Vampire Survivors: Tips to build weapons and items to clear the game, How to build weapons and buff items in Vampire Survivors with up to 100% win rate,

Surviving the 30th minute in Vampire Survivors is extremely difficult. Even after playing the game many times, possessing all kinds of weapons, players can still be easily destroyed. In this guide will provide tips to build weapons, equipment, buffs,. with extremely powerful abilities that give 100% win rate on any character and any map, including even Hyper mode.

How to build with high win rate in Vampire Survivors

Weapons and item buffs required

To start building weapons in Vampire Survivors, players are required to have:

1. Ax - Upward and downward attack weapon, later upgraded to Death Spiral.
2. King Bible - Ambient attack weapon, later upgraded to Unholy Vespers.
3. Runetracer - Weapon with great range of effects (AOE) with good damage per second (DPS).

Next are the required buffs, including:

1. Candelabrador - Required to upgrade Ax and enhance AOE.
2. Spellbinder - Required to upgrade the King Bible and increase its duration.
3. Spinach - Amplify attack.

After having the essential weapons and buffs, players can add some optional weapons and buffs below to further enhance their strength and combat ability.



Optional weapons and buffs

1. Laurel - Helps protect the character from damage caused by enemies.
2. Crown - Faster level expansion.
3. Empty Tome - Cooldown reduction.
4. Duplicator - Creates more ammo, which means more damage to enemies.

To use this weapon and buff build effectively, try to evolve Ax into Death Spiral or King Bible into Unholy Vespers as quickly as possible. These weapons are the main damage agent to the enemy.

When acquiring one of the evolved weapons from Ax and the King Bible, the character is nearly impossible to lose (unless the character gets too close to the creeps).

To develop a weapon, gamers need to upgrade it to level 8 and have a corresponding buff (level 1 is enough). A creep will then drop a chest with an evolved weapon.

Do not upgrade weapons to level 8 without the necessary buff. Otherwise, the player may not be able to develop it.

How to build according to each map in Vampire Survivors

How to build while playing Inlaid Library

When playing the map Inlaid Library, choose the character Mortaccio because it can win even in Hyper mode.

Weapons

1. Bone: Knocks out enemies near the character, helping to stay safe even when completely surrounded.
2. Runetracer: Has a lot of bullets that last for a long time, covering the entire screen, extremely good long-range damage.

3. Cross > Heaven Sword: Great late game damage with a high degree of control before evolving to kill the mobs.
4. Fire Wand > Hellfire: Highly concentrated late-game damage, scaling with lots of extra projectiles.
5. King Bible: Multiple projectiles move rapidly in a narrow perimeter, improved by reducing the area of ?? impact.
6. Whip > Bloody Tear: There are many counter attacks, which play an important role in the late game. Bloody Tear's healing can save the character in the last minutes.



buff items

1. Duplicator: Mortaccio will have 6 additional projectiles for every weapon, especially useful for King Bible and Whip.
2. Spinach: Increased buff power and evolved Fire Wand.
3. Clover: Often useful and for Cross development.
4. Hollow Heart: For the evolved Whip.
5. Bracer: Increases mass improvement speed for Bone, Runetracer and King Bible.
6. Attractorb: Useful in leveling up, helps to gain last minute experience when moving no more, and can rely on Floor Chicken from levels (will get a few points until the last second).

Once you have these items, go left for a while to pick up the Empty Tome.
