

Upgrade the camera firmware on your Android Samsung Galaxy phone

And Samsung is no exception, when you buy a new phone does not mean everything is complete. For current smartphones, the firmware upgrade is essential to ensure system stability. In the following article, we will present some basic steps to upgrade, update the camera firmware on Android Samsung Galaxy phones.

In the latest Android 2.2.1 - Froyo update, Samsung has unknowingly provided an error-free version for users. And the serious consequences that users encounter is that the camera's recording function does not work, especially for Epic 4G users.

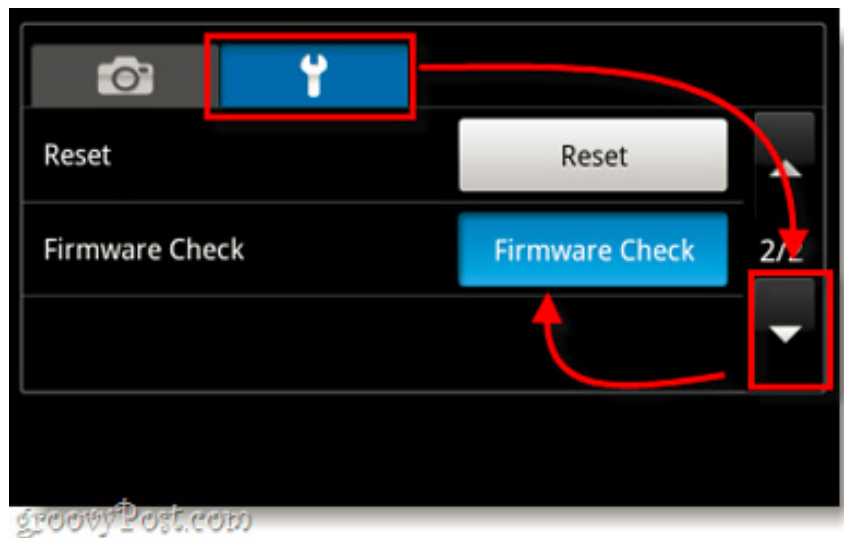
On the **Homescreen** screen, select **App Drawer**> **Camera** :



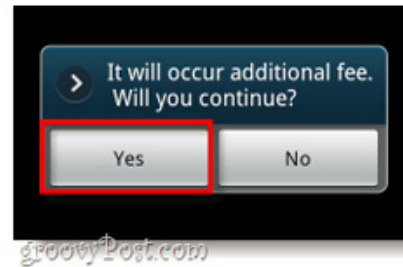
Here, you select Next **Settings** at the bottom left of the screen:



Then, press the wrench button and select **Firmware Check** as shown below:

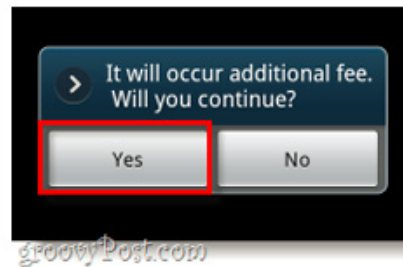
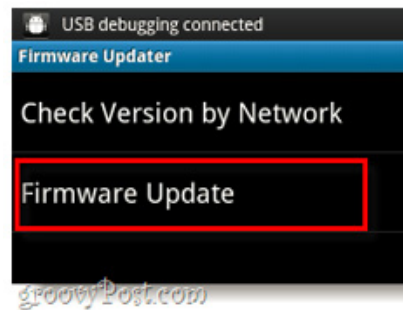


The next screen is displayed, the system will give two options: **Check Version by Network** and **Firmware Update** . When you click **Check Version by Network**, you will continue to receive the **It will occur additional fee message. Will you continue ?**. Click **Yes** to continue:

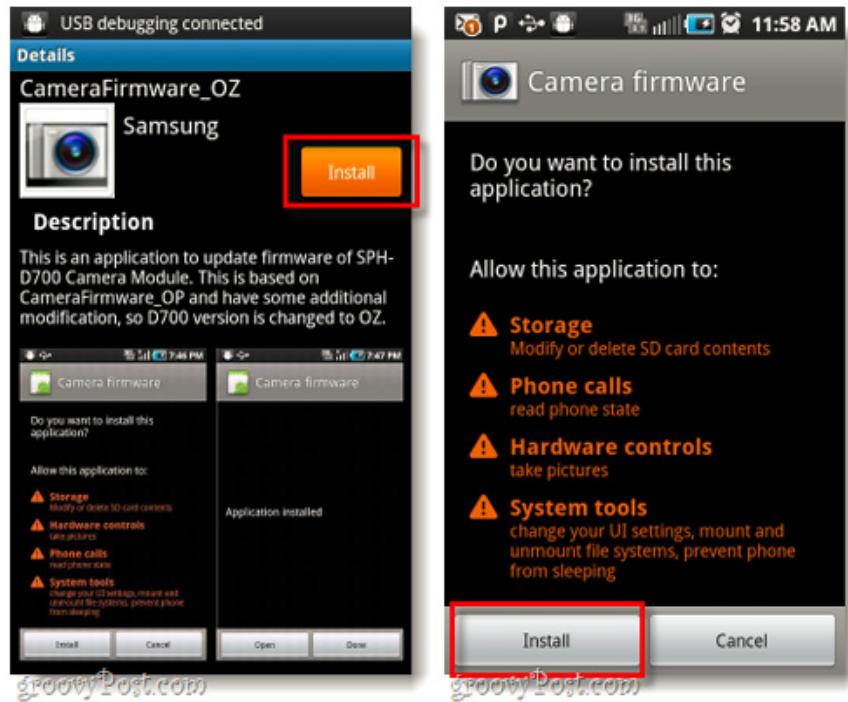


Here, the notification of user requests when upgrading the firmware will take a small fee, but you really won't have to pay a dollar at all.

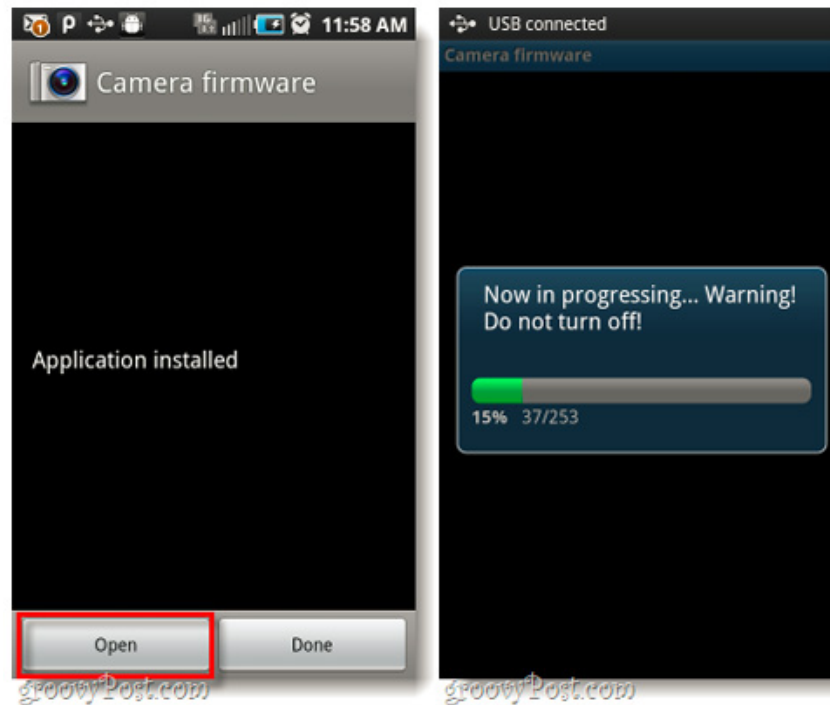
After completion of checking the Firmware version, we return to Firmware Update, and **It will report additional fees. Will you continue?** will display again:



At that time, your phone will search for the corresponding application packages from Samsung's data store, then return details about the software called **CameraFirmware_OZ** . Press the **Install** button in orange and continue **Install** at the next screen:

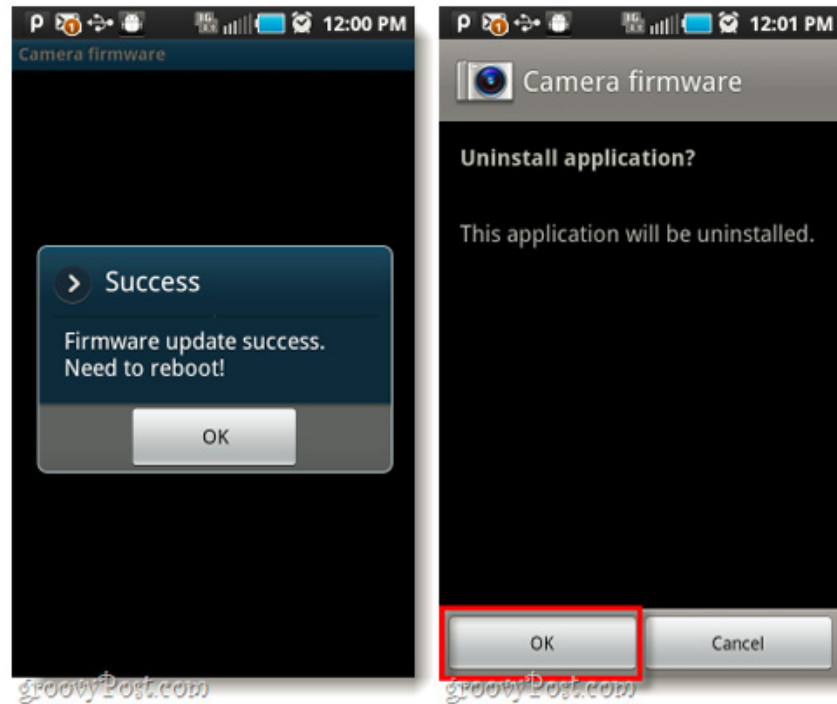


Note that before starting the update, you should plug the charger into the phone or have a long battery life to complete the process. After installing the firmware of the camera, we continue with the actual firmware of the system. Click **Open** in the Camera firmware section and the process will continue automatically, the total time total takes about 3 minutes:



When the system displays the **Success** signal window as shown below, the installation is officially completed, click OK and the phone will restart automatically. After that, the system will ask if you want to remove the

application. Click OK again because we really do not need to go after the firmware update was successful:



Note that this firmware update process will not solve 100% of camera problems, but it can help users avoid most problems with older software versions.
