Throughout 2022, Cyberpunk 2077 will likely receive a few completely free DLC releases. CD Projekt RED has previously released new vehicles and costumes for protagonist V as well as a replacement for Johnny Silverhand.

Cyberpunk 2077's roadmap by the end of 2022 is still a big question mark because the developer has never announced their plans at this stage.

If patches and free DLC have filled the schedule for early 2022, the end of the year could very well be the showpiece of official expansions for Cyberpunk 2077. This is a move. necessary to bring the game's reputation back to life and attract a new pool of players.
