Windows Update is an interactive Web site that allows you to regularly update bug fixes, performance, and features that are suitable for your Windows computer. Windows Update can be used on: Microsoft Windows NT® 4.0 Windows 98 Windows Millennium Edition (Windows Me) Windows 2000 Windows XP Microsoft Windows Server™ 2003 Why use Windows Update? Windows Update allows you to view, select and install the latest enhancements, security and driver updates for your computer. How to use Windows Update? You can find the Windows Update icon in the Start menu. If you can't find the Windows Update icon, just go to <http://windowsupdate.microsoft.com> and follow the instructions. What is Automatic Updates? Automatic Updates is a part of the service provided by Microsoft, capable of automatically downloading essential updates for your Windows operating system to fix errors that could make your computer in danger before the events. virus attack or computer worm. Therefore, Microsoft recommends that you use the Automatic Update service and set the automatic update option periodically as described below. In addition, you should periodically visit the Windows Update page to update other updates and other improvements to your computer. Why should Automatic Updates be used? The key benefit of using Automatic Updates is that the most essential security updates for your computer will be downloaded and installed automatically. How to use Automatic Updates? When you set up Automatic Updates according to the instructions on this page, you will have 3 options: Notify me before downloading any updates and notify me again before installing more on my computer - Notify you before downloading any updates Daily log and notifications before installing on your computer. Download the updates automatically and notify me when they are ready to install - Automatically download updates and notify you that you are ready to install. Automatically download the updates, and install them on the schedule that I specify - Automatically download updates and install them according to your calendar.

Microsoft recommends that you select the third option, automatically update the schedule, so that the program automatically installs the updates after downloading. If you do not select this option, it is important that you remember to perform the update process when you are notified of a new update. How does the calendar update work? Automatic Update service finds relevant updates for your computer, download and install at the time of your choice. It is important that you remember to record changes to your programs before the scheduled update time because the Automatic Update process may require you to restart the computer to finish the installation. Sometimes I see a balloon announcing updates. Why is that? During the normal Automatic Update, you can see a notification balloon like in the picture below. Click on the notification balloon for instructions on how to

complete the update process. If you have configured the Automatic Update service to install updates at a certain time, you will still receive a notification when the updates have been downloaded. You can choose to install the updates at any time, or if you don't install it now, the updates will be installed at the time you choose.

Can I be notified when the computer is about to restart? Some updates may require your computer to reboot to complete the installation process. If you are not logged in and the computer, Automatic Update schedule will restart your computer without notice. If you are logged in, Windows will notify you and give you the option to defer the reboot. Be sure to record your program changes before the scheduled installation time. What is an essential update (critical)? Any updates needed for your operating system are called essential updates and will be automatically selected by Windows Update and Automatic Updates to install. These essential updates address current errors and protect your computer from known security vulnerabilities. Which operating systems support Automatic Updates? The following operating systems support Automatic Updates: Windows Me Windows 2000 installs Service Pack 3 (SP3) or newer Windows XP Windows Server 2003 Windows Update protects my privacy like? The problem you care about Microsoft accessing information on your computer is completely understandable. Microsoft is committed to protecting your privacy when using Windows Update. On Windows Update servers there are many updates, but not all updates are related to your computer. To install the correct updates for your computer, Windows Update needs to check some basic information about your system. As a result, the Windows Update service identifies the necessary updates for your device based on specific software and hardware information on your device. The information Microsoft uses to select updates for your computer does not allow Microsoft or any other entity to identify who you are or what you do with your computer. The Windows Update privacy statement can be found on the Windows Update information page, however, the short list below shows what information Windows Update needs to determine if your computer needs updates. :
