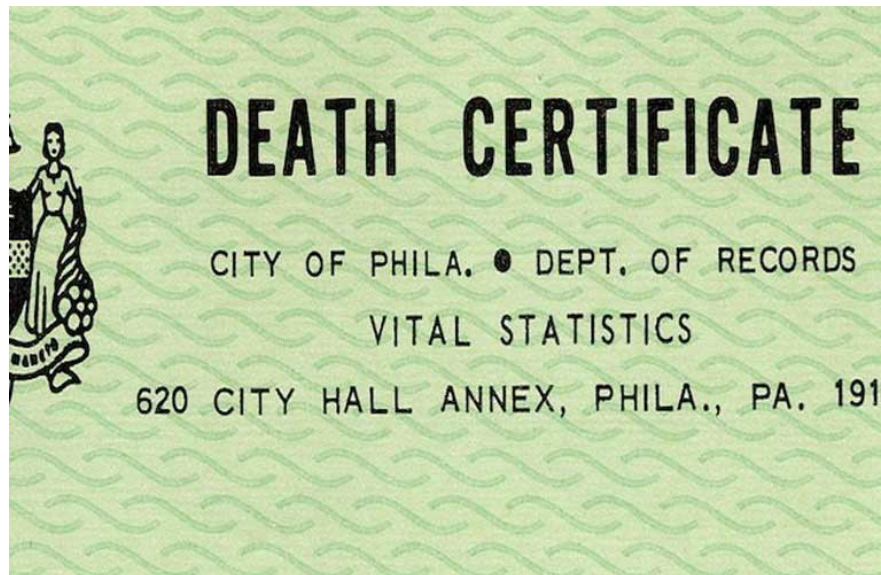
There are many famous figures in the spy world around the world, including Julia Child (pictured), Arthur Goldberg, Roald Dahl .
