

Users cannot uninstall Edge browser on Windows 10

No matter how you use Windows 10, even third-party software cannot remove the stable Edge browser.

From now on, Windows 10 users, regardless of the way they use it, even third-party software cannot remove the stable Edge browser. Because Microsoft has hidden this browser, it doesn't appear in the Control Panel anymore. Microsoft seems to want Windows 10 users to always use and always remember this browser.

Previously, users could find the Edge browser and uninstall it by going to Settings -> select Apps -> select Apps & Features. But currently, this feature has been locked by Microsoft on Windows 10 version 1903 Build 18362.418.



Even when using third-party software cleaning and uninstalling applications, such as Revo Uninstaller, Microsoft Edge does not appear in the advanced uninstall option, the strongest uninstall feature of the software. .

Perhaps Windows 10 users have no choice but to accept the existence of the long-standing browser Microsoft Edge on Windows 10.

A few months ago, Microsoft Edge version of Chromium officially launched with many improvements that made users interested in the browser platform. According to statistics of Netmarketshare, as of June 2019, the market share of Microsoft Edge browser has reached 6.03% of the market. This is the highest level of Microsoft's web browsing platform since its official launch.
