1. Types of fish heads, shrimp shells



With these foods, not only can you bring your family delicious dishes but we can also take advantage of the excess on fish and shrimp to become a fertilizer of that plant. It sounds strange, but this fertilizer provides quite a lot of vitamins that are beneficial for plant growth and development. How to do extremely simple, we have 2 methods to turn fish head of shrimp shell into fertilizer, method 1 using microbial products EM incubate the head of shrimp, fish into fermentation solution to irrigate the plants, use this way if You have a large amount of shrimp and fish heads. The second way we can dry the fish then crush it so you have an excellent fertilizer for your home garden. This fertilizer can be mixed directly into the soil without worrying about harming the crop.

2. Eggshell



Egg is a familiar dish of many families, when finished processing, do not rush to throw eggshells into the trash but take advantage of this material to make fertilizer to care for the plant. In eggshell contains many minerals, very suitable for the growth and development of plants. You just need to dry, grind and then mix into the soil.

3. Animal bones



Animal bones such as chicken bones and pig bones are not too strange for food, it helps the juices more naturally sweet. After using it, do not rush to collect it in the trash but use it as fertilizer. We just need to burn them, you will get a biochar that does not contain heavy metals, this will be a useful organic fertilizer for plants. Small smashing of bones that have been burnt and applied to the soil is one of the best ways to add natural phosphate to the soil.

4. Banana peel



As we know, banana peels are not only useful for whitening teeth but also as a source of nutrients such as phosphorus and potassium for plants. We just need to chop the banana peel and apply it to the stump, the tree will be extremely green.

5. Coffee grounds



Coffee after drinking, instead of putting it in the trash, mix coffee grounds into the soil, the plant will surely be very fresh. Coffee grounds contain lots of protein, potassium and magnesium, which is wasteful if put in trash.
