

# US teenager sets fire to congressman's office over TikTok ban

A teenager angry over a TikTok ban set fire to a Wisconsin congressman's office.

A 19-year-old man has been arrested for setting fire to the office of Congressman Glenn Grothman, a former supporter of a TikTok ban in the US.
