- **Auxiliary display** : A new feature of Vista that allows laptop-makers to build computers with small screens. For example, Toshiba has a business tablet PC with a small screen to notify users about new Outlook messages or even if computers can't open.

- **Gadget** : The new Windows Sidebar in Vista will show virtual small programs that perform specific tasks like a buffer for notifications or a clock called gadgets. Gadgets integrated in Vista do not work much with Office, but you can download gadgets separately from Microsoft servers, which use Outlook to notify people of the number of upcoming appointments.
