The retail price of a set of Saint SIM network is only VND 40,000. Just need to recharge at least 20,000 VND per month, customers will be able to use 4GB of 3G data at high speed every day, high data rate of 30 day cycle is 120GB. Data preferences will increase with the load level. In addition, the calling rate of this package also dropped to the lowest level on the market today, only 680 VND / minute for both internal and external network.
