Vulnerabilities on iOS and Mac

This vulnerability is known as **Broadpwn** - allowing hackers to take control of your phone or computer through Wi-Fi chips. An Exodus Intelligence security researcher discovered the problem and presented it at the Black Hat security conference in Las Vegas last week.

Without super-high technology, hackers can attack your device if you are within their Wi-Fi access range. So how to protect your device?

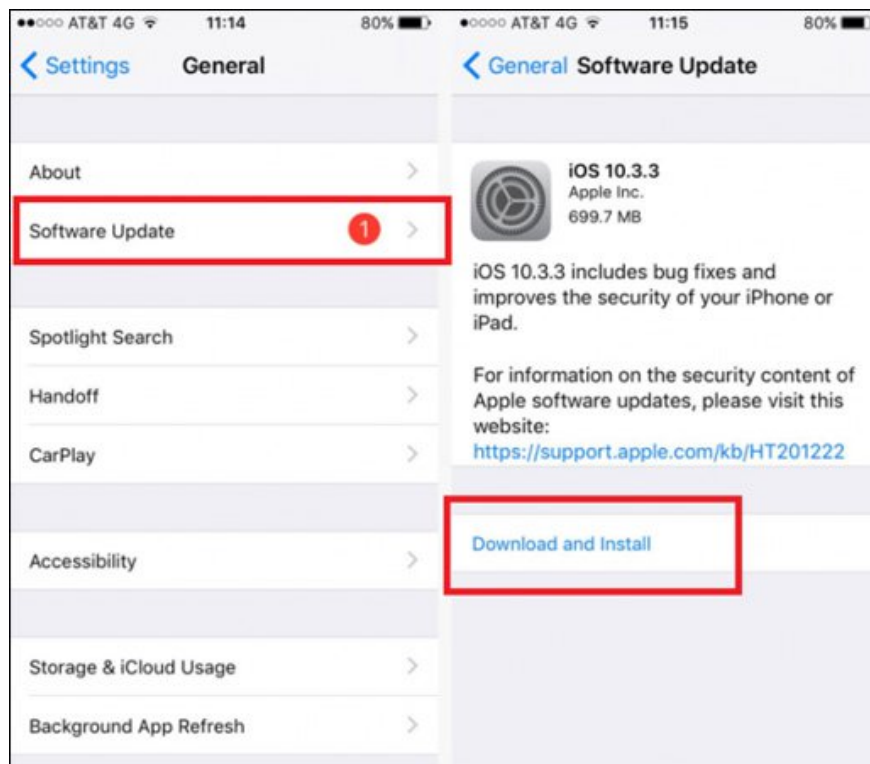
To fix it quickly, you can turn off your device's Wi-Fi. If you want a more permanent solution, you need to update your device as soon as possible.

With iOS

Apple has created a software update available for all iOS users. If you see an upgrade called iOS 10.3.3, update it now.

Open the **Settings** menu and go to **General > Software Update** . If you have not seen the update, refresh the screen.

When you are ready, click **Download and Install**. This process will take several minutes, depending on your connection speed.

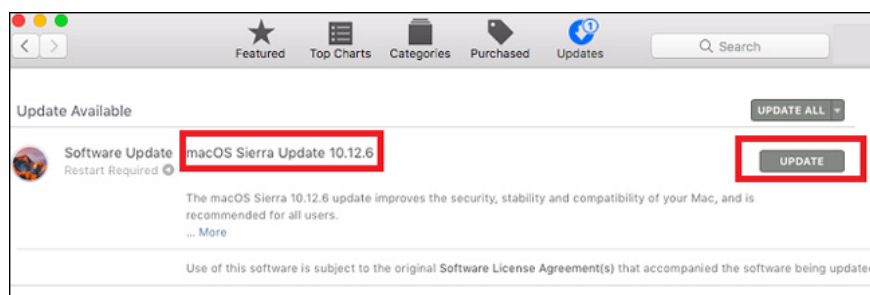


With macOS

If you own macOS, you are also at risk.

To update the device, launch the **App Store** and click the **Updates** tab . Wait a few seconds for the device to search for the patch. You need **macOS Sierra** update **Update 10.12.6** .

When you see the update name on the screen, click **Update** to start the upgrade.
