According to *The Verge site*, early in the morning today (24/7), Viber's support website displayed the banner " *Hacked Syrian Electronic Army* " (*hacked by Syrian Electronic Army*) and a screen cut photo. Describe the device's database.

The SEA also gives the message: " *Send all Viber users, Viber messaging service based in Israel that is spying and watching you. We cannot hack Viber's entire system, but most Viber systems are designed to spy and track users .* " SEA's Twitter also has a warning: " *If you have installed the Viber application, we recommend removing it .* "

Viber said they have 200 million users and it is unclear how many users are affected by the attack. Yesterday, the SEA said it had discovered " *millions* " of email addresses and phone numbers of users, and they planned to bring them to the Syrian government.

The screenshot posted on Viber's website today also shows a list of phone numbers with device IDs, IP addresses and device basic information such as operating system, Viber version .

Currently, Viber has responded to the incident, saying that they were attacked by a Syrian Electronic Army trapped employee. Viber's statement said: "*It is important to emphasize that no sensitive data of users is exposed and Viber database has not been hacked. Sensitive and private information of people Use is still kept in a secure system that cannot be accessed through this type of attack and they are not part of our support system .*"
