Principle of operation of oil heaters

Oil heaters use electricity to burn oil inside the radiators, causing the heat to radiate out, helping the air to warm up.

This is the most efficient and safe way to convert energy to users. During the process of using the user is not required to change the oil, because the oil heater has the function of rotating the fuel ring.

Principle of operation:

1. The oil is contained in the oil bars, when the switch is turned on, the heat will slowly rise and spread throughout the room. Its advantage is not burning oxygen and not drying the skin
2. Up to 3 thermal power levels for users to adjust: Low, medium and high. When overloading, there is an automatic shutdown system of oil heater.
3. Oil heaters use oil as fuel, but it is not a complete replacement in the whole process because the machine has a rotating fuel function. Just charged and use it. Very economical for users.

Benefits of oil heaters



No noise : Traditional heaters often use fans to blow hot air out to the room. Oil heaters are almost completely silent. The only noise it makes is a few clicks when the thermostat adjusts itself

Non-flammable : Oil heater has a heating system inside, so it will not cause a fire hazard

Do not cause smoke : Since it does not burn oil or gas, oil heaters are safe to use in the home

Equipped with many safety features : Most models of oil heaters have protection functions when overheated and automatically turn off when something goes wrong.

Without a grille or ventilation fan : The oil heater is completely closed, so you don't have to worry about dust or small objects flying inside, nor worry about children being able to stick their fingers to enter. You don't have to worry about the airflow or the vents being blocked

Some notes when using oil heaters to not consume much power

1. Place oil heaters in flat places, away from walls, avoid flammable objects, objects of at least 1 meter in size so that the machine does not overheat
2. As well as air conditioning, you should not leave the temperature at the highest level, but only at 22-25 degrees Celsius. This is the energy saving and safe temperature range for users.

3. When using heaters, people need to follow certain guidelines. Should monitor the humidity in the room to ensure body health. According to experts, the most suitable moisture content is 60 to 80%. If the humidity is below 60%, it is recommended to turn off the machine and add steam. You can place a basin of water in the corner of the room (do not place it near the heater) to increase the humidity in the room, the room will be warm without drying out
4. Do not close the room, but leave the door slightly open to allow air to circulate, which will help the heater work more efficiently
5. Depending on the room size and the purpose of use, you can choose a suitable oil heater. Like air conditioners, heaters should also be purchased with a capacity greater than their actual needs to save electricity.

1. Tiross oil heater 11 bar TS920 - Reference price: 2,150,000 VND

Tiross 11 bar TS920 oil heater has a relatively large emitting temperature, so even when a power failure is sudden, the room temperature can be maintained for a long time. When running a heater, it does not cause light, no noise, no dust, very clean and odorless.
