

# Video on hand quickly Galaxy Z Flip, Samsung's upcoming flip phone

Samsung equips the device with ultra-thin UTG (Ultra Thin Glass) screen, which is able to bend without cracking. The improved Hideaway Hinge hinge on the machine will be almost invisible when using the machine and when opened.

Recently, leaked and predicted expert Ben Geskin has posted on his twitter personal page a quick video on hand of Samsung's upcoming folding phone, expected to be called Galaxy Z Flip.

Accordingly, this folding phone of Samsung will own a 6.7-inch Infinity-Flex screen, measuring 167.9 x 74.6 x 6.9mm when opened and when folded vertically is 87.4 x 73.6 x 15.4mm. The Galaxy Z Flip has a fingerprint sensor on the side and still has a 3.5mm jack. The machine weighs 183g.

Samsung equips the device with ultra-thin UTG (Ultra Thin Glass) screen, which can bend without cracking, making it more durable and stronger. The new improved hinge Hideaway Hinge on the machine will be almost "invisible" when using the machine and when opened.

According to sources, the device will be equipped with a primary camera sensor of 108MP resolution and support for 5x optical zoom. The power of Galaxy Z Flip will probably come from Qualcomm Snapdragon 855+ chip, 8GB of RAM and 256GB of ROM.



Galaxy Z Flip may come pre-installed with Android 10 operating system with OneUI 2.0 interface.

This folding phone will be equipped with 2 batteries with a capacity of 900mAh and 2100mAh or 2300mAh, which support fast charging.

Samsung will launch the Galaxy Z Flip in Europe on February 14 for around 1500 EUR
