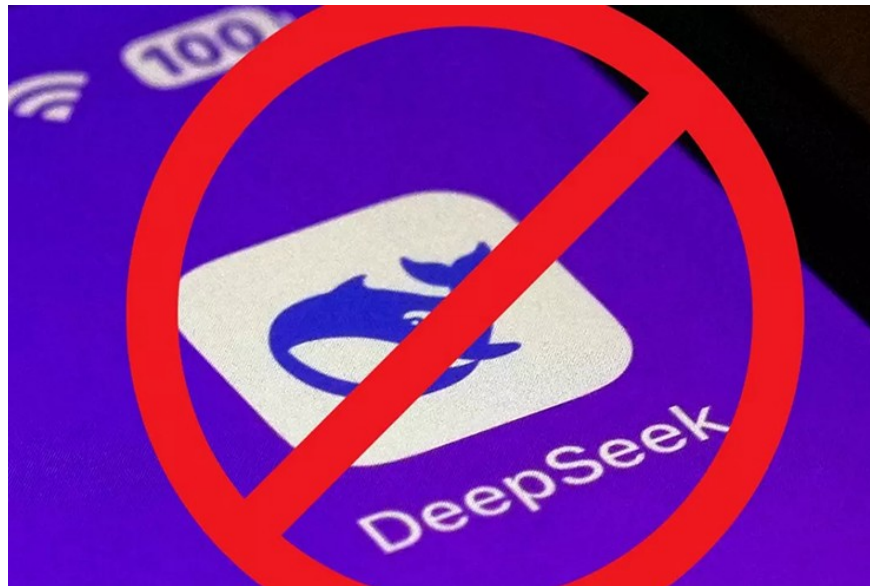


# US Congressman Proposes Up to 20 Years in Prison for DeepSeek Downloaders

US Republican Senator Josh Hawley has just announced a new bill related to DeepSeek.

Under a bill introduced by Senator Hawley, the US could impose up to 20 years in prison on individuals who knowingly download Chinese-developed artificial intelligence (AI) models, such as DeepSeek.



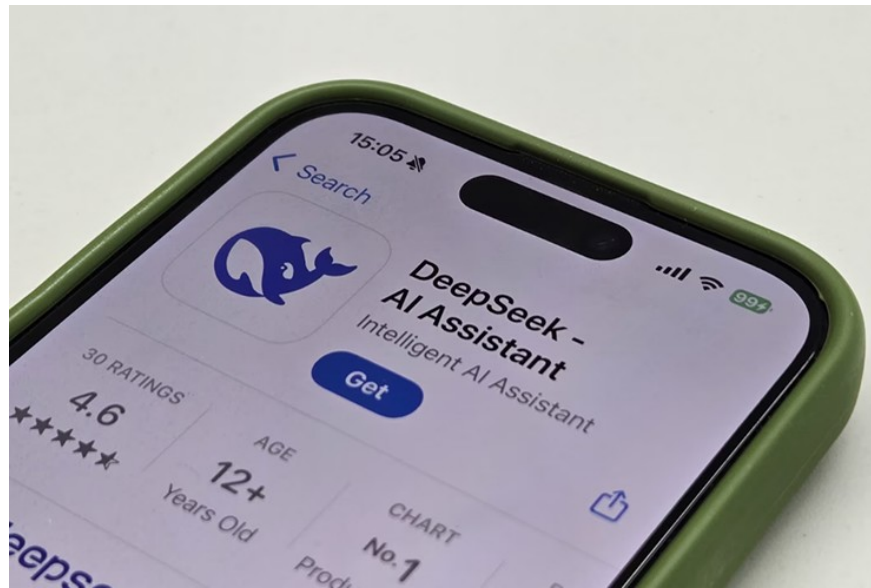
The bill could make DeepSeek out of the US.

If passed, the bill could stifle collaboration between American and Chinese researchers, harming global AI development. The bill proposes heavy penalties for American companies that collaborate with Chinese universities or companies, which could undermine the open collaborative nature of scientific research, especially in AI, which relies on cross-border knowledge sharing.
