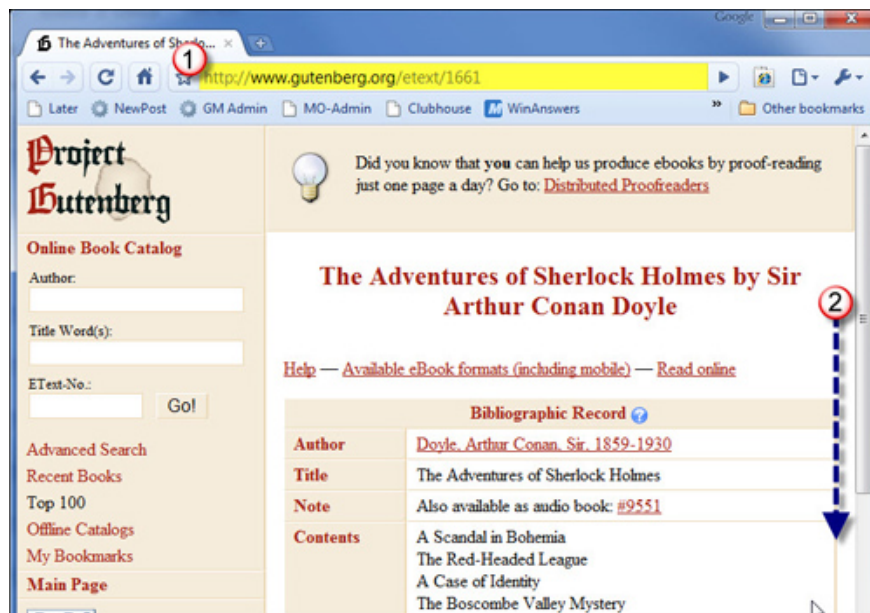


# Use more than 30,000 free eBooks for iPad

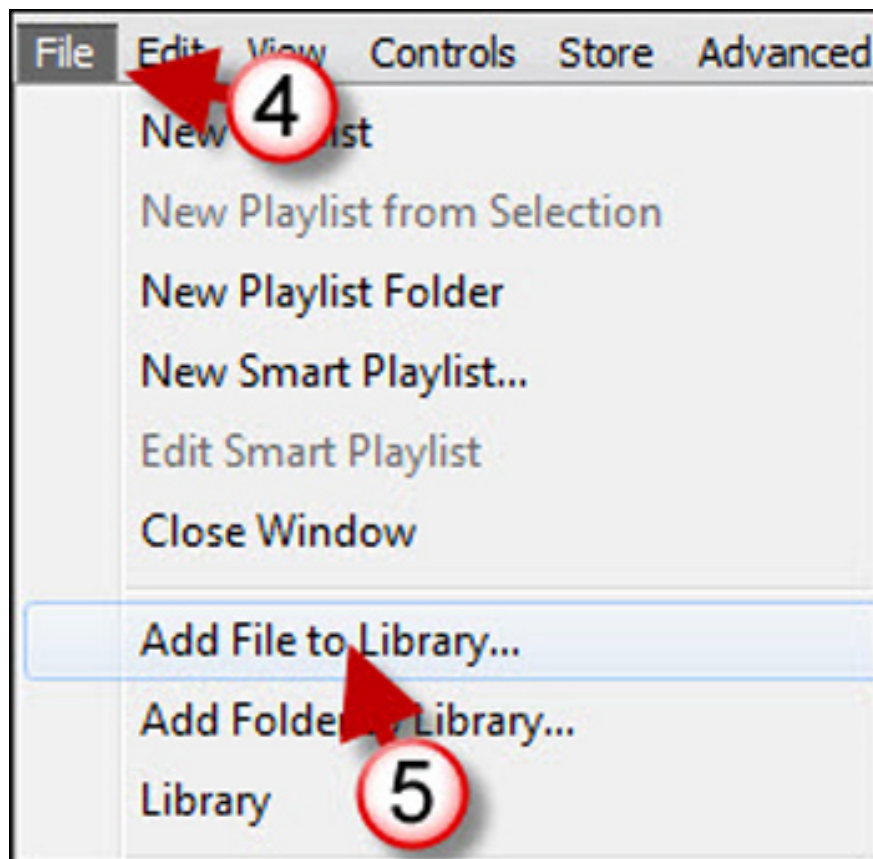
With more than 30,000 free eBooks in ePub format, Project Gutenberg will probably become the largest online e-library for iPad users.

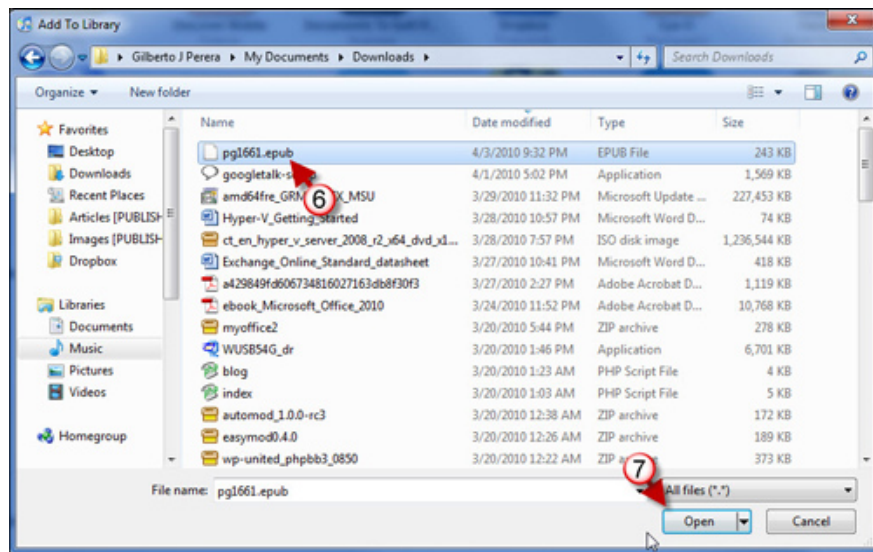
First, you need to access the Project Gutenberg homepage. Select the book you want to read on iPad, click on the link and scroll down:



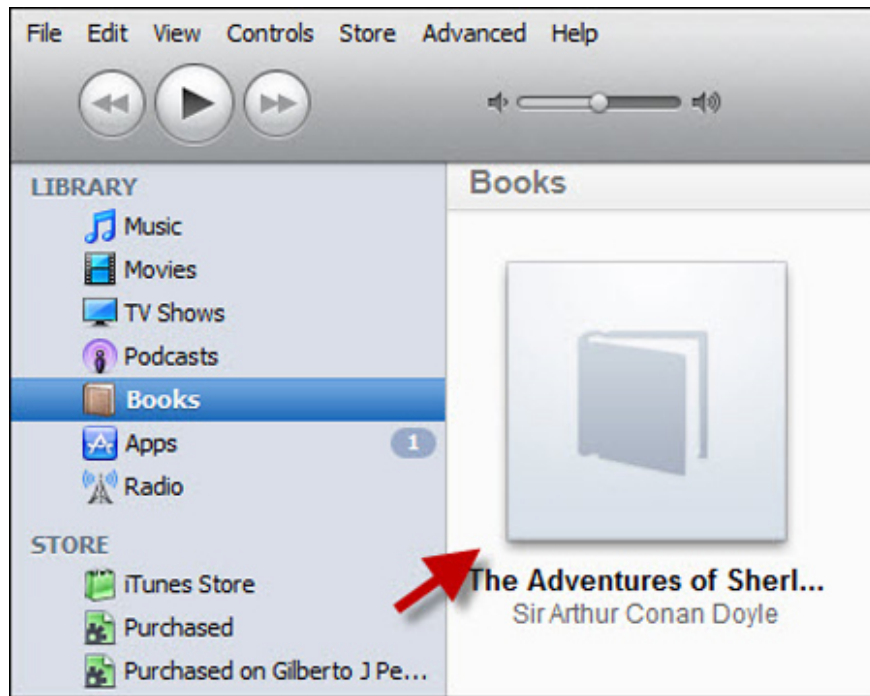
Download the book's ePub format, then open *iTunes* and select *File > Add File to Library* from the menu bar:



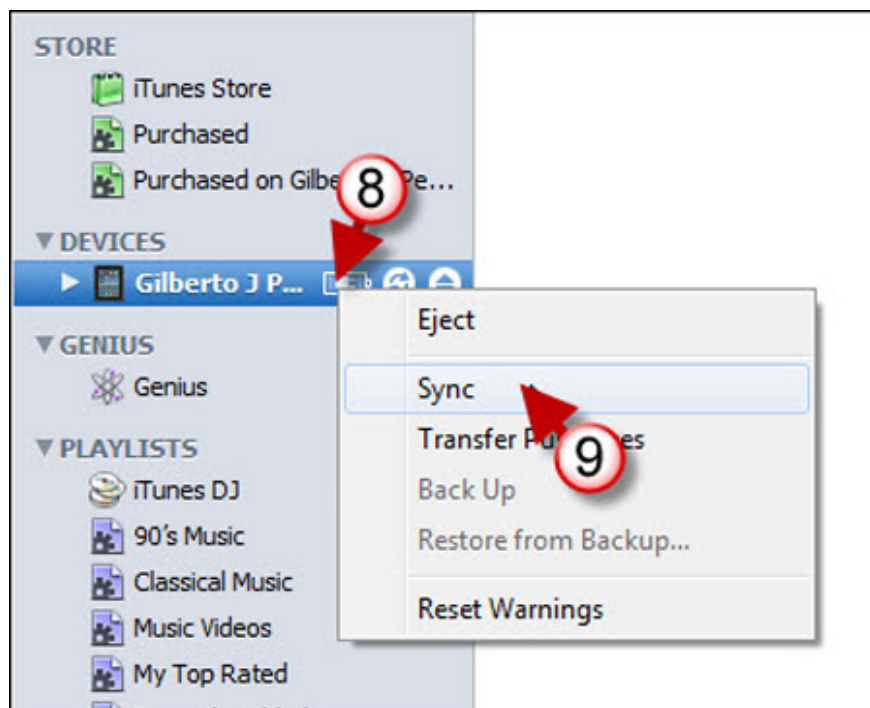
Select the ebook file you just downloaded, and *Open* :



And Books will appear in the iTunes library:



After connecting the computer to the iPad, right-click the iPad icon, and select *Sync* from the menu:



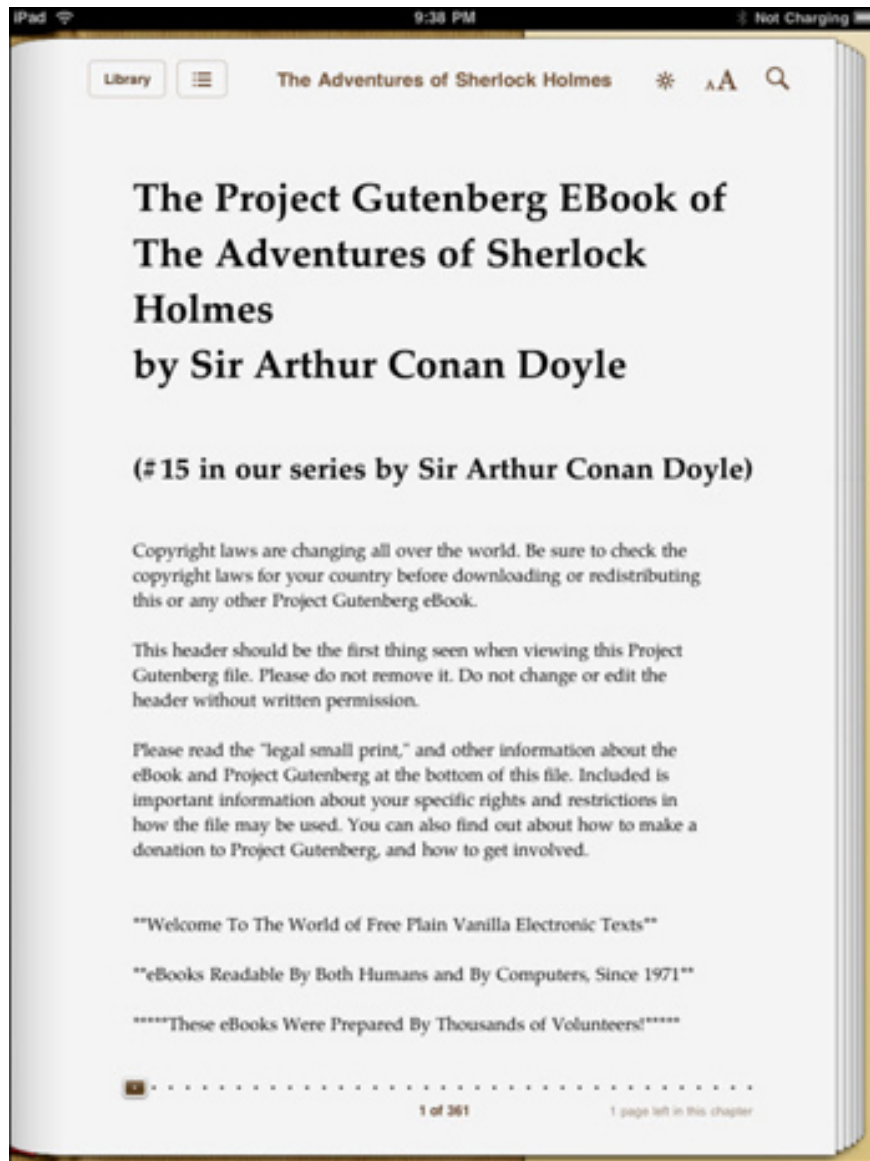
Click the iBooks icon on the iPad:



And choose the eBook that has just been transferred from iTunes to iPad:



Now, you just need to open the iPad at any time and enjoy the completely free book from Project Gutenberg:
