

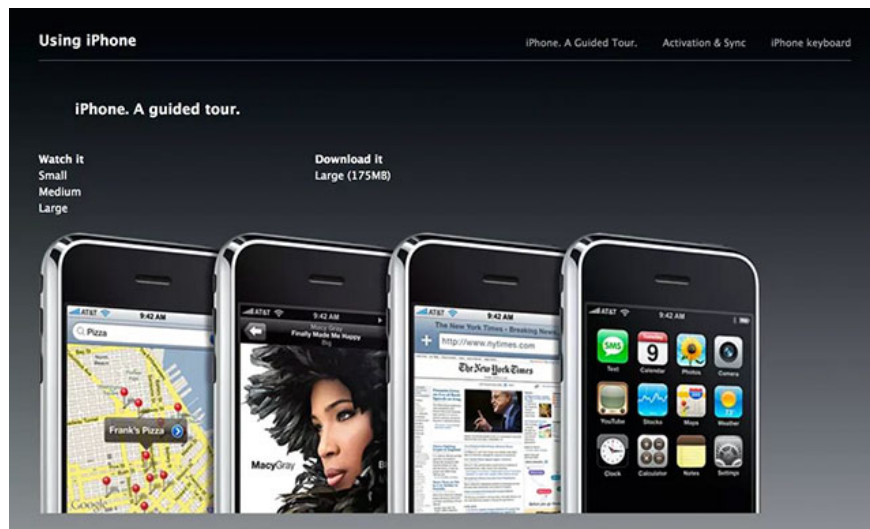
Video tutorial for using iPhone X from Apple

Do you remember the video tutorials Apple introduced from the first iPhones to help users get used to new technology?

Do you remember the video tutorials Apple introduced from the first iPhones to help users get used to new technology?

In 2007, Apple's goal was for users to understand how to interact with the touch screen and how to slide to unlock the phone. Since then, when the smartphone market has exploded, Apple no longer has to teach its customers how to use each new iPhone launch.

But leaving the Home button and completely replacing it with Face ID is a big change, so they have to give new iPhone X user guides to users, more or less unfamiliar with this technology.

Apple has just released A Guided Tour video for iPhone X, a video longer than 4 minutes. Among them are basic operation instructions for performing common tasks such as swipe up to open the Home, swipe and hold to open the App Swicher screen, switch between applications by swiping across the bottom. screen and Face ID setting.

Users are also encouraged not to wait for the authentic Face ID before swiping to unlock the phone. 'You can both look and swipe'. If you do so, the feeling of Face ID will be faster than Touch ID.
