps in previous seasons, TF only cost around 1-2 gold, so you didn't pay much attention to him, and if you included him in your team, it was only to activate buffs.

But at 4 gold, Twisted Fate is sure to have a place in the team in the late game. While there might be similarities between Season 10 and Season 8.5, the Superstar mechanic and TFT origins in Season 10 are different from Season 8.5, so you'll also need to know what he needs if you decide to pick him in your team, using some suggestions below.

TF's origins, stats, and skills in TFT Season 10

Clan

The abilities of the Exquisite Champions reduce the target's damage output by 15% and deal additional magic damage equal to a portion of the damage their abilities deal for 2 seconds.

1. 2 Stunning: Magic damage equals 20% of skill damage.
2. 4. Stunning: Magic damage is equivalent to 50% of skill damage.
3. 6. Stunning: Magic damage is equivalent to 80% of skill damage.

Disco



When you activate Disco, you'll receive a Disco Orb, increasing attack speed and healing per second for champions around the Orb. At level 5, you'll receive a second Disco Orb.

1. 3 Disco: 5% attack speed, 3% maximum health
2. 4 Disco: 10% attack speed, 4% maximum health
3. 5 Disco: 15% attack speed, 4% maximum health
4. 6 Disco: 20% attack speed, 6% maximum health

If you need to build more magic damage support items for Twisted Fate, you can use Disco champions to hold items for TF. Among Disco champions, only Nami can hold items for Twisted Fate; she is both a Disco champion and a Disco champion.

Skills and stats in TFT (Tactical Teamfight Tactics)



1. Cost: 4 gold
2. Blood: 700/1260/2268
3. Energy: 30/105
4. Zodiac: 30
5. Magic Resistance: 30
6. Magical power: 100
7. DPS: 34/61/109
8. Damage: 45/81/146
9. Attack speed: 0.75
10. Critical hit rate: 25%
11. Range: 4 cells

Skill:

1. Throw cards at the current target and the 3 nearest enemies. This reduces their Magic Resistance by 1 and deals additional magic damage.
2. Superstar Bonus: Throw 3 extra cards.
3. Suggested location: Back row

Items for Twisted Fate in TFT Season 10

Similar to Caitlyn in TFT Season 10 or Jhin's build in TFT Season 10, you can ask low-cost champions of the same origin as Twisted Fate to carry his items. The items you need to find for TF include: **Oversized Rod**, **Wooden Bow**, **Tear of the Goddess**, **BF Sword**, and **Training Gloves** to craft items like **Gem Gauntlet**, **Giant Slayer**, **Shojin's Spear**, **Blue Buff**, **Statikk Shiv**, **Hextech Gunblade**, **Red Buff**, **Archangel's Staff**, and **Blue Buff**.



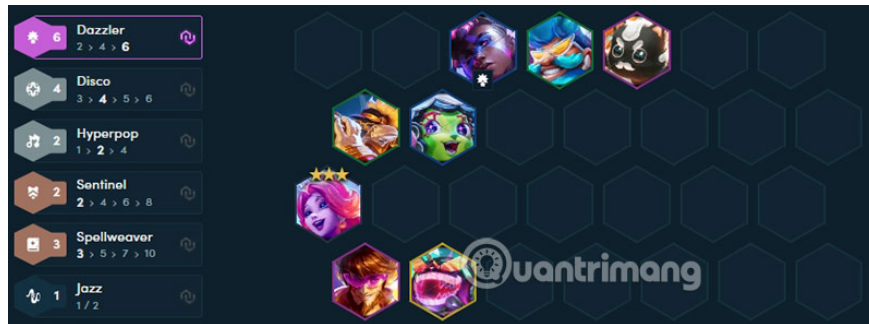


As mentioned above, you can ask Nami, Bard, or Lux to hold items for TF, and even magic items like those work well for Ziggs. So if you want to switch to Ziggs, give him items in the late game if you see him appearing frequently.

Twisted Fate build, Twisted Fate TFT team compositions for Season 10

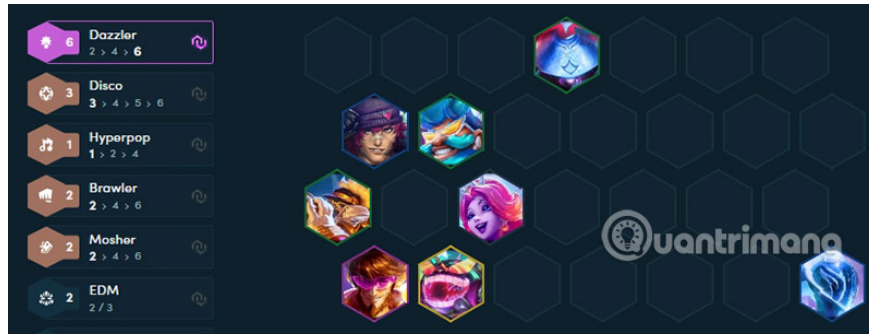

The magic damage from this team will come from Twisted Fate and Ziggs, depending on which champion you find more of in the late game, you should focus on that champion. As for items, all the Supreme champions have similar equipment.



The early game damage dealers could be low-cost champions like the "Exquisite" type, or Lulu could also work. The main tanking duties will fall entirely on Blitzcrank, Gragas, and Ekko.

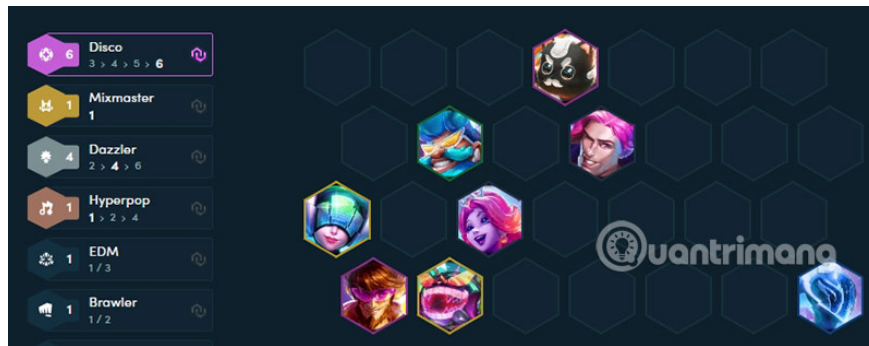
Alternatively, you can choose this lineup, which is cheaper and easier to complete than the one above. However, you will need a Disco button to activate 4 Discos, or you can leave it as below and focus on developing your heroes to increase the team's damage output.



Since Disco's attack speed is limited according to the game's mechanics, you need to prepare some items that support faster skill casting, such as Shojin's Spear, Statikk Shiv, and Berserker's Blade, to increase TF's attack speed.

Disco

Disco will increase attack speed, which in turn will significantly increase TF's card-dealing speed, along with restoring health to all heroes. This is provided TF and all heroes are standing around the Disco light.



Twisted Fate will now need more offensive support items than attack speed. With Sona, you have more flexibility in choosing support items for the player besides Disco Lights, including attack speed, healing and shields, or increased AP. Choose the stats that are lacking.

Regardless of whether the TF team composition is favorable or not, you can easily redirect damage to relevant champions.
