


Twitter will soon allow tweet scheduling

Twitter is said to be preparing to launch one of the most anticipated features, when users can schedule their tweets.

According to *Neowin*, this feature is really useful for all Twitter users, where it has caught the attention of clients like TweetDeck. Information about this feature was first posted by *TheNextWeb* through several Twitter screenshots showing the active tweet scheduling interface.
