Third prize: The Grevy's Illusion - Zebra staring at the camera in Lewa, Kenya, by photographer Yaron Schmid.



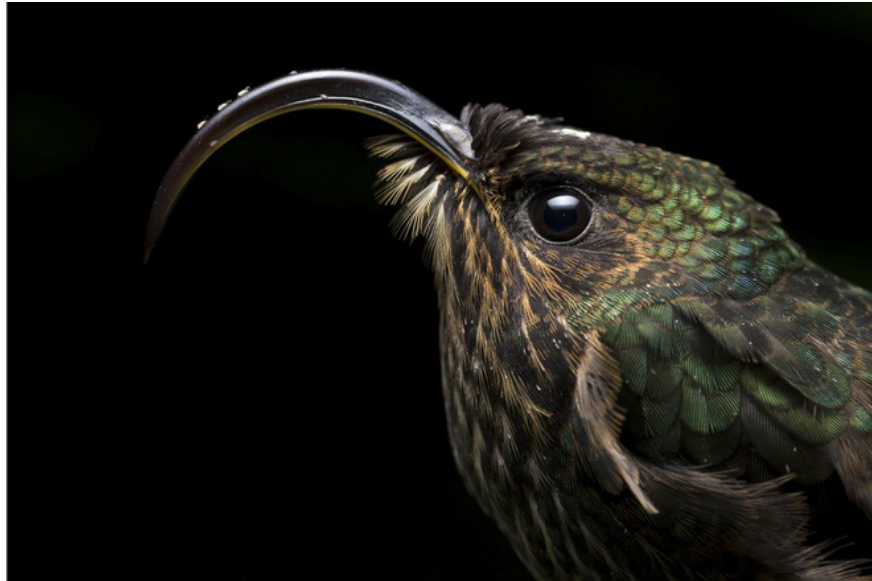
Honors: The "Africa Salvaje" test taken in July 2019 by Botswana by Jose David Altamirano González.



Honor Award: Giuseppe Bonali's "The Trio" exam records three dragonflies fleeing after a storm in Italy.

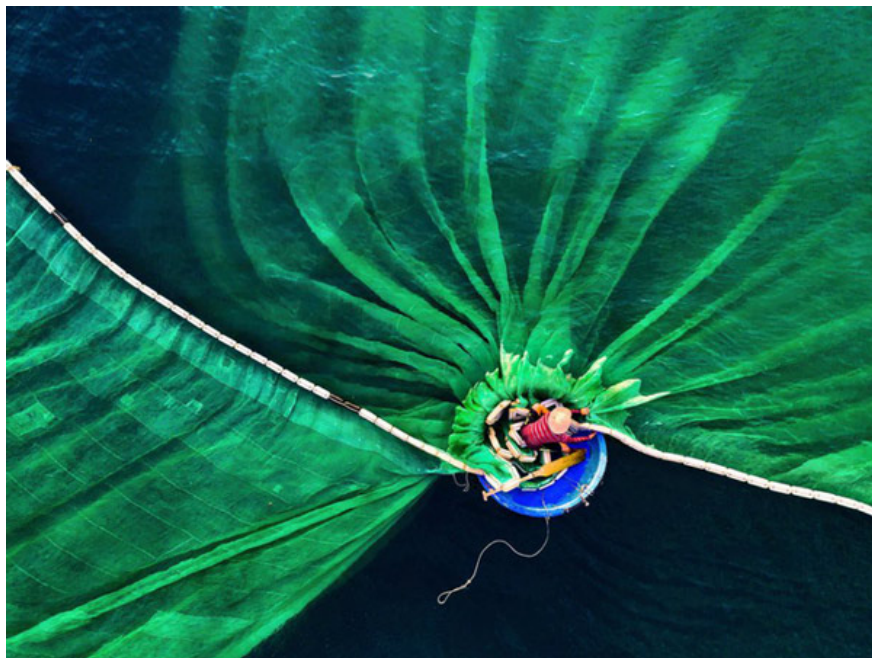

Honors: The "Tree of Life" test by Florian LeDoux taken from above water in quicksand, Iceland.

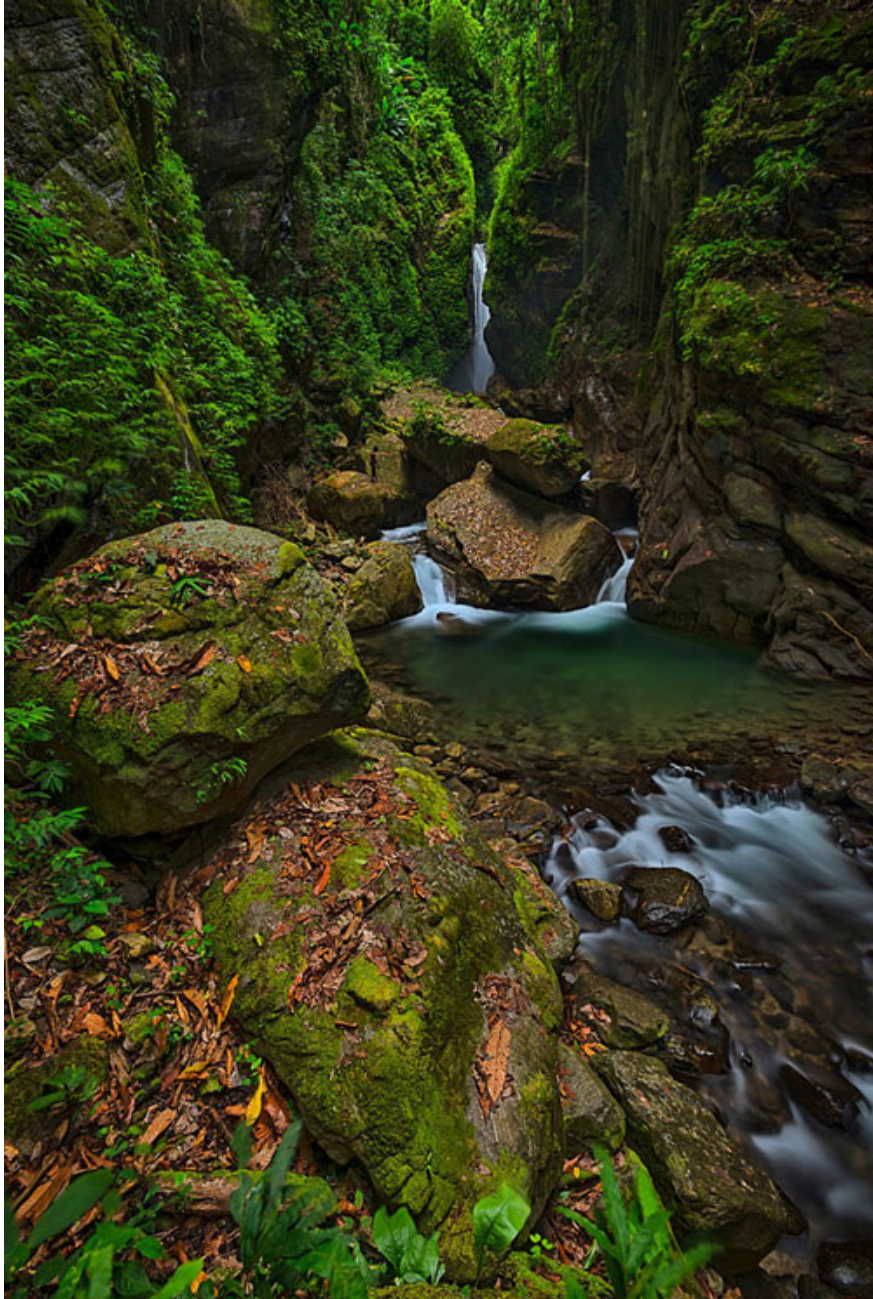


Honors: The "Furia" test by José David Altamirano González captures a volcanic eruption that makes the sky lit up like fireworks.
